The prescribed Bid Forms for submission of bids are available in the Technical RFx -> External Area - > Tender Documents

The general details of tender can be viewed by opening the RFx [Tender] under RFx and Auctions. The details of items tendered can be found in the Item Data and details uploaded under Technical RFX.

The tender will be governed by:

1.0 General Qualification Criteria:

- 3. API 6A monogram must be embossed on each of the item.

(I) BID REJECTION CRITERIA

In addition to BRC criteria vide SECTION - "D" of General Terms and Conditions for Global Tender (MM/RP/GLOBAL/E-01/2005), the following clause will be applicable against this tender:

The bid shall conform to the specifications, notes, terms and conditions stipulated in the bidding document. Bid will be rejected in case items offered will not conform to the stipulated specifications. Not withstanding the general

conformity of the bid to the stipulated specifications and terms & conditions, the following requirements shall be met by the bidder, without which the offer will be considered as non responsive and rejected. All the documents related to BRC must be submitted along with the bid.

- A. Technical
- 1. Bidder's Qualification
- 1.1 The bidder shall be an Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) having experience in manufacturing of VALVE Assembly as per API specification 6A of pressure rating indicated in the tender or more.

OR

- 1.2 The bidder shall be an authorized dealer of OEM.
- 2. Bidder's Experience In case, the bidder is an Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM)-
- 2.1.The bidder shall be a Manufacturer of VALVE Assembly as per API specification 6A of pressure rating indicated in the tender or more and shall also be in the business of manufacturing API 6A VALVE Assembly for the last 5 years as on Bid Closing Date of this tender. Documentary evidence in the form of a valid API 6A certificate for the last 5 years as on Bid Closing Date of this tender shall be submitted along with the bid without which offer will be rejected.
- 2.2.The bidder shall have the credential of successful execution of at least ONE order not less than 50% of the tender quantity of VALVE Assembly in quantum of pressure rating indicated in the tender or more against each order during the period of last 3 (three) years preceding from the bid closing date of this tender to any Oil and Gas Industry. The bidder shall submit details of the previous supply of such VALVE Assembly, in absence of which the bid will be summarily rejected. This information is required as OIL may feel to inspect the infrastructural facilities of the vendor for manufacturing as well as quality assurance before placement of order.
- 2.3. In case the Bidder is an authorized dealer of OEM, the following criteria shall be met by the Bidder:
- 2.3.1.The bidder shall confirm supply of VALVE Assembly as per API specification 6A from Manufacturer (OEM) of valve Assembly who meets the qualification requirements stipulated under clauses A. 2.1 & A.2.2 above.
- 2.3.2.Bidder shall enclose an Authorization Certificate with back up Warranty & Guarantee from the OEM to quote against this tender.
- 2.3.3. The bid shall be rejected in case of any change of the proposed OEM after submission of the bid.
- 2.3.4. The bidder shall have the credential of successful execution of at least 1 (one) order not less than 50% of the tender quantity of valve Assembly as per API specification 6A of pressure rating indicated in the tender or more against the order during the currency of last 3 (three) years preceding from the bid closing date of this tender to any Oil and Gas Industry. The bidder shall submit details of the previous supply of such valve Assembly.

- 2.3.5. However, the clauses A.2.2 & A.2.3.4 related to Bidder's experience criteria will be not applicable for bidders or their Principal who have successfully executed order of OIL for supply of valve Assembly as per API specification 6A.
- 3. Supporting Documents:
- a) Possession of a supply order without complete execution or partially completed order will not be considered as previous experience of the bidder with respect to the Bidder's Experience criteria.
- b) In support of the experience as noted in paras A.2.1, 2.2 and 2.3.4 above, the bidder shall submit the following documents:

- 5.0 API monogram to be embossed on each piece of material. Bidder should forward a copy of valid authorization to use API monogram along with the Bid.
- 6.0 Manufacturer must forward their Inspection Schedule, considering date of placement of order as day one in respect of above for inspection by Third Party Inspectorate Agency along with the offer. The third party inspection is to be carried out by an internationally reputed inspection Agency.
- OIL'S APPROVED THIRD PARTY INSPECTION AGENCIES ARE LLODYS, BUREAU VARITAS, RITES, IRS AND DNV. PLEASE REFER CLAUSE 7.9 OF SECTION A OF GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITION (MM/RP/GLOBAL/E01/2005). All inclusive charges for Third Party Inspection to be indicated
- 7.0 Bidders are required to forward the related Technical Brochure & Drawings showing all the major and critical dimensions along with the bids.
- 8.0 Validity of the Bids shall be minimum 4 months (120 days) from the Bid closing date of the tender. Bids with lesser validity will be rejected.
- 9.0 Bid must be submitted electronically only through OIL's e-procurement portal. Bid submitted in any other form will be rejected.

(II) BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC):

The bids conforming to the specifications, terms & conditions stipulated in the tender and considered to be responsive after subjecting to the Bid Rejection Criteria will be considered for further evaluation as per Bid Evaluation Criteria given below:

1.0 If there is any discrepancy between the unit price and the total price, the unit price will prevail and the total price shall be corrected. Similarly, if there is any discrepancy between words and figure, the amount in words shall prevail and will be adopted for evaluation.

2.0 To ascertain the substantial responsiveness of the bid, OIL reserves the right to ask the bidder for clarification in respect of clauses covered under BRC also and such clarifications fulfilling the BRC clauses in total must be received on or before the deadline given by the company, failing which the offer will be summarily rejected.

(iii) STANDARD NOTES:

- 1.0 Materials to be supplied hereunder shall be new, unused, of recent make, of best quality & workmanship and shall be guaranteed by the seller for a period 18 months from the date of despatch/shipment or 12 months from the date of receipt at destination, whichever is earlier against defects arising from faulty materials, workmanship or design. Defective goods / materials or parts notified by OIL to the seller shall be replaced immediately by the supplier at the supplier expense at no extra cost to OIL.
- 2.0 Bidders are to quote for Unit Material value, Packing/Forwarding Charges, Taxes & Duties as applicable, Transportation charges upto Thaiyat-Hamira which is 25 KM (approx.) from Jaisalmer Town (Rajasthan), Insurance Charges, Payment Terms, Delivery Period, Net. & Gross Weight etc. in their offer.
- 3.0 For order with F.O.R. Destination term, 100% payment against dispatch document will not be entertained. In this regards please refer payment terms in ANNEXURE MM/RP/GLOBAL/E-01/2005. Bidders are advised to take note of this while mentioning payment term.
