Special Notes : 1. The items shall be brand new, unused & of prime quality. Bidder shall warrant (in the event of an order) that the product supplied will be free from all defects & fault in material, workmanship & manufacture and shall be in full conformity with ordered specifications. This clause shall be valid for 18 months from date of shipment or 12 months from date of receipt of

the items, whichever is earlier. The defective materials, if any, rejected by us shall be replaced by the supplier at their own expense. Bidders must confirm the same while quoting.

2. The minimum FOB/FCA charges in case of partial order for reduced quantity/ items shall have to be indicated by the bidder. In case this is not indicated specifically, the charges quoted would be prorata calculated and the same will be binding on the bidder.

3. Bidders are required to quote with minimum validity of 90 days from the Bid Closing Date as per NIT requirement. Bids with lesser validity shall be rejected.

4. Please mention clearly in your quotation the Net. Weight, Gross Weight & Volume, Indian Agent's Name and its Commission, Payment Terms, Ocean Freight/Air Freight Charges, Port of Loading, Delivery period, Country of origin with manufacturer's name, etc.

5. Bidders are required to mention the weight of each item individually. QUOTATION must be submitted in TRIPLICATE.

6. Since the equipment is a plug and play type, installation commissioning for the same is not required. However, the equipment shall be complete with all accessories and shall be ready for instant use once OIL receive. All visits including to and fro transportation to Duliajan and accomodation at Duliajan by supplier's personnel for warranty related work shall have to be borne by the successful bidder. Warranty certificate to be provided along with the equipment.

Successful bidder shall be required to furnish a Performance Security equivalent to ten (10%) of total evaluated value of Order, which should remain valid throughout the period execution, including extension, if any. The successful bidder shall submit Performance Security within 30 days of award, failing which OIL reserves the right to cancel the order and forfeit their Bid Security.
