However, Industries registered as MSEs shall provide necessary documentary evidence duly certified by Statutory Auditor of the Bidder or a Charted Accountant where audit of accounts is not mandatory as per law, whereas PSUs shall submit declaration to this effect that being PSU they are exempted from submitting EMD.
