All tenderers shall deposit the requisite EARNEST MONEY along with the Tender in the form of Demand Draft/Banker's Cheque/Bank Guarantee in favour of M/s Oil India Limited and payable at Guwahati. This Earnest Money shall be refunded to all unsuccessful tenderers, but is liable to be forfeited in full or part, at Company's discretion, as per Clause No. 6 below. **Tenders received without Earnest Money in the manner specified above will be summarily rejected.** The bid is to be submitted in **Original**. A copy of the Bank Guarantee (EMD) format is enclosed as **Annexure -A.**

3.0 Tenders will be received upto **01:30 PM (IST)** on the date as mentioned above and opened on the **date as mentioned above** day at **02:00 PM (IST)** at **CHIEF MANAGER(CONTRACTS), Pipeline Head Quarters(PHQ) , Oil India Limited, Guwahati** office before any attending tenderers. Tender box is placed at the office of Chief Manager (Contracts). However, if the above mentioned closing / opening day of the tender happens to be non-working day due to Bundh / Strike or any other reason, the tenders will be received and opened on the following working day at the same time except on Saturdays.

4.0 The rates shall be quoted per unit as specified in the Schedule of Work (Part II) and shall be in words as well as in figures. No overwriting shall be allowed, but all corrections may be inserted in the blank space above the corrected word / figure and must be initialled. However, white fluid

shall not be used for making correction. Any bid not meeting this requirement will be rejected. In case of discrepancy the unit rate quoted in words shall be considerate to be correct.

- 5.0 The Company reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders or accept any tender in full or in part, without assigning any reason.
- 6.0 (a) No Tenderer must withdraw the tender after its public opening. Any such withdrawal will make the tenderer liable of forfeit his/her/their Earnest Money in full and debarred from further tendering at the sole discretion of the company and the period of debarment will not be less than 6(six) months.
- (b) Once a withdrawal letter is received from any bidder, the offer will be treated as withdrawn and no further claim / correspondence will be entertained in this regard.
- 7.0 The tender must be valid for **90 (Ninety)** days from the date of opening of the tender.
- 8.0 Conditional tenders are liable to be rejected at the discretion of the Company.
- 9.0 Tenders can be dropped at the box placed at the office of Contract Department or can be sent by registered post addressed to

- 10.0 The work may be split up amongst more than one contractor at the sole discretion of the Company.
- 11.0 The bidders are required to furnish the composition and status of ownership of the firm in whose name tender documents have been purchased/issued along with one or more of the following documentary evidences(which are applicable to the bidder) in support of the same.
01. In case of Sole Proprietorship Firm-Copies of Telephone/Electricity/Mobile Bill, PAN, latest Income Tax Return indicating therein the name, business and residential address, E-mail and telephone numbers of the owner and copies of Service Tax and Central Excise Registration Certificate.
02. In case of HUF-Copies of Telephone/Electricity/Mobile Bill, PAN, latest Income Tax Return, Family Arrangement indicating therein the name, residential address, E-mail and telephone numbers of the owners in general and Karta in particular and copies of Service Tax and Central Excise Registration Certificate.
03. 04. In case of Co-Operative Societies-Copies of Telephone/Electricity/Mobile Bill, PAN, latest Income Tax Return indicating therein the name, residential address, E-mail and telephone numbers of all the Directors or persons who are at the helm of affairs,

registration certificate from Registrar of Co-Operative Societies and copies of Service Tax and Central Excise Registration Certificate.

05. In case of Societies registered under the Societies Registration Act -Copies of Telephone/Electricity/Mobile Bill, PAN, latest Income Tax Return indicating therein the name, residential address, E-mail and telephone numbers of all the Directors or persons who are at the helm of affairs, registration certificate from the Registrar of the state and copies Service Tax and Central Excise Registration Certificate.
06. In case of Joint Stock Companies registered under the Indian Companies Act - Copies of Telephone/Electricity/Mobile Bill, PAN, latest Income Tax Return indicating therein the name, residential address, E-mail and telephone numbers of all the Directors or persons who are at the helm of affairs, Certificate of Incorporation from the Registrar of Companies, Memorandum and Articles and copies of Service Tax and Central Excise Registration Certificate.
07. In case of Trusts registered under the Indian Trust Act - Copies of Telephone/Electricity/Mobile Bill, PAN, latest Income Tax Return indicating therein the name, residential address, E-mail and telephone numbers of all the Trustee or persons who are at the helm of affairs, registration certificate from the Registrar of the state, Trust Deed and copies Service Tax and Central Excise Registration Certificate.
- 12.0 The selected tenderer will be required to enter into a formal contract, which will be based on their tender i.e O.I.L's Standard Form of Contract.
- 13.0 **PERFORMANCE SECURITY: (NOT APPLICABLE FOR THIS TENDER)**
- 13.1 Successful bidder shall be required to furnish an amount equivalent to **7.5% (initial security deposit along with acceptance of contract is to be deposited for 2.5% and remaining 5% is to be recovered from running account bill)** of the estimated total contract value as Performance Security Deposit within 30 days of notification of award of contract and before signing of the formal contract. In case of default the award of contract may be cancelled and Security deposit forfeited. The Performance Security Deposit may be in the form of Demand Draft / Banker's Cheque/ Bank Guarantee issued by a Nationalized Bank. A copy of the Bank Guarantee format is enclosed as **Annexure –B.**
- 13.2 The performance security and retention money shall be payable to Company as compensation for any loss resulting from Contractor's failure to fulfil its obligations under the Contract.
- 13.3 The performance security in the form of Bank Guarantee as specified above must be valid for **90 (Ninety)** days after the date of expiry of the tenure of the contract to cover the warranty obligations. The same will be discharged by company not later than 30 days following its expiry.
- 13.4 Failure of the successful Bidder to comply with the requirements of **clause 13.1 and /or 13.4** shall constitute sufficient grounds for annulment of the award and forfeiture of the Bid Security. In such an event the Company may award the contract to the next evaluated Bidder or call for new bid or negotiate with the next lowest bidder as then case may be.
- 14.0 The amount of retention money shall be released after expiry of Contractor's performance obligation under this contract. **(NOT APPLICABLE FOR THIS TENDER)**

- 15.0 The work shall have to be started within **7(Seven)Days** from the date of issue of work order.
- 16.0 Time will be regarded as the essence of the Contract and the failure on the part of the Contractor to complete the work within the stipulated time shall entitle the Company to recover liquidate damages and / or penalty from the Contractor as per terms of the tender /contract.
- 17.0 The contractor will be required to allow OIL officials to inspect the work site and documents in respect of the workers payment.

18.0 DISCOUNTS / REBATES:

- 1.1 Unconditional Discounts/ Rebates if any given in the bid or along with bid will be considered for evaluation.
- 1.2 Post bid or conditional discounts / rebates offered by any bidder shall not be considered for evaluation of bids. However, if the lowest bidder happens to be the final acceptable bidder for award of contract and if they have offered any discount/rebate, the contract shall be awarded after taking into consideration such discount / rebate. These provisions shall be incorporated suitably in the Bid Document.

19.0 BACKING OUT BY BIDDER:

In case any bidder withdraws their bid within the bid validity period, Bid Security will be forfeited and the party will be debarred for a period of 2(two) years from the date of withdrawal of bid.

20.0 BACKING OUT BY L-1 BIDDER AFTER ISSUE OF LOA:

In case LOA issued is not accepted by the L1 bidder or the Performance Security is not submitted as per the terms of the contract within the time specified in the Bid Document, the Bid Security shall be forfeited and the bidder shall be debarred for 2(two) years from the date of default.

21.0 FURNISHING FRAUDULENT INFORMATION/DOCUMENT:

If it is found that a Bidder/Contractor has furnished fraudulent document/information, the Bid Security/Performance Security shall be forfeited and the party shall be debarred for period of 3(three) years from date of detection of such fraudulent act, besides the legal action.

22.0 RESPONSIVENESS OF THE BIDS:

The bids shall conform generally to the terms and conditions given in the bidding documents. Notwithstanding the general conformity of the bid, the following requirement under **Bid Rejection criteria (BRC)/ Bid Evaluation Criteria (BEC)** will have to be particularly met by the bidders without which the same will be considered non-responsive and rejected.

BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC) / BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC)

The bid shall conform generally to the specifications and terms and conditions given in the Bidding Documents. Bids will be rejected in case material and services offered do not conform to the required parameters stipulated in the technical specifications. Notwithstanding the general conformity of the bid to the stipulated specifications, the following requirements will have to be particularly met by the Bidders without which the same will be considered as non-responsive and

rejected. All the documents related to BEC/BRC shall be submitted along with the Techno-Commercial Bid.

1.0 Financial capability: Bidders must have:

- (A) Annual financial turnover as per Audited Annual Reports **in any of the preceding three(3) financial years** should be at least **Rs. 1,45,000.00**

FOR CONSORTIUM :

At least one member of the consortium to meet the above criteria of 50% turnover. The other members of consortium should meet minimum 25% turnover requirement.

- (B) Net Worth should be positive for the preceding financial year.
- (C) For proof of Annual Turnover & Net worth any one of the following document must be submitted along with the bid:-
- i) A certificate issued by a practicing Chartered/Cost Accountant (with Membership Number and Firm Registration Number), certifying the Annual turnover & Net worth
- OR**
- ii) Audited Balance Sheet along with Profit & Loss account.

(D) In case the bidder is a Central Govt. Organization/PSU/State Govt. Organization/Semi-State Govt. Organization or any other Central/State Govt. Undertaking, where the auditor is appointed only after the approval of Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the Central Government, their certificates may be accepted even though **FRN (Firm Registration Number)** is not available. However, bidder to provide documentary evidence for the same.

2.0 Experience: Bidders must have:

- 2.1 Experience of having successfully completed **similar works** with CPWD, Railways, APWD, MES, NRL, ONGCL, OIL or any other Government Organization / Public Sector Undertaking in previous **7(seven)** years to be reckoned from the original bid closing date in which applications are invited should be the following :
- (i) Experience of at least **1(one)** similar work of **Rs.2,41,600.00**

Similar Work means:

"Carrying out detailed topographical survey using Total Station and DGPS including preparation of contour map and preparation of digitized map in AutoCAD for any existing township or other areas".

- 2.2 A job executed by a bidder for its own organization / subsidiary cannot be considered as experience for the purpose of meeting BEC.
- 2.3 In case of tenders for Annual rate contracts / Maintenance and Service contracts, if the prospective bidder is executing rate / maintenance /service contract which is

still running and the contract value / quantity executed prior to due date of bid submission is equal to or more than the minimum prescribed value in the BEC such experience will also be taken in to consideration provided that the bidder has submitted satisfactory work / supply / service execution certificate issued by end user.

- 2.4 For proof of requisite experience of SIMILAR work, Job Completion Certificate clearly mentioning Gross value of job done, Nature of works, Contracts period/Contract Start and Completion date issued by CPWD, Railways, APWD, MES, NRL, ONGCL, OIL or any other Government Organization / Public Sector Undertaking must be submitted along with the bid.

All the documents related to BEC must be submitted along with the Techno-Commercial Bid. Otherwise, the bid will be considered as non-responsive and rejected Non-submission of the documents as specified in all the paragraphs above will result in rejection of bids.

3.0 Deviation to the following provision of the tender document shall make the bid liable for rejection:

- i. Firm price
- ii. EMD / Bid Bond
- iii. Scope of work
- iv. Specifications
- v. Price Schedule
- vi. Delivery / Completion Schedule
- vii. Period of Validity of Bid
- viii. Liquidated Damages
- ix. Performance Bank Guarantee / Security deposit
- x. Guarantee of material / work
- xi. Arbitration / Resolution of Dispute
- xii. Force Majeure
- xiii. Applicable Laws
- xiv. Integrity Pact, if applicable
- xv. Any other condition specifically mentioned in the tender documents elsewhere that non-compliance of the clause lead to rejection of the bid.

- 4.0** Bids must be valid for minimum **120** (One Hundred Twenty) days from the date of Technical Bid opening. If bidder does not submit / declare bid validity period, it will be presumed that the bid validity is 120 (one hundred twenty) days.

Note: In case of extension of Bid Opening Date, Bid validity should be extended suitably by the bidder, as and when advised by OIL.

Bid Security must be furnished (except those exempted) as a part of the Technical Bid. The Bid Security (in original) must reach the Office of Chief Manager-Contracts(PL),OIL,Narangi on or before 2:00 p.m. on the bid closing date.

Note:

- (a) In case the Bidder submits Bid security in the form of Bank Guarantee (BG), the BG must be valid for minimum **150** days from the date of Technical bid opening.
- (b) In case of extension of Bid Opening Date, Bid Security validity should be extended suitably by the bidder, as and when advised by OIL.

5. The bidders must submit documentary evidence for BEC clauses. All the documents should be legible.

The rates shall be quoted in figures as well as in words and up to two decimal places only. In case of any discrepancy between rates quoted in figure and words, the rates quoted in words will be considered for evaluation. If any identical situation arises, the L-1 bidder will be decided through draw of lots".

- 6.0 The bids conforming to the specifications, terms and conditions stipulated in the tender documents and considered to be responsive after subjecting to Bid Evaluation Criteria will be considered for further evaluation given below:

- i) To ascertain the inter-se-ranking, the comparison of the responsive bids will be made.
- ii) In case of identical lowest offered rate by more than 1 (one) bidder, the selection of priority-1 and priority-2 bidder will be made by draw of lots amongst the parties offering the same lowest price. The tender shall be awarded to priority-1 bidder only, but if priority-1 bidder fails to accept the LOI/found non-eligible/ fails to execute the job, then Company reserves the right to award the same to priority -2 bidder after taking management approval for the same.
- iii) The Company's Internal Estimated Rates, as indicated are inclusive of all overheads, taxes, duties, levies etc. except P.F. & Service Tax.

- 7.0 Bid security shall be furnished as a part of the Techno Commercial Un-priced Bid. The amount of bid security should be as specified in the NIT. Any bid not accompanied by proper bid security will be summarily rejected.

8. **GENERAL:**

- i. Submission of Forged Documents: Bidders should note that Company may verify authenticity of all the documents /certificates / information submitted by the bidder(s) against the tender. In case at any stage of tendering process or Contract execution etc., if it is established that bidder has submitted forged documents / certificates / information towards fulfillment of any of the tender / contract conditions, Company shall immediately reject the bid of such bidder(s) or cancel / terminate the contract and forfeit EMD / SD submitted by the bidder(s), besides liable for action as per clause no. 9.0 (G).
- ii. In case bidder takes exception to any clause of bidding document not covered under BEC/BRC, then the Company has the discretion to load or reject the offer on account of such exception if the bidder does not withdraw / modify the deviation when / as

advised by company. The loading so done by the Company will be final and binding on the bidders. No deviation will however be accepted in the clauses covered under BRC.

- iii. **To ascertain the substantial responsiveness of the bid the Company reserves the right to ask the bidder for clarification in respect of clauses covered under BEC/BRC also and such clarifications fulfilling the BEC/BRC clauses in toto must be received on or before the deadline given by the company, failing which the offer will be evaluated based on the submission. However, mere submission of such clarification shall not make the offer responsive, unless Company is satisfied with the substantial responsiveness of the offer.**
- iv. If any of the clauses in the BRC contradicts with other clauses of Bidding document elsewhere, the clauses in the BRC shall prevail.
- v. Bidder(s) must note that requisite information/financial values etc. as required in the BEC/BRC & Tender are clearly understandable from the supporting documents submitted by the Bidder(s); otherwise Bids shall be rejected.
- vi. OIL will not be responsible for delay, loss or non-receipt of applications for participating in the bid sent by mail and will not entertain any correspondence in this regard.

9.0

- (A) "The bidders should note that, if 3 (three) or more bidders are found to be technically eligible, no clarification / deficit documents will be sought from the bidders under any circumstances, once the bids are opened and the bids will be evaluated on the basis of documents submitted by the bidders along with the bid".
- (B) The bidder shall also furnish following information / documents along with the bid. Company reserves the right to reject the bid in the event of non-submission of such information / documents.

Wherever applicable, the bidder shall have itself registered under Employees' Provident Fund and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 and follow the relevant statutory provisions including Rules made there-under concerning contractual workers to be engaged by such bidder. The bidder shall furnish the Provident Fund code number issued by the appropriate Govt. Authority, with supporting documents or a declaration / undertaking in stamped paper in the Format.

- (C) The Contractor shall deposit the PAN, VAT, PF code & Service Tax registration number as and when required by the Company.
- (D) The bidder must provide the following minimum numbers of equipment in operational condition capable of providing uninterrupted services under the contract as and when required.

List of equipment: The bidder must own in their own name the following minimum surveying instruments /system. Necessary document in this regard shall be enclosed along with the application

1. Total Station- 1 No.

The contractor shall either own DGPS and latest version of AUTOCAD in their own name or provide a undertaking in this regard for hiring the same from reputed parties.

(E) Before Bidding :

"Bidder(s) are advised to inspect the work site with permission from DGM(O),PS-3,JORHAT with intimation to DGM-Civil(PL) or his representative, to assess the nature and extent of work and the conditions under which it will be carried out.

Bidder(s) should clearly understand all the terms & conditions, criteria, specification etc. of this tender.

(F) Information / List of other works contract, if any, being executed by the bidder(s) in his / her / their firm's name in OIL and expected to continue beyond 6 months time from date of opening of bid document to be furnished to DGM-Civil by all bidders before issuance of work order.

(G) Company reserves the right to debar the bidder / contractor during processing of tender and / or during continuation of the contract on commission or omission on the part of the bidder / contractor as under:

- a. Has indulged in malpractices, bribery, fraud, pilferage.
- b. Is bankrupt or is being dissolved or resolved to be wound up or proceedings for winding up or dissolution have been instituted.
- c. Has furnished false information /statement / declaration and / or forged document / certificate.
- d. Has substituted materials in lieu of materials supplied by OIL or has not returned or has short returned or has un-authorized disposed-off materials / documents / drawings / tools or plants or equipment supplied by OIL.
- e. Has obtained official Company information or copies of documents in relation to the tender / contract by dubious methods / means.
- f. Has deliberately violated and circumvented the provisions of labour laws / regulations / rules, safety norms or other statutory requirements.
- g. Has indulged in construction and erection of defective works or supply of defective materials/services and not made good of the defects within reasonable time in spite of follow-up by Company.
- h. Has not cleared OIL's previous dues.
- i. Has committed Breach of Contract or has failed to perform a contract or has abandoned the contract.
- j. Has refused to accept LOA / LOI / Purchase Order / Signing of the Contract after accepting LOA / Work Order after the same is issued by OIL within the period of Bid validity and as per agreed terms & conditions.

- k. After bid opening, withdraws / revises its bid within the period of bid validity for no valid reasons. However, reduction of quoted rate(s) / Bid price by L1 Bidder after the bid opening date shall not constitute ground for banning.
- l. Has parted with, leaked or provided confidential / proprietary information of OIL given to the party only for its use (in discharging its obligations against an order / contract) to any third party without prior consent of OIL.
- m. Use intimidation / threatening or brings undue outside pressure on the Company or its Official(s) for acceptance of its bid or acceptance of materials supplied or performance of the job under the contract / purchase order.
- n. If the Director / Owner / Proprietor / Partner of a party is convicted by a court of law for offences involving moral turpitude in relation to its business dealings during last five years.
- o. Poor performance of the supplier / contractor /service provider in one or several contracts / supplies affecting Company's operations.
- p. Any other ground for which, in the opinion of the Company makes it undesirable to deal with the party.

(The above clauses mentioned under clause no. (G) have been incorporated as per Company's existing banning policy. Whenever the banning policy is revised, these clauses will also be revised accordingly in the tender document.)

23.0 Evaluation of Bids:

The Bids will be evaluated as per the Bid Evaluation Criteria (BEC) as stated herein under:

BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC)

- 23.1 Bids conforming to the terms and conditions stipulated in the bid document and considered responsive and subject to qualifying the Bid Rejection Criteria will be considered for further evaluation.
- 23.2 **To ascertain the inter-se-ranking, the comparison of the responsive bids will be made on the basis of total amount quoted for the items of SOQ.**
- 23.3 **In case more than one bidder emerges as lowest bidder due to equal rate quoted by the bidder, then the lowest bidder will be decided by draw of lots. Company's decision in this regard is final and binding to all bidders.**
- 23.4 Any discount/rebates offered shall not be considered for evaluation of bids. However, if the lowest bidder happens to be the final acceptable bidder for award of contract and if they have offered any discount/rebate the contract shall be awarded after taking into consideration such discount/rebate after negotiation or otherwise.
- 23.5 Company will open the Bids in the presence of Bidder's representatives who choose to attend at the date, time and place mentioned in the Forwarding Letter. However, an

authorization letter from the bidder must be produced by the Bidder's representative at the time of bid opening. Unless this Letter is presented, the representative will not be allowed to attend the bid opening. Only one representative against each bid will be allowed to attend.

- 23.6 Bid for which an acceptable notice of withdrawal has been received shall not be opened. Company will examine bids to determine whether they are complete, whether requisite Bid Securities have been furnished, whether documents have been properly signed and whether the bids are generally in order.
- 23.7 At bid opening, Company will announce the Bidder's names, written notifications of bid modifications or withdrawal, if any, the presence of requisite Bid Security and such other details as the Company may consider appropriate.
- 23.8 Company shall prepare, for its own records, document containing the information disclosed to those present in accordance.
- 23.9 **To assist in the examination, evaluation and comparison of bids the Company may at its discretion, ask the Bidder for clarifications of its bid. The request for clarification and the response shall be in writing and no change in the price or substance of the bid shall be sought, offered or permitted.**
- 23.10 Prior to the detailed evaluation, Company will determine the substantial responsiveness of each bid to the requirement of the Bidding Documents. For purpose of these paragraphs, a substantially responsive bid is one, which conforms to all the terms and conditions of the Bidding Document without deviations or reservation. A deviation or reservation is one which affects in any way substantial way the scope, quality, or performance of work, or which limits in any substantial way, in-consistent way with the bidding documents, the Company's right or the bidder's obligations under the contract, and the rectification of which deviation or reservation would affect unfairly the competitive position of other bidders presenting substantial responsive bids. The Company's determination of bid's responsiveness is to be based on the contents of the Bid itself without recourse to extrinsic evidence.
- 23.11 A Bid determined as not substantially responsive will be rejected by the Company and may not subsequently be made responsive by the Bidder by correction of the non-conformity.
- 23.12 The Company may waive minor informality or nonconformity or irregularity in a bid, which does not constitute a material deviation, provided such waiver, does not prejudice or affect the relative ranking of any Bidder.
- 23.13 Quoted rates must be in conformity with the applicable minimum wage as applicable otherwise bid will be rejected.

24.0 **OPENING OF COMMERCIAL/ PRICE BIDS:**

- 24.1 *Company will open the Commercial/Price Bids of all the Bidders on a specific date in presence of interested bidders.*

- 24.2 The Company will examine the Price quoted by Bidders to determine whether they are complete, any computational errors have been made, the documents have been properly signed, and the bids are generally in order.
- 21.3 *Arithmetical errors will be rectified on the following basis. If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price (that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity) the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected accordingly. If any Bidder does not accept the correction of the errors, their bid will*
- 21.4 **All entries in the offer must be made in English. Rates quoted must be firm and shall be both in figures and words. In case of any discrepancy the rates quoted in words will prevail.** No overwriting shall be allowed and all corrections must be initiated. The quoted price shall be the net price inclusive of all taxes/charges/expenses. (However taxes, duties, charges etc. considered should also be shown separately). In absence of these details the quoted price shall be considered as net price inclusive of all taxes, duties, charges/expenses for providing the services at the required place/location.

WITNESSETH :

1.
 - a) The contractor hereby agrees to carry out the work set down in the Schedule of work which forms part-II of this Contract in accordance with the 1968 General Conditions of Contract of Oil India Limited and General Specifications read in conjunction with any drawings and Particular Specifications & instructions which forms Part-III of the contract utilizing any materials/services as offered by the Company as per Part-IV of the contract at _____.
 - b) In this Contract all words and expressions shall have the same meaning as are respectively assigned to them in the 1968 General Conditions of Contract of Oil India Limited which the Contractor has perused and is fully conversant with before entering into this Contract.
 - c) The clauses of this contract and of the specifications set out hereunder shall be paramount and in the event of anything herein contained being inconsistent with any term or terms of the 1968 General Conditions of Contract of Oil India Limited, the said term or terms of the 1968 General conditions of Contract to the extent of such inconsistency, and no further, shall not be binding on the parties hereto.

The Company reserves the right to cancel this Contract at any time upon full payment of work done and the value of the materials collected by the contractor for permanent incorporation in the work under this contract particularly for execution of this contract upto the date of cancellation of the Contract. The valuation of the work done and the materials collected shall be estimated by the company's Engineer in presence of the contractor. The Contractor shall have no claim to any further payment whatsoever. The valuation would be carried out exparte if Contractor fails to turn up despite reasonable notice which will be binding on the Contractor.
6. The Contractor hereby undertakes to indemnify the Company against all claims which may arise under the under noted Acts:-

or any other Acts or Statute not here in above specifically mentioned having bearing over engagement of workers directly or indirectly for execution of work. The Contractor shall not make the Company liable to reimburse the Contractor for the statutory increase in the wage rates of the Contract Labour appointed by the Contractor. Such Statutory increase in the wage rates of Contract Labour shall be borne by the contractor.

7. The Contractor shall clear away all rubbish and surplus material from the site on completion of work and shall leave the site clean and tidy.

In the event of any delay on the contractor's part, he/she will be liable to pay to the company liquidated damages at the rate of 1/2% (Half p.c) per week of the contract price of the item(s) delayed in completion and the maximum value of the liquidated damage will be 7.5% of the contract price of the item(s) delayed provided the item(s) delayed are not critical for commissioning and final utilization of the work. If, however, the item(s) delayed in completion are critical for commissioning and final utilisation of the work then the contractor will be liable to pay liquidated damages by way of penalty at the rate of **1/2% (Half percent)** per week of delay of the total contract cost subject to a maximum of **7.5%** of total contract cost. The Chief Engineer's certificate as to the criticality or otherwise of an item shall be final.

The payment of liquidated damages/penalty may be reduced or waived at the sole discretion of the Company whose decision in this regard will be final.

In the event of there being undue delay in execution of the Contract, the Company reserves the right to cancel the Contract and / or levy such additional damages as it deems fit based on the actual loss suffered by the company attributable to such delay. The company's decision in this regard shall be final.

10. On account payment may be made, not oftener than monthly, upto the amount of **100%** of the value of work done. Final payment will be made

only after satisfactory completion of the work. Such final payment shall be based on the work actually done allowing for deviations and any deductions and the measurement shall be checked and certified correct by the Company's Engineer before any such final payment is made.

11. The contractor employing 20 (twenty) or more workmen on any day preceding 12 months shall be required to obtain requisite licence at his cost from the appropriate Licensing Officer before undertaking any Contract work. The Contractor shall also observe the rules & regulations framed under the Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act.
12. Wages shall be paid by the Contractor to the workmen directly without any intervention of any Jamadars or Thekadars and that the Contractor shall ensure that no amount by way of commission or otherwise be deducted/ recovered by the Jamadar from the wages of the workmen.

14. The Contractor will not be allowed to construct any structure (for storage / housing purpose) with thatch, bamboo or any other inflammable materials within any company's fenced area.
15. The Contractor shall ensure that all men engaged by him/her are provided with appropriate protective clothing and safety wear in accordance with regulation 89(a) and 89(b) in the Oil mines Regulations 1984. The Company's representative shall not allow/accept those men who are not provided with the same.
16. All Statutory taxes levied by the Central and State Government or any other competent authority from time to time will be borne by Contractor and the amount of the contract specified in the contract is inclusive of all tax liabilities.
17. The Contractor shall deploy local persons in all works.
18. The Contractor shall not engage minor labour below 18(eighteen) years of age under any circumstances.
19. The Contractor and his/her workmen shall strictly observe the rules and regulations as per Mines Act (Latest editions).

20. SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

- a) Contractor shall be required to furnish an amount equivalent to **7.5% (initial security deposit along with acceptance of contract is to be deposited for 2.5% and remaining 5% is to be recovered from running account bill)** of the estimated total contract value as **Performance Security Deposit**. Any contractor found violating these provisions will render themselves disqualified from any future tendering. 22. **FORCE MAJUERE:**

- 22.1 In the event of either party being rendered unable by 'Force Majeure' to perform any obligation required to be performed by them under the contract, the relative obligation of the party affected by such 'Force Majeure' will stand suspended as provided herein. The word 'Force Majeure' as employed herein shall mean acts of God, war, revolt, agitation, strikes, riot, fire, flood, sabotage, civil commotion, road barricade (but not due to interference of employment problem of the Contractor) and any other cause, whether of kind herein enumerated or otherwise which are not within the control of the party to the contract and which renders performance of the contract by the said party impossible.
- 22.2 Upon occurrence of such cause and upon its termination, the party alleging that it has been rendered unable as aforesaid thereby, shall notify the other party in writing within Seventy Two (72) hours of the alleged beginning and ending thereof, giving full particulars and satisfactory evidence in support of its claim.
- 22.3 Should 'force majeure' condition as stated above occurs and should the same be notified within seventy two (72) hours after its occurrence the 'force majeure' rate shall apply for a maximum cumulative period of fifteen days. Either party will have the right to terminate the Contract if such 'force majeure' condition continues beyond fifteen (15) days with

prior written notice. Should either party decide not to terminate the Contract even under such condition, no payment would apply after expiry of fifteen (15) days force majeure period unless otherwise agreed to.

23. I.B. VERIFICATION REPORT AND SECURITY REVIEW:

Contractor will be required to submit the verification report to ascertain character and antecedents from the Civil Administration towards the persons engaged under this contract to the Head of the user Department before engagement.

24. In case of any doubt or dispute as to the interpretation of any clause herein contained, the decision of the Company's Engineer shall be final and binding on the contractor.

25. SET OFF CLAUSE:-

"Any sum of money due and payable to the contractor (including Security Deposit refundable to them) under this or any other contract may be appropriated by Oil India Limited and set off against any claim of Oil India Limited (or such other person or persons contracting through Oil India Limited) for payment of a sum of money arising out of this contract or under any other contract made by the contractor with Oil India Limited (or such other person or persons contracting through Oil India Limited)."

26.0 FURNISHING FRAUDULENT INFORMATION/DOCUMENT:

If it is found that a Bidder/Contractor has furnished fraudulent document/information, the Bid Security/Performance Security shall be forfeited and the party shall be debarred for period of 3(three) years from date of detection of such fraudulent act, besides the legal action.

27.0 LIQUIDATED DAMAGES FOR DELAY IN MOBILISATION AND/ OR COMPLETION OF WORKS AND SERVICES

27.1 In normal case of works /service contracts, liquidated damages will be applicable @ 0.5% of the contract value per week or part thereof, for delay in contract mobilization /completion date subject to a maximum ceiling of 7.5% of contract value .

28.0 PAYMENT TERMS:

28.1 The company shall make payment, subject to adjustment/deduction of TDS as necessary for the service, rendered as and when required, on the basis of rates finalized by OIL and as mentioned in SOQ of this service agreement, provided bills which are to be submitted by the service provider are received not later than end day of subsequent calendar month.

29.0 TERMINATION:

29.1 TERMINATION ON EXPIRY OF THE TERMS (DURATION):

The contract shall be deemed to have been automatically terminated on the expiry of duration of the Contract or extension, if any, thereof.

29.2 TERMINATION ON ACCOUNT OF FORCE MAJEURE:

Either party shall have the right to terminate the Contract on account of Force Majeure as set forth in clause 22.0 above.

29.3 TERMINATION ON ACCOUNT OF INSOLVENCY:

In the event that the Contractor at any time during the term of the Contract, becomes insolvent or makes a voluntary assignment of its assets for the benefit of creditors or is adjudged bankrupt, then the Company shall, by a notice in writing have the right to terminate the Contract and all the Contractor's rights and privileges hereunder, shall stand terminated forthwith.

29.4 TERMINATION FOR UNSATISFACTORY PERFORMANCE:

If the Company considers that, the performance of the Contractor is unsatisfactory, or not upto the expected standard, the Company shall notify the Contractor in writing and specify in details the cause of the dissatisfaction. The Company shall have the option to terminate the Contract by giving 15 days notice in writing to the Contractor, if Contractor fails to comply with the requisitions contained in the said written notice issued by the Company,

29.5 TERMINATION DUE TO CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP & ASSIGNMENT:

In case the Contractor's rights and / or obligations under the Contract and/or the Contractor's rights, title and interest to the equipment/material, are transferred or assigned without the Company's consent, the Company may at its absolute discretion, terminate the Contract.

29.6 If at any time during the term of the Contract, breakdown of Contractor's equipment results in Contractor being unable to perform their obligations hereunder for a period of 15 successive days, Company at its option may terminate this Contract in its entirety without any further right or obligation on the part of the Company except for the payment of money then due. No notice shall be served by the Company under the condition stated above.

29.7 Notwithstanding any provisions herein to the contrary, the Contract may be terminated at any time by the company on giving 30 (thirty) days written notice to the Contractor due to any other reason not covered under the above clause from 12.1 to 12.6 and in the event of such termination the Company shall not be liable to pay any cost or damage to the Contractor except for payment for services as per the Contract upto the date of termination.

29.8 CONSEQUENCES OF TERMINATION:

In all cases of termination herein set forth, the obligation of the Company to pay for Services as per the Contract shall be limited to the period upto the date of termination. Notwithstanding the termination of the Contract, the parties shall continue to be bound by the provisions of the Contract that reasonably require some action or forbearance after such termination.

29.8.1 Upon termination of the Contract, Contractor shall return to Company all of Company's items, which are at the time in Contractor's possession.

29.8.2 In the event of termination of contract, Company will issue Notice of termination of the contract with date or event after which the contract will be terminated. The

contract shall then stand terminated and the Contractor shall demobilize their personnel & materials.
