BB:: SPECIAL NOTES TO BIDDERS:

- 1.0 The items supplied shall be brand new, unused & of prime quality. Supplier shall warrant that the product supplied will be free from all defects & fault in material, workmanship & manufacture. This clause shall be valid for 18 months from date of despatch or 12 months from the date of receipt at site, whichever is earlier. Defective goods / materials or parts notified by OIL to the Seller shall be replaced immediately by the Seller on FOR destination basis including payment of all taxes and duties at Seller's expense. Suppliers must confirm the same in their quotations.
- 2.0 The spear along with all the components should be suitable for fishing operation with all types of drilling and work-over fluids.
- 3.0 The bidder should confirm to provide three sets of Operation, service & maintenance manual (indicating assembling & disassembling procedures, drawing and spare parts book having illustrated drawings and exploded views of the items with part number) for the items along with the supply.
- 4.0 The Bidder should furnish a list of recommended spares for two (02) years operation indicating part numbers, quantity and unit price of each and every spares separately along with the quotation in the commercial bid and categorically confirm the same in the technical bid (price should not be mentioned in the technical bid). However the cost of these spares will not be considered for bid evaluation purpose. The price should remain valid for at least two (02) years.
- 5.0 All parts should be suitably marked for identification purpose. Bidders shall confirm compliance to the same while quoting.
- 6.0 The item should be suitably coated with a protective coating both internally & externally to prevent corrosion and rusting during transit.
- 7.0 Threading and gauging of the rotary shoulder connections of spears should be as per API Spec.7-1 [latest edition]. Valid API Spec. 7-1 certificate of the Threader having authorization for Threading of Rotary Shoulder Connections should be forwarded along with the bid, failing which the offer will be liable for rejection.
- 8.0 The Bidder should indicate the name of the manufacturer, the country of origin and port of dispatch of the materials.
- 9.0 In case bidder is not the Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM), proper authorization certificate (in original) is required with back-up warranty & guarantee from OEM to quote against this tender, failing which offer will be rejected.
- 10.0 The bidder must specify the offered item in details & should forward relevant product catalogue of the offered item.
- 11.0 Any deviation(s) from the tender specification should be clearly highlighted specifying justification in support of deviation.
- 12.0 Bidder to sign and submit completely filled up Technical Evaluation Matrix for Technical specification.
- 13.0 The bidder may quote either for any of the items or for all the items. However, the quoted item / items must be offered along with its accessories. - 14.0 Bidder quoted as manufacturer must guarantee uninterrupted supply of spares and availability of service for at least 10 years with effect from delivery of the Item / product for the item / product to be supplied under the Tender / Order, if order is awarded to them by OIL.

- 15.0 In case the bidder is an authorized distributor / dealer / supply house of any Original Equipment manufacturer (OEM), then bidder must furnish the following documents:
