**1.0** Bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of bid. Oil India Limited, hereinafter referred to as Company, will in no case be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

**2.0 BIDDING DOCUMENTS**

**2.1 TENDER FEE:**

2.1.1 Bidders interested to provide the services and interested to participate in the above tender are requested to submit the tender fee of **Rs. 1000/-** (Rupees One Thousand) only by Demand Draft/Banker's Cheque favouring OIL INDIA LIMITED, Payable at Guwahati issued by any Scheduled Bank. NO OTHER MODE OF PAYMENT WILL BE ACCEPTED BY THE COMPANY.

2.1.2 Sealed envelopes containing the Tender Fee shall be marked with the above Tender Number and description of work and addressed to following:

Tender fee shall reach the above address one week prior to Bid Closing date during working days (excluding Sundays/Holidays). Bidder whose Tender fee reach after the last date of received of tender fee as mentioned in online data shall not be allowed to participate in the bidding process.

**2.2 EXEMPTION OF TENDER FEE:**

- (i) **Micro & small Enterprises (MSME)** ,Small Scale Industries (SSI) registered with NSIC under Single Point Registration Scheme are exempted from payment of tender fees for the items they are registered with NSIC. Valid registration certificate with NSIC must be enclosed along with the application for issuing tender documents.
- (ii) Public Sector Undertakings (PSU) ,**Central Govt. Departments** are also exempted from payment of tender fee.
- (iii) Firms registered with NSIC, PSU's & Government Departments claiming exemption from payment of tender fee should submit their request with all credentials to the tender administrator at least 7 days in advance from the date of closer of sale of bid documents, to get access for participation in the tender.

- (iv) Tender documents provided to SSI Units registered with NSIC on free of charge basis shall submit their offer for the service for which they are registered. Their offer for other than the registered service shall not be acceptable. Their offer as service provider also will not be acceptable and shall be rejected straightway.
- (v) **Public Sector Undertakings (PSU) , Central Govt. Departments ,Micro & small Enterprises (MSME)** and Small Scale Industries (SSI) registered with NSIC under Single Point Registration Scheme for the items they are registered with NSIC are exempted from payment of **Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)**. Valid registration certificate with NSIC must be enclosed along with the application for issuing tender documents.

### 2.3 TRANSFERABILITY OF BID DOCUMENTS:

3.1 *Bid Documents are non-transferable. Bid can be submitted only in the name of the bidder in whose name the Bid Document has been issued.*

3.2 Unsolicited bids will not be considered and will be rejected straightway.

- 2.5 The bidder is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms and specifications in the Bidding Documents. Failure to furnish all information required in the Bidding Documents or submission of a bid not substantially responsive to the Bidding Documents in every respect will be at the Bidder's risk & responsibility and may result in the rejection of its bid.

### 3.0 AMENDMENT OF BIDDING DOCUMENTS:

- 3.1 At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids, the company may, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective Bidder, modify the Bidding Documents by the issuance of an Addendum.
- 3.2 *The Addendum will be uploaded in the OIL's e-portal in the C-folder under the tab "Amendments to Tender Documents" only. However, Addendum shall be neither published in news paper nor sent to any of the participating Bidders. The company may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for bid submission, if the Bidders are expected to require additional time in which to take the Addendum into account in preparation of their bid or for any other reason. Bidders shall also check OIL's E-Tender portal [C-folder under the tab "Amendments to Tender Documents"] for any amendments to the bid documents before submission of their bids.*

### 4.0 PREPARATION OF BIDS

#### 4.1 LANGUAGE OF BIDS:

The bid as well as all correspondence and documents relating to the bid exchanged between the Bidder and the company shall be in English language, except that any printed literature may be in another language provided it is accompanied by an English translated version, which shall govern for the purpose of bid interpretation.

#### 4.2 BIDDER'S NAME & ADDRESS:

Bidders should indicate in their bids their detailed postal address including the Fax/Telephone / Cell Phone Nos. and E-mail address.

### 5.0 DOCUMENTS COMPRISING THE BID:

- 5.1 Bids are invited under **Single Stage- Single bid System**. The bid along with all Annexure and copies of documents should be submitted in e-form only through OIL's e-bidding engine. The price bids submitted in physical form against procurement tenders shall not be given any cognizance. However the following documents should necessarily be submitted in physical form in sealed envelope superscribed as "Tender Number and due for opening on \_\_\_\_\_" The outer cover of the sealed envelope should duly

5.2 **Envelope:**

- i) Containing Valid and proper Bid Security in Original as per **Clause 10.0** and should reach the office of Chief Manager (Contracts) before Bid closing date and time, otherwise Bid will be rejected. ***A scanned copy of this document should also be uploaded along with the Un-priced (Technical) bid documents.***
- ii) Any other document required to be submitted in original as per tender requirement.

Documents sent through E-mail/Fax/Telex/Telegraphic/Telephonic will not be considered.

5.3 **E- FORM FOR ONLINE SUBMISSION:**

5.3.1 **TECHNICAL BID (Un-Priced)** comprise of the following:

- i) Containing Certificate of Compliance in respect of BRC of the Bid Document as per **Part-II**.
- ii) Complete technical details of the services and equipment specifications with catalogue, etc
- iii) Documentary evidence established in accordance with clause 9.0 of this section.
- iv) Copy of Bid Security furnished in accordance with clause 10.0 of this section.
- vi) ***Copy of signed Bid document without indicating prices.***

5.3.2 **COMMERCIAL/PRICE BID** comprising of following:

Bidder shall quote their prices in the following Proforma and shall upload the same in the OIL's E-Portal:

- (i) Price-Bid Format as per **Proforma-A**
- (ii) Bid Form as per **Proforma -B**

The Priced Bid shall contain the prices along with the currency quoted and any other commercial information pertaining to the service offered.

**NOTE:**

Only **Envelope** mentioned in **clause 5.2 above** shall be submitted to Office of Chief Manager (Contracts), Oil India Ltd, Guwahati within Bid Closing Date and **TECHNICAL BID & COMMERCIAL / PRICE BID** shall be submitted through e-tendering process.

**6.0 BID FORM:**

*The bidder shall complete the Bid Form and the appropriate Price Schedule furnished in their Bid.*

**7.0 BID PRICE:**

7.1 *Unit prices must be quoted by the bidders both in words and in figures.*

7.2 Price quoted by the successful bidder must remain firm during its performance of the Contract and is not subject to variation on any account.

7.3 All duties and taxes including VAT, Service tax, Contract Tax, Corporate income Taxes and other levies payable by the successful bidder under the Contract for which this Bidding Document is being issued, shall be included in the rates, prices and total Bid Price submitted by the bidder, and the evaluation and comparison of bids shall be made accordingly. For example, personal taxes and/or any corporate taxes arising out of the profits on the contract as per rules of the country shall be borne by the bidder.

**8.0 CURRENCIES OF BID AND PAYMENT:**

8.1 Bid currency and payment shall be INR.

**9.0 DOCUMENTS ESTABLISHING BIDDER'S ELIGIBILITY AND QUALIFICATIONS:**

These are listed in **Part-II** of the document.

**10.0 SIGNING OF BID:**

10.1 Bids are to be submitted online through OIL's E-procurement portal with digital signature. The bid and all attached documents should be digitally signed by the bidder using "Class 3" digital certificates with Organizations Name [e-commerce application (Certificate with personal verification and Organisation Name)] as per Indian IT Act 2000 obtained from the licensed Certifying Authorities operating under the Root Certifying Authority of India(RCAI), Controller of Certifying Authorities(CCA) of India before bid is uploaded.

If any modifications are made to a document after attaching digital signature, the digital signature shall again be attached to such documents before uploading the same. The Power of Attorney in original shall be submitted by bidder as mentioned in **Para 5.2(ii) above**.

The authenticity of above digital signature shall be verified through authorized CA after bid opening and in case the digital signature is not of "Class-3" with organization name, the bid will be rejected.

Bidder is responsible for ensuring the validity of digital signature and it's proper usage by their employees.

- 10.2 ***The original and all copies of the bid shall be typed or written in indelible inks and shall be signed by the Bidder or a person or persons duly authorised to bind the Bidder to the contract. The letter of authorisation (as per Proforma-H) shall be accompanying the Bid. All pages of the Bid, drawings and other accompanying documents except for un-amended printed literature, shall be initialed by the person or persons signing the Bid Document.***
- 10.3 Any person signing the Bid or any other document in respect of this Bid Document or other relevant documents on behalf of the Bidder without disclosing his authority to do so shall be deemed to have the authority to bind the Bidder. If it is discovered at any time that the person so signing has no authority to do so, the Company (OIL) may, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, cancel his Bid or Contract and hold the Bidder liable to the Company(OIL) for all costs and damages arising from the cancellation of the Bid or Contract including any loss which the Company(OIL) may sustain on account thereof.
- 10.4 ***Any physical documents submitted by bidders shall contain no interlineations, white fluid erasures or overwriting except as necessary to correct errors made by the Bidder, in which case such correction shall be initialed by the person or persons who has/have digitally signed the Bid.***
- 10.5 Any Bid, which is incomplete, ambiguous, or not in compliance with the Bidding process will be rejected.

#### **11.0 BID SECURITY:**

- 11.1 Pursuant to clause 5.0 the Bidder shall furnish as part of its Technical bid, Bid Security for an amount of **Rs.27,700.00 ( Rupees Twenty Seven Thousand Seven Hundred only)**
- 11.2 The Bid Security is required to protect the Company against the risk of Bidder's conduct, which would warrant the security's forfeiture, pursuant to sub-clause **11.7**.
- 11.3 The Bid Security shall be denominated in the currency of the bid or another freely convertible currency, and shall be in one of the following form:
- (a) A Bank Guarantee in the prescribed format vides **Proforma-C** or in another form acceptable to the Company issued by any Scheduled Bank in India.

The Bank Guarantee shall be valid for 30 days beyond the validity of the bids asked for in the Bid Document.

***Bank Guarantees issued by Banks in India should be on non-judicial stamp paper of requisite value, as per Indian Stamp Act, purchased in the name of the Banker.***

- (b) A Cashier's cheque or Demand Draft drawn on 'Oil India Limited' valid for 180 days from the date of issue and payable at Guwahati, Assam.

11.4 **Any bid not secured in accordance with sub-clause 11.1 and /or 11.3 shall be rejected by the Company as non-responsive.**

11.5 Unsuccessful Bidder's Bid Security will be discharged and/or returned within 30 days of expiry of the period of bid validity.

11.6 Successful Bidder's Bid Security will be discharged upon the Bidder's signing of the contract and furnishing the performance security.

11.7 The Bid Security may be forfeited:

- a) If any Bidder withdraws or modifies their bid during the period of bid validity (including any subsequent extension)

**or**

- b) If a successful Bidder fails:

i) **to sign the contract within stipulated reasonable time & within the period of bid validity, and/or**

ii) to furnish the Performance Security.

11.8 ***In case any bidder withdraws their bid during the period of bid validity, Bid Security will be forfeited and the party shall be debarred for a period of 2(two) year to participate any future tender.***

11.9 **Micro & small Enterprises (MSME) ,Small Scale Industries (SSI) registered with NSIC under Single Point Registration Scheme ,Central Govt. offices , Central Public Sector undertakings are exempted from submitting Bid Security.**

## **12.0 PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF BIDS:**

12.1 Bids shall remain valid for **90 days** after the date of bid opening (technical) prescribed by the Company.

12.2 In exceptional circumstances, the Company may solicit the Bidder's consent to an extension of the period of validity. The request and the response thereto shall be made in writing/email (or by Fax). The bid Security provided under **Clause 11.0** shall also be suitably extended. A Bidder may refuse the request without forfeiting its Bid Security. A Bidder granting the request will neither be required nor permitted to modify their bid.

12.3 Bid Security shall not accrue any interest during its period of validity or extended validity.

**13.0** All the conditions of the contract to be made with the successful bidder are given in various Sections of this document. Bidders are requested to state their compliance/ non-compliance to each clause as per **Proforma-F**.

**14.0** Timely delivery of the bids is the responsibility of the Bidder. Company shall not be responsible for any delay.

**15.0 DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF BIDS:**

Bids must be received by the company within Bid Closing Date as specified in the “Forwarding Letter”.

**16.0 LATE BIDS:**

Any Bid received by the Company after the deadline for submission of bids prescribed by the Company shall be rejected.

**17.0 MODIFICATION AND WITHDRAWAL OF BIDS:**

17.1 The Bidder after submission of bid may withdraw its bid by written notice prior to bid closing.

17.2 The Bidder's withdrawal notice shall be prepared sealed, marked and dispatched in accordance with the provisions of **Clause 5.1**. A withdrawal notice may also be sent by fax but followed by a signed confirmation copy, postmarked not later than the deadline for submission of bids.

**19.0 FURNISHING FRAUDULENT INFORMATION/DOCUMENTS:**

If it is found that a bidder/contractor has furnished fraudulent information / documents, the Bid Security/Performance Security shall be forfeited and the party shall be debarred for a period of 3(three) years from the date of detection of such fraudulent act besides the legal action.

**20.0 OPENING AND EVALUATION OF BID:**

For purpose of these paragraphs, a substantially responsive bid is one, which conforms to all the terms and conditions of the Bidding Document without deviations or reservation. A deviation or reservation is one which affects in any way substantial way the scope, quality, or performance of work, or which limits in any substantial way, in-consistent way with the bidding documents, the Company's right or the bidder's obligations under the contract, and the rectification of which deviation or reservation would affect unfairly the competitive position of other bidders presenting substantial responsive bids. The Company's determination of bid's responsiveness is to be based on the contents of the Bid itself without recourse to extrinsic evidence.
- 20.7 A Bid determined as not substantially responsive will be rejected by the Company and may not subsequently be made responsive by the Bidder by correction of the non-conformity.
- 20.8 The Company may waive minor informality or nonconformity or irregularity in a bid, which does not constitute a material deviation, provided such waiver, does not prejudice or affect the relative ranking of any Bidder.

- 1.0 Services of the **Security Personnel** shall be eight (08) hours per day per person
- 2.0 Depending on operational requirement, work may have to be carried out on all days of the year including Sundays and declared Holidays.
- 3.0 **The Security Personnel to be deployed by the contractor, for execution of the required service, must be an Adult and have sound physical and mental health.**
- 4.0 The contractor should have no claim against the company in respect of service which may be withdrawn at any stage and the contractor should be paid only for the duration of the service actually rendered shift wise strictly as per service charges. In case of absorption by OIL or demise of any service personnel the agreement will stand reduced to the balance numbers of service personnel only.
- 5.0 **OBLIGATION OF CONTRACTOR :**
  - 5.1 The Contractor shall maintain liaison with Local Police Stations in connection with filing of FIR and helping Police for investigation (wherever required), to bring improvement in security service wherever contractor security persons deployed.
  - 5.2 Contractor shall have to watch and safeguard Company's property round the clock generally within and around assigned duty areas/sites. At times Contractor may have to deploy the security Personnel / Guards in other areas as decided by the Installation In-Charge if required for operational exigencies. Any loss/damage/theft of Company's property from any assigned areas/sites shall have to be made good at the Contractor's cost in case of occurrence during the period of the area/site being guarded by the Contractor. Also at times the Contractor may be required to deploy the security guards for particular time e.g. 1st shift or 2nd shift or 3rd shift or general shift in any post(s) depending on operational requirement.
  - 5.3 In case any item(s) is lost from the place where contractor security is deployed entire amount will be recovered from the Contractor's Bill. If Contractor recovers the materials, he shall submit necessary certificate from the concerned department duly received by the concerned department who raised the theft reports within 15 days from the date of occurrence of theft and the recovered money will be returned back.
  - 5.4 The Contractor shall be solely responsible for any damage, loss or act of subversion or unlawful activities, which may be caused or committed, by any one of his/her/their workers within Company's establishment during the contractual period.

The name of the Contractor (security agency) shall be prominently visible on the shirt and name of each guard displayed on a name plate pinned to the shirt worn by the security guards. The Contractor must ensure that the security guards turn up on duty with suitable and proper uniform. Any security guards, without afore stated dress shall not be allowed to attend duty. - 5.6 The Contractor shall issue Identity Card/Photo Pass to each security guard as per Company's and Govt. Security Regulatory norms & the security personnel must carry/display the same during working hours. Contractor shall get sample of the uniform approved by the Installation In-Charge before providing the same to his personnel.
- 5.7 Contractor shall deploy one male person per shift per post who must be physically/medically/mentally fit and do not exceed the over age (above superannuation).
- 5.8 The Contractor shall arrange own transport, whenever necessary, for self and the security guards to execute contractual responsibilities.
- 5.9 The contractor shall arrange for Police verification of character and antecedents at his own cost and shall submit the same to the concerned Security officer of the company. The Contractor shall not engage any person as security guard whose Police verification report is found adverse.
- 5.10 All posts are transferable and may be split/re-deployed depending on operational requirement without any prior notice.
- 5.11 The Contractor shall comply with any other instruction which may be issued by the Company from time to time. The number of persons at any of the security posts may be changed from time to time due to operational exigencies to which the contractor shall not object.
- 5.12 The Contractor shall be responsible for ensuring disciplined duty of the security guards. The Contractor shall be solely held responsible for misconduct of any the security guards whatsoever. If lawful authority in connection with any crime, convict any of the contractor's security guards, the Contractor shall immediately remove such person from services.
- 5.13 In case of death of any Security guard of the Contractor, the Contractor shall be responsible for settling down his/her claim and under no circumstances his/her next of kin can claim for deployment in company (OIL) as a Security personnel.
- 5.14 The Contractor shall ensure that security guards do not leave their place of duty under any circumstance till the next reliever reports for duty. Contractor shall be fully responsible for deployment of reliever.
- 5.15 The Contractor shall ensure that security personnel deployed on security duty are properly explained the nature of job and hazards associated with the assigned job in consultation with Installation In-Charge (Installation Manager) or his/her authorised representative. The Contractor shall follow all the HSE guidelines detailed in **clause 15**.
- 5.16 The Contractor shall have a registered office with telephone Number and Mobile Phone. The Contractor shall make available the Office address, telephone number and mobile

number to the Installation In-Charge. The Office address, telephone number and mobile number shall also be available with the security guards.

- 5.17 The Contractor shall maintain the following registers in every post:
- (i) Monthly Duty roster and Shift wise daily attendance of the security guards deployed (one copy should be submitted every month to the Installation In-Charge).

  - (iii) Visitor's register wherever applicable.
  - (iv) Beat book/duty book/diary book by the all contractor security guards on daily basis, details of duty/shift/off etc. The Beat book/Duty book to be carried by the Contractor Security guards always while on duty for showing to the Contractor's supervisor and/or the Installation In-Charge or his/her Representative while checking Duty Post.
- 5.18 The Contractor must obtain 'Entry Permit' from **Manager (Security) PL or GM (CoEES)** of OIL for all the workers to enable them to work inside the installations.
- 5.19 The Contractor shall provide the services as detailed hereof and everything else necessary for the day to day running and maintaining the services in an efficient and adequate manner including, supervision, accommodation at worksite for staff, office etc. The contractor will register himself with appropriate authority before entering into the agreement and should submit all documents to the concerned authority as required by the relevant authorities.
- 5.20 The contractor under this agreement shall be for the area under jurisdiction of **Centre of Excellence premises ,Guwahati** .**The services may however be extended to other areas of company's activities as determined by the company from time to time at the same rates, terms and conditions.**
- 5.21 The contractor shall commence to supply of regular and continuous service at all places as per this agreement on due date specified in the work order. Failure to commence the services will attract penalty as decided by the company.
- 5.22 There is no right to claim by the contractor for Oil India's permanent jobs to his personnel nor his/her next of kin after his/her death even if death during working hours.
- 5.23 The contractor shall be responsible / liable for necessary clearance and any claims thereof which may be required / arise under any of the Government/Statutory regulations, Act, Law, Rules etc. having bearing over obligations under the Contract including engagement of workers directly or indirectly to render the specified services mentioned in the proposed Service Contract.
- 5.24 The contractor shall obtain the necessary clearances like labour license and certificate relating to the statutory requirement as may be necessary, before issuing the work order.

- 5.25 The contractor shall not be entitled to transfer or assign his interest under this agreement to third party.
- 5.26 The contractor should have no claim against the company in respect of service which may be withdrawn at any stage and the contractor should be paid only for the duration of the service actually rendered shift wise strictly as per service charges.
- 5.27 The Contractor shall provide the services as detailed above hereof and everything else necessary for the day to day running and maintaining the services in an efficient and adequate manner including supervision, accommodation at worksite for staff, office etc. The contractor shall be responsible for all taxes (except where otherwise stated), fees, insurance, medical, safety clothing and safety appliances, Provident Fund, license(s) etc. and his rates are inclusive of all such and similar charges and incidental and contingent operations which although not specifically mentioned in this service agreement are necessary for the performance of the service in satisfactory manner and up to the desired standard. **The contractor will register himself with appropriate authority before entering into the agreement and should submit all documents to the concerned authority as required by the relevant authorities.**
- 5.28 The contractor employing 20 (twenty) or more numbers of workmen on any day of the preceding 12 months should be required to obtain requisite license at his cost from the appropriate licensing officer before undertaking any work. The contractor should also observe the rules and regulation framed under the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act. 1970. The liabilities of the Principal employer as fixed by this Act and rules made therein should remain with the Principal employer.
- 5.29 The nature of company's operations envisages frequent shifting of sites/locations from place to place and the service personnel are required at/near the base site of work in the areas of activities of the company. The contractor should have to provide necessary transport to their service personnel to and from base site of the company after their periodical off days.
- 5.30 The contractor must maintain an office nearer to Company location with telephone facility. The contractor should have to provide at his own cost competent resident representative/manager at the sites along with adequate number of assistance(s)/supervisor(s) at different locations of the work for efficient execution of this agreement.
- 5.31 The contractor shall mobilize his personnel as necessary at short notice to undertake the work at any time of the day or night. The contractor's representative/Manager(s) shall be available throughout the duration of the agreement of the site for receiving and complying with any emergency.
- 5.32 The rates stipulated in Schedule of quantities (SOQ) of this agreement are all inclusive **except Service Tax and Provident Fund** and the contractor agrees to perform all incidental and contingent service in a sound and workmanship like manner within the said rates which although not specially mentioned in this agreement but are essential for rendering the service.

- 5.33 The contractor should provide services required throughout the seven days of the week without any interruption.
- 5.34 The contractor is to abide by all safety regulations and fully indemnify the company against injury/loss of life to any of his personnel at any time during the execution of the Agreement. The company shall not be liable for any claim whatsoever on any account.
- 5.35 The contractor shall ensure that all service personnel engaged by him are provided with appropriate protective clothing and safety wears in accordance with regulation of the Indian Oil Mines Regulation, 1984 or latest edition. The service provider shall also ensure that all service personnel engaged are provided with proper uniform as required by the nature of work. In case of noncompliance of the same by the service provider, the company reserves the right (a) not to allow such service personnel to work and (b) to provide necessary protective clothing and safety gears to the contractor's service personnel and recover the cost of the same from the contractor.
- 5.36 The contractor shall ensure careful handling of the company's and third party/parties material/equipment and the contractor shall be responsible for any loss/damage caused willfully to such material/equipment. The total cost of the item lost/damaged inclusive of incidental charges shall be recovered from the contractor by the company.
- 5.37 All service personnel deployed by the contractor in various works in sensitive areas must have proper Identity Cards with photographs duly countersigned by the authorized representative of the company.
- 5.38 The contractor should agree to provide related transport, safety gears, medical facilities and employee's contribution of Provident Fund etc. to their workmen at their cost at any location of work.
- 5.39 The contractor shall provide necessary insurance coverage of his service personnel against all risks and claims which will hold the company harmless for any action from the service personnel in case of any accident/mishap etc.
- 5.40 The service personnel engaged by the contractor, if found guilty of misconduct or misbehaviors, he/she shall be replaced by contractor on the same day but the alternate personnel will be supplied only by the company, no opinion, suggestion or any personnel supplied by the contractor would not be granted and entertained by the company. The opinion of the authorized officer of the company in this respect shall be final and shall be binding on the contractor.
- 5.41 The contractor should abide by all Labour Laws and other contractual provisions as per agreement connected with Central and State Government. This inter alias will include Factories Act, Mines Act, Payment of Wages Act, Minimum Wages Act and Contract Labour (R & A) Act Workman's Compensation Act, 1923 and The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965. The contractor should have to register himself with appropriate authority before entering in the agreement and should submit all documents to the concerned authority as required by the relevant authorities.
- 5.42 The contractor shall not be entitled to transfer or assign his interest under this agreement to third party.

- 5.43 It will be the responsibility of the contractor to arrange transportation of his employees. In case, any time service personnel of the contractor is/are traveling in company's vehicle due availability of space and the vehicle meet with an accident, the company shall have no responsibility or obligation in respect of any loss/injury sustained by such employee(s) of the service provider due to the accident and any claims whatsoever arising there from.
- 5.44 The contractor should ensure observation of working hours and provision of rest days to the service personnel and other requirement under the existing laws.
- 5.45 The contractor should have to ensure observation of working hours and provision of rest days to the service personnel and other requirement under the existing laws.
- 5.46 Each **Security Personnel** engaged under this contract shall have adequate insurance coverage under workmen compensation Act, 1923 for the entire duration of the contract. The amount of coverage and premium thereof will be intimated by the Company's authorized personal. The premium amount will be reimbursed by the Company on producing the documentary evidence.
- 5.47 Contractor has to arrange Personal Health Check-up of each **Security Personnel** deployed under this contract as and when advised by the Company. The required medical tests for each eligible **Security Personnel** shall be intimated by the Company and cost thereof will be reimbursed by Company.
- 5.48 In case of absence of any **Security Personnel** and thereby necessitating replacement, Contractor with prior permission engaged a suitable replacement and payment to such replaced **Security Personnel** will be as per wages applicable for **Security Personnel** as mentioned in the contract document.

6.0 **POWERS OF COMPANY OFFICER /AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE:**

- 6.1 The services shall be to the satisfaction of the company's officer who shall have powers, amongst other, to:-
- i) Advise the contractor to remove immediately cause of unsatisfactory performance of the service.
  - ii. Advise the contractor from time to time such further instructions as shall be necessary for the purpose of proper and adequate rendering of the service and for keeping such records as are deemed necessary by the company. Non compliance of the instructions will make the contractor liable for liquidated damage/penalty as determined by the company.
- 6.2 In the event the contractor fails to render the services in most efficient and workman like manner under his supervision, the company reserves the right to obtain the services from any other agency at Contractor's risk and cost. The difference of higher cost, if any, will be recoverable from the contractor's outstanding bills or his security deposit.

- 6.3 The company reserves the right to increase or decrease the number of service personnel under any or both the categories of services. Further, the service provider will also be required to provide extra hourly services under any or both the categories beyond normal working hours as notified by the company but without any extra handling/service charges.

7.0 **PENALTY:**

The contractor shall commence to supply of regular and continuous service at all places as per this agreement on due date specified in the work order. Failure to commence the services will attract penalty and decision of the company in this regard will be final and binding.

8.0 **TERMINATION:**

- 8.1 In the event of contractor failure to commence the services within stipulated period or to render proper services as per terms of this agreement (including the extended period, if any), the company reserves the right to terminate this agreement wholly or partially, with 7(seven) days notice in writing and on the expiry of this notice period this service agreement shall stand terminated and the contractor shall not be entitled to any damage or compensation on account of such termination or otherwise from any cause arising whatsoever.
- 8.2 The company reserves the right to terminate this agreement any time with **7 (seven) days** notice for contractor's failure to provide full time supervisors any day in a month during continuance of the Agreement. Supervisors must report to the in-charge of the services of the company daily in the morning at 07:00 hrs on all working days for necessary instruction, if any.
- 8.3 The company will assess the performance of the contractor regularly for regular payment to their employees and rendering proper services, failing which the company will have the option to terminate the agreement.
- 8.4 The company also reserves the right to terminate the agreement for failure on the part of the contractor of this agreement due to the following reasons:
- a) Poor interpersonal relationship
  - b) Poor monitoring and follow-up.
  - c) Improper and untimely payment to their service personnel.
  - d) Poor dealing with their service personnel/employees.

9.0 **DURATION OF THE CONTRACT:**

The duration of the contract will be for a period of **3 (Three) years**.

10.0 **PERFORMANCE SECURITY DEPOSIT:**

- 10.1 Contractor shall be required to furnish an amount equivalent to **7.5% of the annualized contract value** as **Performance Security Deposit** within two weeks of notification of award of contract and before signing of the formal contract. The Performance Security Deposit may be in the form of a Bank Guarantee issued by a Nationalized Bank, and shall remain valid for **three** more months beyond validity of the contract. A copy of the Bank Guarantee format is enclosed as **Annexure –D**

- 10.2 The Performance Bank Guarantee will be discharged after successful completion of the contract and subsequent extensions if any. In the event of default in the execution of the contract by the contractor as per the terms and conditions of the contract, OIL will invoke the Bank Guarantee either in part or in full.
- 10.3 The proceeds of the Performance security shall be payable to Oil India Limited as compensation for any loss resulting from the contractors failure to complete his obligations under the contract.
- 10.4 The Performance Security will not accrue any interest.

11.0 **PAYMENT TERMS :**

- 11.1 The company shall make payment, subject to adjustment/deduction of TDS as necessary for the service, rendered in each calendar month before the 7<sup>th</sup> day of the subsequent calendar month on the basis of rates finalized by OIL and as mentioned in SOQ of this service agreement, provided bills which are to be submitted by the service provider are received not later than end day of subsequent calendar month. However, due to unforeseen delay from the company, the contractor should pay the wages to his labours from his end within 7<sup>th</sup> day of every month.
- 11.2 Wages should be paid regularly in presence of authorized representative of company within 7<sup>th</sup> of following month by the contractor to the service personnel directly without the intervention of any middleman and that the contractor should ensure that no amount by way of commission or otherwise is deducted or recovered from the wages of the service personnel. In case the company receives any complaint from the service personnel deployed by the contractor the company shall be at liberty to take any action as deemed fit.
- 11.3 Payment to the contractor against the contract would be done on reimbursement basis. The company will also reimburse to the contractor for any overtime work required to be done by the labours as per rules. However, extra handling/Service charges for overtime hours shall not be applicable for which the contractor should not have any objection.
- 11.4 The contractor will be required to pay the arrear wages to his service personnel due to the Ex-Post-Facto revision of wages which will be reimbursed by the company. The contractor is also required to deposit the arrear **Provident Fund/ESI etc.** with the Government Authorities due to Ex. Post-Facto revision of Wages/Rates. The company will reimburse such arrear wages/deposits to the contractor.
- 11.5 The contractor must make payment duly witnessed by authorized representative of company to his service personnel under the agreement by 7<sup>th</sup> of every following month irrespective of payment of his bill by the company.
- 11.6 The transportation cost of service personnel included in the rates for service personnel is excluding of work to be undertaken on the instance of the company (OIL) at places outside the works sphere specified.

12.0 **FORCE MAJUERE:**

- 12.1 In the event of either party being rendered unable by 'Force Majeure' to perform any obligation required to be performed by them under the contract, the relative obligation of the party affected by such 'Force Majeure' will stand suspended as provided herein. The word 'Force Majeure' as employed herein shall mean acts of God, war, revolt, agitation, strikes, riot, fire, flood, sabotage, civil commotion, road barricade (but not due to interference of employment problem of the Contractor) and any other cause, whether of kind herein enumerated or otherwise which are not within the control of the party to the contract and which renders performance of the contract by the said party impossible.
- 12.2 Upon occurrence of such cause and upon its termination, the party alleging that it has been rendered unable as aforesaid thereby, shall notify the other party in writing within **Seventy Two (72) hours** of the alleged beginning and ending thereof, giving full particulars and satisfactory evidence in support of its claim.
- 12.3 Should 'force majeure' condition as stated above occurs and should the same be notified within **seventy two (72) hours** after its occurrence the 'force majeure' rate shall apply for a maximum cumulative period of fifteen days. Either party will have the right to terminate the Contract if such 'force majeure' condition continues beyond fifteen (15) days with prior written notice. Should either party decide not to terminate the Contract even under such condition, no payment would apply after expiry of fifteen (15) days force majeure period unless otherwise agreed to.

13.0 **SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES :**

- 13.1 The service provider and the company shall make every effort to resolve amicably by direct informal negotiation at any disagreement arising between them under or in connection with the contract agreement.
- 13.2 In the event of any disagreement or dispute arising in connection with execution of the agreement which can not be settled in an amicable manner between the service provider and the company, the matter shall be referred to Arbitration. Such arbitration shall be governed by the provisions of the **Rules of Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996** as amended upto date by any statutory modification or reenactment thereof for the time being in force. The award made in pursuance thereof shall be binding on the parties. **The venue of arbitration will be Guwahati, Assam.**

14.0 **AMENDMENTS :**

Amendments to any terms and conditions of this agreement, if any, can be carried out only through an "Amendment to Agreement" duly signed by authorized representative of the company and contractor.

15.0 **SAFETY, HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT :**

- 15.1 It will be solely the contractor's responsibility to fulfill all the legal formalities with respect to the Safety, Health and Environmental aspects of the entire job (namely, the person employed by him, the equipment, the environment etc.) under the jurisdiction of the district of that state where it is operating.

- 15.2 Every person deployed by the contractor in a mine must wear safety gadgets to be provided by the contractor. The contractor shall provide proper personnel protective equipment as per the hazard identified and risk assessed for the job and conforming to statutory requirement and company Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) schedule. Safety appliances like protective footwear, Safety Helmet and Full Body harness has to be Director General Mines Safety (DGMS) approved. Necessary supportive document shall have to be submitted as proof. If the contractor fails to provide the safety items as mentioned above to the working personnel, the contractor may apply to the company (OIL) for providing the same. OIL will provide the safety items, if available. But in turn, OIL will recover the actual cost of the items by deducting from contractor's Bill. However, it will be contractor's sole responsibility to ensure that the persons engaged by him in the mines use proper PPE while at work. All the safety gears mentioned above are to be provided to the working personnel before commencement of the work.
- 15.3 The contractor shall prepare written Safe Operating Procedure (SOP) for the work to be carried out, including an assessment of risk, wherever possible and safe methods to deal with it/them. The SOP should clearly state the risk arising to men, machine and material from the mining operation/operations to be done by the contractor and how it is to be managed.
- 15.4 The contractor shall provide a copy of the SOP to the person designated by the mine owner who shall be supervising the contractor's work.
- 15.5 Keep an up to date SOP and provide a copy of changes to a person designated by the Mine Owner/Agent/Manager.
- 15.6 All persons deployed by the contractor for working in a mine must undergo Mines Vocational Training, Initial Medical Examination, Periodical Medical Examination. They should be issued cards stating the name of the service provider and the work and its validity period, indicating status MVT, IME and PME.
- 15.7 The contractor should be submitted to DGMS returns indicating name of his firm, Registration number, Name and address of person heading the firm, Nature of work, type of deployment of work persons, Number of work persons deployed, how many work persons hold Vertigo Test Certificate, how many work persons undergone IME and type of medical coverage given to the work persons.
- 15.8 It will be entirely the responsibility of the contractor/his supervisor/representative to ensure strict adherence to all Safety, Health and Environment measures and statutory rules during operation in OIL's installations and safety of workers engaged by him. The crew members will not refuse to follow any instruction given by company's installation Manager/Safety Officer/Engineer/Official/Supervisor/Junior Engineer for safe operation.
- 15.9 Any compensation arising out of the job carried out by the service provider whether related to pollution, safety or health will be paid by the contractor only.
- 15.10 Any compensation arising due to accident of the contractor's personnel while carrying out the job will be payable by the contractor only.

- 15.11 The contractor should have to report all incidents including near miss to Installation Manager/Departmental representative of the concerned department of OIL.
- 15.12 The contractor has to keep a register of the persons employed by him/her. The contractor's supervisor shall take and maintain attendance of his men every day for the work, punctually.
- 15.13 If the company arranges any safety or other class/training for the working personnel at site (company employee, contractor worker, etc) the contractor should not have any objection for such training provided to his personnel.
- 15.14 The health check-up of contractor's personnel is to be done by the contractor in authorized Health Centers as per OIL's requirement and proof of such test(s) is to be submitted to OIL. The frequency of periodic medical examinations should be every five years for the workers below 45 years of age and every three years for workers of above 45 years of age.
- 15.15 The contractor has to arrange daily tool box meeting, regular site safety meetings and maintain all records etc.
- 15.16 Records of daily attendance, accident report etc. are to be maintained ~~in form B, E and J (as per Mines rules 1955)~~ by the contractor. Also this is entirely the contractor's responsibility to maintain all registers as per statutory norms.
- 15.17 A contractor's worker must, while at work, take reasonable care for the health and safety of people who are at the worker, place of work and who may be affected by the worker act or omissions at work.
- 15.18 A contractor's personnel must, while at work, co-operate with his or her employer or other persons so far as is necessary to enable compliance with any requirement under the act or the regulations that is imposed in the interest of safety, health and welfare of the personnel or any other person.
- 15.19 Contractor's arrangements for health and safety management shall be consistent with those for the mine owner.
- 15.20 In case contractor is found non-compliant of SHE laws as required, company will have the right for directing the service provider to take action to comply with the requirements and for further non-compliance, the contractor will be penalized prevailing relevant Acts/Rules/Regulations.
- 15.21 When there is a significant risk to safety, health and environment of a person or place arising because of a non-compliance of SHE measures company will have the right to direct the contractor to cease work until the non-compliance is corrected.
- 15.22 The contractor should frame a mutually agreed bridging document between OIL and the contractor with roles and responsibilities clearly defined.
- 15.23 For any Safety Health & Environment (SHE) matters not specified in this contract document, the contractor will abide the relevant and prevailing Acts/Rules/Regulations pertaining to Health, Safety and Environment.

- 15.24 Contractor has to ensure that all work is carried out in accordance with the Statute and SOP and for the purpose he may deploy adequate qualified and competent personnel for the purpose of carrying out the job in a safe manner. For work of a specified scope/nature, he should develop and provide to the mine owner a site specific code of practice in line .
- 15.25 The return shall be submitted quarterly (by 10th of April, July, October & January) for contracts of more than one year. However, for contracts of less than one year, returns shall be submitted monthly.
- 15.26 The contractor should prevent the frequent change of his contractual employees as far as practicable.

16.0 **WAGES AND OTHER BENEFIT TO SECURITY PERSONNEL :**

The **Security Personnel** who are being engaged shall be entitled to the following wages and benefits:

Wages: To be paid as per the following rates:

- a) `298.00 per day to **Security Personnel** without Arms category.
- b) ` 37.25 per hour over time for working beyond 8 hrs normal working hrs for **Security Personnel** without Arms category.  
  
{Above rate is inclusive of Regional Labour Commissioner (RLC) Central rate, as per OIL's circular No. **PL/ER/05-03/16/2059 of 12-04-2016** other allowance (as applicable), Co's Contribution, House Rent and **exclusive of PF ,Contractor's Commission and Service Tax as applicable**)
- c) **Contractors are advised to quote only on % (percentage) parameter as commission on the above rate and the total commission amount to the contractor will be calculated based on above rates.**
- d) These **Security Personnel** are also entitled for enhanced rate as and when revised by RLC and as advice by the department and should be disbursed accordingly. Such enhancement will be reimbursed by OIL.
- e) The contractor should have to ensure payment of wages to the Security Personnel by contractors within 7<sup>th</sup> day of every month.
- f) **Provident Fund:** Company will pay the employer's contribution of Provident Fund amount @ 12% of the prevailing RLC rate for wage of eligible labour.
- g) Leave with wages: **Security Personnel** will be granted 03 National Holidays (if not Sunday or Holiday) and will be granted 3 (three) festival Holidays per annum ( i.e. Magh Bihu-1 day, Bohag Bihu-1day and Dasserah-1day) (Calendar year).

- h) Weekly Rest Day Wages: The intervening national and festival holidays shall be deemed to be the working days for the purpose of calculation of six consecutive working days in order to be eligible for the weekly rest day wages, provided the contract labour concerned is present on other working days of the week.
- i) Overtime: Overtime shall be paid to the **Security Personnel** as and when they are made to work on overtime above the 8 hours normal working hours.

17.0 **BILLING CYCLE**: Payment will be on monthly basis and the billing cycle will be on completion of each month. Contractor should submit his bills in triplicate to the sectional head of concerned section.

18.0 **Contractor should have to ensure that the applicable wages are disbursed to the identified Security Personnel after deducting Provident Fund (employee's contribution) @ 12% of RLC rate which would be deposited to Provident Fund office and documentary evidence in the form of statutory payment of wages sheet should be submitted to the concerned section along with bill in triplicate.**

19.0 Impersonation will be taken care by law of the land. Income Tax (TDS) at the applicable rate will be deducted at source on the total contract amount of the contract for which TDS certificate will be issued as per law.

20.0 Daily wages will be based on 8 (eight) hours a day including Saturday.

21.0 The payment, however, shall be made on actual and on pro-rata basis.

22.0 Contractor(s) whosoever is liable to be covered under the Provident Fund (P.F.) Act and contract cost is inclusive P.F. must ensure strict compliance of provisions of Provident Fund and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 in addition to the various Acts mentioned elsewhere in this contract. Any contractor found violating these provision will render themselves disqualified from any future tendering. As per terms of the contract, if applicable, the Contractor must deposit Provident Fund Contribution (Covering Employee's & Employer's share) with the competent authority month under their direct code. The Contractor shall be required to submit documentary evidence of deposit of P.F. Contribution to the Company. In case of failure to provide such documentary evidence, the Company reserves the right to withhold the amount equivalent to 12% P.F. contribution on wage component.

23.0 **Contractor should have to ensure that the applicable wages are disbursed to the identified Listed/unlisted WCLs/Security Personnel/Watch and Ward after deducting Provident Fund (employee's contribution) @ 12% of RLC rate. For Unlisted WCL Contractor has to deposit the total PF amount (OIL's contribution + WCL Contribution) to the Concern Provident Fund office and documentary evidence in the form of statutory payment of wages sheet should be submitted to the concerned section along with bill in triplicate. Contractor shall not be paid any extra commission for depositing the PF amount to concerned Provident Fund office.**

24.0 **SET OFF CLAUSE**:

5.0 Contractor will deploy one male person per shift per post who must be physically/medically/mentally fit and do security duty not exceed the over age 50 years.

6.0 No Transport, whatsoever shall be provided to Contractor or to his personnel security to execute contractual job.

7.0 The Contractor will arrange for Police verification of character and antecedents of the persons engaged by him under the contract as per the system and procedure of the Govt. Security Regulations and submit the reports to Head CoEES Office positively prior to their deployment and if not, due to any reason positively within three months of commencement of the contract. **Preamble:**

The Principal intends to award, under laid down organizational procedures, contract/s for Tender No. \_\_\_\_\_. The Principal values full compliance with all relevant laws and regulations, and the principles of economic use of resources, and of fairness and transparency in its relations with its Bidder/s and Contractor/s. In order to achieve these goals, the Principal cooperates with the renowned international Non-Governmental Organisation "Transparency International" (TI). Following TI's national and international experience, the Principal will appoint an external independent Monitor who will monitor the tender process and the execution of the contract for compliance with the principles mentioned above.

**SECTION 1 - COMMITMENTS OF THE PRINCIPAL:**

- 1.0 The Principal commits itself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption and to observe the following principles:-
- a) No employee of the Principal, personally or through family members, will in connection with the tender for, or the execution of a contract, demand, take a promise for or accept, for him / herself or third person, any material or immaterial benefit which he/she is not legally entitled to.
  - b) The Principal will, during the tender process treat all Bidders with equity and reason. **SECTION 2 - COMMITMENTS OF THE BIDDER/CONTRACTOR:**

- 1.0 The Bidder / Contractor commit itself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption. He commits himself to observe the following principles during his participation in the tender process and during the contract execution.

2. The Bidder/Contractor will not instigate third persons to commit offences outlined above or be an accessory to such offences.

**SECTION 3 - DISQUALIFICATION FROM TENDER PROCESS AND EXCLUSION FROM FUTURE CONTRACTS:**

If the Bidder, before contract award has committed a transgression through a violation of Section 2 or in any other form such as to put his reliability or risibility as Bidder into question, the Principal is entitled to disqualify the Bidder from the tender process or to terminate the contract, if already signed, for such reason.

The Bidder accepts and undertakes to respect and uphold the Principal's Absolute right to resort to and impose such exclusion and further accepts and undertakes not to challenge or question such exclusion on any ground, including the lack of any hearing before the decision to resort to such exclusion is taken. This undertaking is given freely and after obtaining independent legal advice.
3. If the Bidder / Contractor can prove that he has restored/recouped the Damage caused by him and has installed a suitable corruption prevention system, the Principal may revoke the exclusion prematurely.
4. A transgression is considered to have occurred if in light of available evidence no reasonable doubt is possible.

#### **SECTION 4 - COMPENSATION FOR DAMAGES:**

1. If the Principal has disqualified the Bidder from the tender process prior to the award according to Section 3, the Principal is entitled to demand and recover from the Bidder liquidated damages equivalent to 3 % of the value of the offer or the amount equivalent to Earnest Money Deposit/Bid Security, whichever is higher.
2. If the Principal has terminated the contract according to Section 3, or if the Principal is entitled to terminate the contract according to section 3, the Principal shall be entitled to demand and recover from the Contractor liquidated damages equivalent to 5% of the contract value or the amount equivalent to Security Deposit / Performance Bank Guarantee, whichever is higher.
3. 2. The Monitor is not subject to instructions by the representatives of the parties and performs his functions neutrally and independently. He reports to the Chairperson of the Board of the Principal.
3. The Contractor accepts that the Monitor has the right to access without restriction to all Project documentation of the Principal including that provided by the Contractor. The Contractor will also grant the Monitor, upon his request and demonstration of a valid interest, unrestricted and unconditional access to his project documentation. The same is applicable to Subcontractors. The Monitor is under contractual obligation to treat the information and documents of the Bidder/ Contractor/ Subcontractor with confidentiality
4. The Principal will provide to the Monitor sufficient information about all meetings among the parties related to the Project provided such meetings could have an impact on the contractual relations between the Principal and the Contractor. The parties offer to the Monitor the option to participate in such meetings.
5. As soon as the Monitor notices, or believes to notice, a violation of this agreement, he will so inform the Management of the Principal and request the Management to discontinue or heal the violation, or to take other relevant action. The monitor can in this regard submit non-binding recommendations. Beyond this, the Monitor has no right to demand from the parties that they act in a specific manner, refrain from action or tolerate action.
6. The Monitor will submit a written report to the Chairperson of the Board of the Principal within 8 to 10 weeks from the date of reference or intimation to him by the 'Principal' and, should the occasion arise, submit proposals for correcting problematic situations.
7. If the Monitor has reported to the Chairperson of the Board a substantiated suspicion of an offence under relevant Anti-Corruption Laws of India, and the Chairperson has not, within reasonable time, taken visible action to proceed against such offence or reported it to the

Vigilance Office, the Monitor may also transmit this information directly to the Central Vigilance Commissioner, Government of India.

8. The word 'Monitor' would include both singular and plural.

It expires for the Contractor 12 months after the last payment under the respective contract, and for all other Bidders 6 months after the contract has been awarded. If any claim is made/ lodged during this time, the same shall be binding and continue to be valid despite the lapse of this pact as specified above, unless it is discharged/determined by Chairperson of the Principal.

**SECTION 10 - OTHER PROVISIONS:**

1. This agreement is subject to Indian Law. Place of performance and jurisdiction is the Registered Office of the Principal, i.e. New Delhi.
