Physical State : The material, as received, should be white to creamish white free flowing powder, free from lumps and other impurities.</p> <p>2. Moisture Content at : 15.00 105 +/- 2 DegC, % by mass, maximum.</p> <p>3. PH of 1% solution in : 6.5 - 7.5 distilled water at 26 +/- 2 DegC.</p> <p>4. **Standard Notes:** 1.0 The items covered by this tender shall be used by OIL INDIA LIMITED in the PEL/ML areas which are issued/renewed after 01/04/99 and hence NIL customs duty during import will be applicable. However, deemed export benefit for domestic bidders is not applicable against this tender. Domestic bidders to quote their prices without considering the deemed export benefit. Domestic bidders to also quote the applicable rate of excise duty in their price bid. 2.0 Items shall be brand new, unused & of prime quality. Bidders shall warrant (in the event of order) that the items will be free from all defects & fault in material, workmanship and manufacture and shall be in full conformity with the ordered specification. This clause shall be valid for 12 months from date of dispatch/shipment. The defective items, if any, rejected by OIL shall be replaced by the supplier on F.O.R. destination basis at their own expenses including payment of all taxes and duties. Bidders must confirm the same in their quotation.

3.0 Validity of the offer should be 75 days from the date of bid opening. Bid with lesser validity will be rejected.

4.0 Quotation should be submitted in duplicate.

5.0 Bidders are to quote the Material Value, FOB/FCA Charges upto Port of shipment, Total FOB/FCA value, Ocean/Air Freight Charges upto Kolkata Port/Airport, best possible delivery

period, Payment terms (preferably Sight Draft), Port of Shipment, Country of Origin, Indian Agent's Name as well as its Commission, if any, Nett & Gross weight of materials etc. in their quotation.

6.0 The Minimum FOB / FCA Charges in case of partial order for reduced quantity /items shall have to be indicated by the bidder. In case this is not indicated specifically, the charges quoted would be prorata calculated and the same will be binding on the bidder.

7.0 The Port/Airport of unloading is Kolkata Sea Port/Airport, India (For Foreign Bidders).

8.0 Indigenous Party to quote for Unit Material value, Packing/Forwarding Charges, Taxes & Duties as applicable, Transportation charges upto Thaiyat-Hamira which is 25 KM (approx.) from Jaisalmer Town (Rajasthan), Payment Terms, Delivery Period, Net. & Gross Weight etc. in their offer.
