1. The item should be able to communicate with any registered & unregistered HART compatible devices and should support HART versions 5, 6 & 7 (including Wireless HART).
 2. The bidder must quote for their latest model of the item.
 3. The item & its accessories should be brand new, unused and of prime quality.
 4. Quotation should be forwarded in a tabular form, enlisting the compliances and deviations of the technical specifications for ease in scrutiny.
 5. Product catalogue / literature should be provided along with the offer.
 6. Offer from bidder other than OEM must provide valid documentary evidence / authorization certificate from OEM.
 7. The bidder must indicate the year of launch of the offered model. Obsolete products will not be considered for evaluation.
 8. The bidder must continue their services and spares, if required for the quoted item for atleast next 5 years. The bidder has to provide firm confirmation in this regard during submission of bid.
 9. Guarantee / warranty certificate for the item and its accessories valid for at least 18 months from the date of supply or 12 months from the date of receipt at OIL office, Jodhpur whichever earlier should be provided along with the material. The bidder has to confirm the same in writing during submission of bid.
 10. Test / calibration certificate for the item should be provided along with the material. The bidder has to confirm the same in writing during submission of bid.
 11. The bidder should provide any upgradation of device profiles required for the item for atleast next 5 years from the date of supply. The upgradation cost, if any should include in the bid. The item not having such facility to upgrade will not be accepted for technical evaluation.
 12. The bidder must quote for Intrinsically Safe model of the item. Offer from bidder bidding for Non-Intrinsic Safe model will not be accepted for technical evaluation.
 13. The bidder should state the address of their service centre for their quoted item along with the offer. Bids from bidders having their authorized service centre in India will only be considered for evaluation.

The item and its accessories will be inspected by OIL's Instrument Engineer at supplier works before dispatch and supplier has to inform OIL for inspection at least 15 days before the inspection date.
