6.0 (a) No Tenderer must withdraw the tender after its public opening. 10.0 The work may be split up amongst more than one contractor at the sole discretion of the Company.

13.0 The successful tenderer shall furnish a Security Deposit in the form of Demand Draft / Banker's Cheque / Cash as specified above before signing the formal contract. The Security Deposit will be refunded to the Contractor after satisfactory completion of the work, but a part or whole of which shall be used by the Company in realization of liquidated damages or claims, if any or for adjustment of compensation or loss due to the Company for any reason. This Security Money shall not earn any interest.

14.0 The amount of retention money shall be released after 6 (six) months from the date of completion certificate from the concerned department.

15.0 The work shall have to be started within seven days from the date of work order.

16.0 Time will be regarded as the essence of the Contract and the failure on the part of the Contractor to complete the work within the stipulated time shall entitle the Company to recover liquidate damages and / or penalty from the Contractor as per terms of the tender /contract.

17.0 The contractor will be required to allow OIL officials to inspect the work site and documents in respect of the workers payment.

18.0 DISCOUNTS / REBATES.

1.1 Unconditional Discounts/ Rebates if any given in the bid or along with bid will be considered for evaluation.

1.2 Post bid or conditional discounts / rebates offered by any bidder shall not be considered for evaluation of bids. However, if the lowest bidder happens to be the final acceptable bidder for award of contract and if they have offered any discount/rebate, the contract shall be awarded after taking into consideration such discount / rebate. These provisions shall be incorporated suitably in the Bid Document

19.0 BACKING OUT BY BIDDER

In case any bidder withdraws their bid within the bid validity period, Bid Security will be forfeited and the party will be debarred for a period of 2(two) years from the date of withdrawal of bid.

20.0 BACKING OUT BY L-1 BIDDER AFTER ISSUE OF LOA

In case LOA issued is not accepted by the L1 bidder or the Performance Security is not submitted as per the terms of the contract within the time specified in the Bid Document, the Bid Security shall be forfeited and the bidder shall be debarred for 2(two) years from the date of default.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT(GCC)

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT made this _____ day of _____ Between OIL INDIA LIMITED a Company incorporated under the Companies Act 1956 and having its Registered Office at Duliajan in the District of Dibrugarh, Assam (hereinafter called Company) of the one part and Shri/Smti _____ and Shri/Smti _____ carrying on business as partners /proprietor under the firm name and style of M/s. _____ with the main Office at _____ in the District of _____ aforesaid (hereinafter called 'Contractor') on the other part.

WITNESSETH:

1. a) The contractor hereby agrees to carry out the work set down in the Schedule of work which forms part-II of this Contract in accordance with the 1968 General Conditions of Contract of Oil India Limited and General Specifications read in conjunction with any drawings and Particular Specifications & instructions which forms Part-III of the contract utilizing any materials/services as offered by the Company as per Part-IV of the contract at _____ .

b) In this Contract all words and expressions shall have the same meaning as are respectively assigned to them in the 1968 General Conditions of Contract of Oil India Limited which the Contractor has perused and is fully conversant with before entering into this Contract.

c) The clauses of this contract and of the specifications set out hereunder shall be paramount and in the event of anything herein contained being inconsistent with any term or terms of the 1968 General Conditions of Contract of Oil India Limited, the said term or terms of the 1968 General conditions of Contract to the extent of such inconsistency, and no further, shall not be binding on the parties hereto.

2. The contractor shall provide all labour, supervision and transport and such specified materials described in part-II of the Contract including tools and plants as necessary for the work and shall be responsible for all royalties and other levies and his rates shall include for these. The work executed and materials supplied shall be to the satisfaction of the Company's Engineer and Contractor's rates shall include for all incidental and contingent work which although not specifically mentioned in this contract are necessary for its completion in a sound and workman like manner.

3. The Company's Engineer shall have power to:

a) Reduce the rates at which payments shall be made if the quality of work although acceptable is not upto the required standard set forth in the OIL Standard Specifications which have been perused and fully understood by the Contractor.

b) Order the Contractor to remove any inferior material from the site and to demolish or rectify any work of inferior workmanship, failing which the Company's Engineer may arrange for any such work to be demolished or rectified by any other means at the Contractor's expenses.

c) Order the Contractor to remove or replace any workman who he (The Engineer) considers incompetent or unsuitable; the Engineer's opinion as to the competence and suitability of any workman engaged by the Contractor shall be final and binding on the Contractor.

d) Issue to the Contractor from time to time during the progress of the work such further drawings and instructions as shall be necessary for the purpose of proper and adequate execution and maintenance of the works and the Contractor shall carry out and be bound by the same.

e) Order deviations in Part II and III of this Contract. All such deviation orders shall be in writing and shall show the financial effect, if any, of such deviation and whether any extra time is to be allowed. The rates to be applied for such Deviation Order shall be the same for those appearing in Company's Schedule of Rate in force on the date of issue of such Deviation Order, to which the contractor has no objection.

4. The Contractor shall have no claim against the company in respect of any work which may be withdrawn but only for work actually completed under this contract. The contractor shall have no objection to carry out work in excess of the quantities stipulated in Part-II if so ordered by the company at the same rates, terms and conditions.

5. The Company reserves the right to cancel this Contract at any time upon full payment of work done and the value of the materials collected by the contractor for permanent incorporation in the work under this contract particularly for execution of this contract upto the date of cancellation of the Contract. The valuation of the work done and the materials collected shall be estimated by the company's Engineer in presence of the contractor. The Contractor shall have no claim to any further payment whatsoever. The valuation would be carried out exparte if Contractor fails to turn up despite reasonable notice which will be binding on the Contractor.

6. The Contractor hereby undertakes to indemnify the Company against all claims which may arise under the under noted Acts :-

- i) The Mines Act.
- ii) The Minimum Wages Act, 1948.
- iii) The Workman's Compensation Act, 1923.
- iv) The Payment of wages Act, 1963.
- v) The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965.
- vi) The Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, 1970 and the rules framed thereunder.
- vii) Employees Pension Scheme, 1995.
- viii) Inter-State Migrant (Regulation of Employment and Condition of Service) Act. 1979.
- ix) The Employees Provident Fund and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952.
- x) AGST Act.
- xi) Service Tax Act.

or any other Acts or Statute not here in above specifically mentioned having bearing over engagement of workers directly or indirectly for execution of work. The Contractor shall not make the Company liable to reimburse the Contractor for the statutory increase in the wage rates of the Contract Labour appointed by the Contractor. Such Statutory increase in the wage rates of Contract Labour shall be borne by the contractor.

7. The Contractor shall clear away all rubbish and surplus material from the site on completion of work and shall leave the site clean and tidy.

8. The duration of the contract shall be 52 weeks from the commencement date mentioned in the work order. The contractor must complete the work within the contract period. During the currency of the job, the work progress must be commensurate with the time elapsed. In the event of any delay on the contractor's part, he/she will be liable to pay to the company liquidated damages at the rate of 1/2% (Half p.c) per week of the contract price of the item(s) delayed in completion and the maximum value of the liquidated damage will be 7.5% of the contract price of the item(s) delayed provided the item(s) delayed are not critical for commissioning and final utilization of the work. If, however, the item(s) delayed in completion are critical for commissioning

and final utilisation of the work then the contractor will be liable to pay liquidated damages by way of penalty at the rate of 1/2% (Half percent) per week of delay of the total contract cost subject to a maximum of 7.5% of total contract cost.

The Chief Engineer's certificate as to the criticality or otherwise of an item shall be final.

The payment of liquidated damages/penalty may be reduced or waived at the sole discretion of the Company whose decision in this regard will be final.

In the event of there being undue delay in execution of the Contract, the Company reserves the right to cancel the Contract and / or levy such additional damages as it deems fit based on the actual loss suffered by the company attributable to such delay. The company's decision in this regard shall be final.

9. In order to promote, safeguard and facilitate the general operational economic in the interest of the Company during the continuance of this contract the Contractor hereby agrees and undertakes not to take any direct or indirect interest and or support, assist, maintain or help any person or persons engaged in antisocial activities, demonstration, riots, or in any agitation prejudicial to the Company's interest and any such event taking shape or form at any place of the Company's works or and its neighbourhood.

10. The tendered all-inclusive Price (i.e. the Contract price) is Rs. _____
(Rupees _____

_____ only.) but the Company shall pay the Contractor only for actual work done at the all inclusive rates set down in the Schedule of work part II of this Contract.

On account payment may be made, not oftener than monthly, upto the amount of 92.5% of the value of work done. Final payment will be made only after satisfactory completion of the work. Such final payment shall be based on the work actually done allowing for deviations and any deductions and the measurement shall be checked and certified correct by the Company's Engineer before any such final payment is made.

11. The contractor employing 20 (twenty) or more workmen on any day preceding 12 months shall be required to obtain requisite licence at his cost from the appropriate Licensing Officer before undertaking any Contract work. The Contractor shall also observe the rules & regulations framed under the Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act.

12. Wages shall be paid by the Contractor to the workmen directly without any intervention of any Jamadars or Thekadars and that the Contractor shall ensure that no amount by way of commission or otherwise be deducted/ recovered by the Jamadar from the wages of the workmen.

13. The Company for any reason whatsoever and of which the company shall be sole judge may terminate this Contract with a 24 hours notice in writing to the Contractor and in the event of Company's so doing the clause 5 here of shall prevail and the accounts between the parties will be in accordance therewith finalised.

14. The Contractor will not be allowed to construct any structure (for storage / housing purpose) with thatch, bamboo or any other inflammable materials within any company's fenced area.

15. The Contractor shall ensure that all men engaged by him/her are provided with appropriate protective clothing and safety wear in accordance with regulation 89(a) and 89(b) in the Oil mines Regulations 1984. The Company's representative shall not allow/accept those men who are not provided with the same.

16. All Statutory taxes levied by the Central and State Government or any other competent authority from time to time will be borne by Contractor and the amount of the contract specified in the contract is inclusive of all tax liabilities.

17. The Contractor shall deploy local persons in all works.

18. The Contractor shall not engage minor labour below 18 (eighteen) years of age under any circumstances.

19. The Contractor and his/her workmen shall strictly observe the rules and regulations as per Mines Act. (latest editions).

20. Special Conditions

a) The amount of retention money shall be released after 6(six) months from the date of issue of completion certificate from concerned department.

b) The contractor will be required to allow OIL Officials to inspect the work site and documents in respect of the workers' payment.

c) Contractor(s) whosoever is liable to be covered under the P.F. Act and contract cost is inclusive of P.F., must ensure strict compliance of provisions of Provident Fund and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 in addition to the various Acts mentioned elsewhere in this contract. Any contractor found violating these provisions will render themselves disqualified from any future tendering. As per terms of the contract, if applicable, the Contractor must deposit Provident Fund Contribution (covering Employee's & Employer's share) with the competent authority monthly under their direct code. The Contractor shall be required to submit documentary evidence of deposit of P.F. Contribution to the Company. In case of failure to provide such documentary evidence, the Company reserves the right to withhold the amount equivalent to applicable P.F. Contribution.

21. ARBITRATION :

Any dispute under this contract will be settled through Arbitration as per Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

Place of Arbitration : DULIAJAN .

22. FORCE MAJEURE :

Force Majeure (exemption) Clause of the International Chamber of Commerce (ICC Publication No. 421) is hereby incorporated in this contract.

23. LB VERIFICATION REPORT AND SECURITY REVIEW :

Contractor will be required to submit the verification report to ascertain character and antecedents from the Civil Administration towards the persons engaged under this contract to the Head of the user Department before engagement.

24. In case of any doubt or dispute as to the interpretation of any clause herein contained, the decision of the Company's Engineer shall be final and binding on the contractor.

25. SET OFF CLAUSE :-

"Any sum of money due and payable to the contractor (including Security Deposit refundable to them) under this or any other contract may be appropriated by Oil India Limited and set off against any claim of Oil India Limited (or such other person or persons contracting through Oil India Limited) for payment of a sum of money arising out of this contract or under any other contract made by the contractor with Oil India Limited (or such other person or persons contracting through Oil India Limited)."

26.0 FURNISHING FRAUDULENT INFORMATION/DOCUMENT:

Laying of pipelines from deep tube wells to different water injection stations, fabrication & installation of surface filters, hooking up and construction of pump house and surrounding fencing for 5nos DTWs (5 Jobs) at different locations in and around duliajan/ digboi/ moran.

Contractor should execute the following Jobs:

1. "Transportation of pipes with valves, pipe fittings etc. including loading and offloading from Field Engg. Yard/Materials Stores to various locations for a distance within 10 Km. = 30Ton x 1 job x 3 Km (average distance) = 90 Ton-Km"
2. "Transportation of pipes with valves, pipe fittings etc. including loading and offloading from Field Engg. Yard/Materials Stores to various locations for a distance between 10 Km to 70 Km and. Ton-Km for the four job beyond 10Km range = 30Ton x 4 job x 20 Km (average distance) = 2400Ton-Km
3. Carrying of pipes by manual labour from dumps and stringing and aligning them along the route of the pipeline.
4. Swabbing and cleaning of inside of pipe prior to welding.
5. Welding of PIPES WITH CONVENTIONAL WELDING INCLUDING FLANGES, SWAGES, BENDS etc.
6. Fabrication of lobster bends with gradual and smooth curvature which shall have minimum of 10 (Ten) weld joints to suit the alignment. Size of pipe = 150 mm NB
7. Scrapping/cleaning exterior surface of pipe lines including valves and fittings thoroughly with wire brush and applying one coat of primer and one coat of blue/green colour paint as per relevant BIS specification over the pipeline
8. Crossing of asphalted /graveled road and providing necessary casing pipe. The trench is to be back filled and rammed properly with gravel stone at contractor's cost. Casing Size = 200mm NB
9. Lowering of finished pipe into the trenches for their subsequent hook up. Care should be taken that the pipes are lowered without the use external force to avoid damage to the pipes. In case of any such damage the contractor shall repair/ replace such damaged portion or repair the surface free of cost. After lowering the pipe, the trenches should be back filled with previously dugout earth including ramming to restore the surface into original condition. Size of pipe= 150 mm NB
10. Hooking up/commissioning of newly laid lines with existing suction manifold at water injection/water supply stations. These junctions are to be exposed by excavating earth. Necessary welding/cutting associated jobs are to be carried out by the contractor. Size of the pipe = 150mm

11.Fabrication of surface filters out of 250mm NB/150mm NB/100mm/50mm NB M.S. pipes along with inlet/delivery/bleed valve flanges bends fittings etc.and applying one coat of primer and one coat of good quality paint over the entire surface filter.

12.Installation of surface filters over support near Deep Tube Well pump house and hooking up with the Deep Tube Well pump head and 6" delivery line including fittings and fixing of valves, check valves, pressure gauge. Bleed line with valve, bends, spocket, socket etc.

13.Cleaning & Installation Of Filters, Nrvs & Flowmeters- Ancillary Jobs

14.HYdraulic Testing of layed lines

15.Brick Soling of the Surface filter and surrounding area of the pump house including PCC grouting of the Surface filter. Brick, sand, cement (OPC Grade-43) etc. are to be supplied by the contractor.

16.Construction of the Deep tube well pump house (Size: 4.165 mtrs X 3.555 mtrs X 1.00 mtrs approx) as per OIL drawing No:7961 "All construction materials sand, cement (OPC Grade-43),brick, CGI Sheets, Door with frame etc are to be supplied by the contractor.

17.Erection of 2400 mm height jingle wire fencing with cement post (Cross-sectional area of 150x 150 sqmm) grouting at an interval of 2000 mm and at top fixing 3 lines of barbed wire, also providing a steel gate of size (1500 x 2400 mm). Perimeter of fencing (4 x 10.00 x 2.40) m. Required materials like sand,cement(OPC Grade-43),steel gate,jingle wire etc are to be supplied by the contractor.

Standard conditions of work:

1.0 All materials such as pipes (including pipes required for the posts), valves, flanges, pipe fittings, bolts & nuts etc. will be supplied by the company free of charge from Field Engg Yard/ Materials Deptt at Duliajan/ Moran. But transportation of all materials and manpower to and fro to the site will have to be arranged by the contractor.

2.0 All tools & tackles, Welding / cutting machines with all accessories and consumables, welder, transportation of welding / cutting sets from place to place, pump and its accessories for hydraulic testing , accessories for digging trenches, etc will have to be arranged by the contractor.

3.0 No accommodation and electricity will be provided by OIL to the contractor.

4.0 Water for hydraulic testing will be supplied by OIL .

5.0 Any material found defective due to poor workmanship will have to be replaced by the contractor at his own cost.

6.0 Security and responsibility of all company's materials will have to be borne by the contractor once these are handed over to the contractor till the same are returned to the company after completion of work(s).

7.0 The contractor shall not engage minor labourer below eighteen (18) years of age under any circumstances.

8.0 Any non technical / local problem arising in the work site shall have to be settled by the contractor at his own cost.

9.0 The contractor or his designated representative should report to the departmental officer at least twice in a week.

10.0 Measurement of the work done against each work order shall be carried out within seven days of its completion and the contractor should be present at the time of measurement and the same should be vetted by

company's representatives.

11.0 While quoting, the contractor must take into consideration all statutory laws for minimum wages, taxes, duties, insurance, Provident Fund, bonus, compensation etc. as per State/ Central Government laws applicable from time to time.

Safety Precautions:

1. The contractor personnel have to abide by all relevant statutory safety and environment rules, regulations, applicable codes and standards (i.e. OMR, OISD standards, BIS etc.). Also the contractor will have to supply the necessary PPEs like safety boots, gum boots, hand gloves, safety goggles, safety helmet, safety belts, etc. to his workmen and should ensure strict use of the same. Work order will not be issued to the contractor till this requirement is fulfilled.
2. Necessary Cold / Hot work permits are to be obtained from authorized personnel before starting of the job(s).
3. While carrying out welding and cutting jobs, the contractor should strictly enforce the guidelines as stated in OMR - 1984 and SOP-OIL, Vol-II.
4. The oxy acetylene cutting sets will have to be fitted with flash back arrestors in the regulator side as well as nozzle side.
5. The job of pipe line laying will have to be executed as per strict compliance of regulations enforced by State Pollution Control Board.
6. The contractor shall engage only skilled, capable and competent personnel who are fully conversant with the job. Before starting the job, the contractor shall submit the list of competent personnel with valid certificates whenever necessary, who will carry out the job.
7. During transportation of line pipes by road, they should be tied up securely with rope/ chain on trailers, to prevent toppling over of pipes on bumpy roads. The pipes should be unloaded carefully to prevent damage at the ends/ body of the pipes.
8. The trenching operation should be just ahead of welding operation. This will avoid deep trenches remaining open for many days, creating safety hazards to villagers and their cattle.
9. Before lowering the pipeline in the trench, it should be ensured that no person is present inside the trench. In case the sides cave in, the pipeline should be kept adequately supported before removing loose soil from underneath.
10. Utmost care is to be observed in deciding the number of the tripods with chain pulley blocks for a particular section of pipeline to be lowered. Also the capacity of the chain pulley blocks must be minimum 1.5 times the weight of the pipeline section it is going to lift.
11. Necessary sign boards/ warning signals etc should be used while working. The said sign boards/ warning signals shall have to be arranged by the contractor.
12. First aid box is to be carried by contractor's personnel while carrying out the job. Requisite emergency medicines should be available in the FA Box.
13. Under no circumstances LPG should be used for gas cutting purpose.
14. The contractor shall clear away all the rubbish and surplus materials from the site on completion of work and shall have to leave the site clean and tidy. Bills will not be processed unless the same is carried out.
15. Tool Box Meeting to be regularly held.
16. The contractor have to ensure complete safety of the personnel engaged by him, and of all the equipment they will handle and must take full responsibility for their safety.
17. The contractor have to ensure the quality and reliability of all the tools, equipment and instruments they use.
18. The contractor have to provide suitable facility such as Drinking Water, Toilets, Lighting, Canteen etc for their working personal.
19. The contractor personnel have to take every possible care to keep the environment clean and free from pollution.
20. The contractor personnel should understand the implication of the known hazards related to the work undertaken by them and the necessity of having an emergency plan ready to counter them, should anything go wrong.
21. While providing the services, the contractor personnel have to follow the procedures and systems taking all control measures in all the stages of works to avoid any untoward incidents/accidents.
22. The contractor shall have to report all sorts of near misses, incidents and accidents to Installation Manager /

departmental representative of Field Engineer dept.

23. For any clarification with regard to the above, the contractor may contact Head-Field Engineering / concerned Engineer / DSO of Field Engineering Department.

24. All the personnel to be engaged for the job under this contract should first undergo safety training prior to starting the job. The safety training will be conducted by DSO(FE) and same has to be recorded in writing.

25. The contractor shall prepare a written Safe Operating Procedure (SOP) for the work to be carried out, including an assessment of risk, wherever possible and safe methods to deal with it. The copy of the same to be submitted to Departmental Safety Officer prior to starting operations/ work at site.

26. All the persons deployed by the contractor for working in the mine must undergo vocational training, initial medical examination, PME. The contractor shall issue cards stating the Name of the Contractor and the work and its validity period, indicating VT and IME and provide a list of all such personnel to the EIC.

27. In accordance to the 10th Conference guidelines, the Contractor shall submit quarterly returns (by 10th of April, July, October and January) to DGMS indicating - Name

of the firm, Nature of work, Type of deployment of work person, Number of persons deployed, How many work persons hold VT certificate, How many work persons undergone IME and type of medical coverage given to the work persons.

Note I against clause no 6: Skilled person: Person should have a valid certificate from the Contractor as the competent person who will supervise the entire job.

The following BRC/BEC will be applicable for the IFB:

BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC):
