The PINS for the Centralizers must be a solid body pin, manufactured from sufficiently strong material with proper metullurgical properties to withstand the various forces encountered while lowering casings. These should be of proper length, tight fit, slightly tapered at one end for easy entry and perfectly compatible to the mating centralizer hinges.
- 2. The Centralizer should be supplied in assembled condition with one side open for easy installation on the casing.
