Minimum socket dimensions as per Table 6 of BIS: 1239 Part 2, Latest Edition 4. Markings: Each tube shall be marked by stamping with manufacturer's name or trade-mark, IS No. that is, BIS 1239 (Part 1) and class of tubes, that is, M for medium. Each socket should also bear manufacturer's name, size and BIS -1239 (Part 2) marking. In addition, the PO number, length, OD of pipe and unique pipe number is to be stamped on each length of pipe. 5. Leak Proof Test: Each tube shall be tested for leak tightness at 5 MPa, as stipulated in BIS: 1239(Part-1), Latest Edition. Third Party Inspection (All test results to be documented and submitted to OIL by the third party):

- (a) Third Party inspection is to be carried out by OIL approved agencies like IRS/Lloyds/Bureau Veritas/DNV.
- (b) Raw material inspection for chemical composition and mechanical properties as specified in BIS:1239(Part-1):Latest Edition. 10% of number of heats of raw material and 10% of number of plates will be tested at random by the third party. The minimum number of tests either from heats or plates is 5.
- (c) Verification of certificate provided by the supplier for raw material used for the pipes from reputed manufacturers like SAIL/TISCO etc, specifying clearly the suitability of the raw material.
- (d) Finished Tube Inspection:
  - (i) Checking of lengths, diameters and thickness, straightness. Gauging of threads, visual inspection for surface imperfections. At least 10% of the tubes to be supplied to OIL will be randomly checked and stamped by the third party seal.
  - (ii) Checking Chemical composition and Mechanical properties: At least 10% of the tubes to be supplied to OIL will be randomly checked and stamped by the Third Party seal.
  - (iii) Hydraulic Testing: As per BIS:1239, Part 1 specifications. At least 10% of the tubes to be supplied to OIL will be randomly tested at 5 MPa and stamped by the third party seal.

NOTE: Pre-despatch inspection to be carried out along with Third party inspection.

(4) In the event you authorize your dealer/stockist/channel partner to quote on your behalf, the dealer/stockist/channel partner while submitting bid should mention on the body of the envelope that they are submitting bid on your behalf.

(6) To evaluate the inter-se ranking of the offers, Assam Entry Tax on purchase value will be loaded as per prevailing Government of Assam Guidelines as applicable on bid closing date. Bidders may check this with the appropriate authority while submitting their bids.

(7) Bidder must mention page no./nos. in every pages of their offer.

(8) Bidders should submit their bids (preferably in tabular form) explicitly mentioning compliance / non compliance to all the NIT terms and conditions of NIT.

(9) Bidder should clearly mention their name and address on the outside of the envelope containing their offer.

The Performance Security shall be in form of Bank Guarantee in the prescribed OIL's format valid for 3(three) months beyond the Warranty period indicated in the Purchase Order /contract agreement.

The Performance Security for capital nature items like plant and machinery etc. shall be valid for 12 months from the date of commissioning plus 3(three) months or 18 months from the date of shipment/despatch plus 3(three) months whichever concludes earlier. However, for consumables

like chemicals, cement, tubular etc. the Performance Security shall be valid for 12 months from the date of shipment/despatch plus 3(three) months.

The validity requirement of Performance Security is assuming despatch within stipulated delivery period and confirmation to all terms and conditions of order. In case of any delay in despatch or non-confirmation to all terms and conditions of order, validity of the Performance Security is to be extended suitably as advised by OIL.
