Prospective bidders are requested to regularly visit the website and e-portal to keep themselves updated.

BID REJECTION / EVALUATION CRITERIA:

1.0. BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC):

The bid shall conform to the specifications and terms and conditions given in the Bidding Documents. Bids will be rejected in case material and services offered do not conform to the required parameters stipulated in the technical specifications. Notwithstanding the general conformity of the bid to the stipulated specifications, the following requirements will have to be particularly met by the Bidders without which the same will be considered as non-responsive and rejected. All the documents related to BRC shall be submitted along with the Techno-Commercial Bid.

1.1 1.1 Financial capability: Bidders must have;

- a) Annual financial turnover as per Audited Annual Reports for any of the last three accounting year ending **2014-2015** preceding scheduled bid opening date should be at least **Rs.2,91,000.00**
- b) Net Worth should be positive for preceding 3 (Three) financial years.
- c) For Proof of Annual Turnover and Net Worth any of the following documents /photocopy must be furnished

- A Certificate issued by a practicing Chartered / Cost Accountant Firm, with membership number certifying the Annual Turnover and nature of business.
- Audited Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss account.

1.2 Experience: Bidders must have;

The bidder shall have successfully completed of the following magnitude during last 7 years (to be reckoned from original bid closing date) should be the following:

- (i) One similar completed works costing not less than Rs. 4,84,000.00**

(Similar completed work means 'Providing services of hired vehicles')

Documentary proof must be furnished in support of the experience by way of purchase order / work order / contract document along with completion certificate from the organization to whom such services have been rendered.

1.3 The Bidder must have a business office establishment for a least one year within 50 Km radius of the area of operation where the services need to be provided. Documentary evidence must be provided in the form of Municipality trade license or other such documents which satisfies as a proof of having the office establishment.

- (i) Trade License issued by the local authority in the name of the Firm or*
- (ii) Landline phone number in the name of the Firm or*
- (i) Electricity bill for last one year in the name of the Firm*

“Additionally, the names of the areas covering the 50 Km radius may be mentioned”.

1.4 All the supporting documents in compliance to BRC requirements under clause 1.1 & 1.2 above shall be scanned and uploaded along with the technical bid.

1.5 Any bid not complying BRC requirements shall be summarily rejected.

1.6 To ascertain the substantial responsiveness of the bid the Company reserves the right to ask the Bidder for clarification in respect of clauses covered under BRC and such clarification fulfilling the BRC clauses must be received on or before the deadline given by the Company, failing which the offer will summarily rejected.

1.7 In case, any of the clauses in the BRC contradict with other clauses of Bid Document elsewhere, then the clauses in the BRC shall prevail.

1.8 Deviation to the following provision of the tender document shall make the bid liable for rejection:

- i. Firm price
- ii. EMD / Bid Bond
- iii. Scope of work
- iv. Specifications
- v. Price Schedule
- vi. Delivery / Completion Schedule
- vii. Period of Validity of Bid
- viii. Liquidated Damages
- ix. Performance Bank Guarantee / Security deposit

- x. Guarantee of material / work
- xi. Arbitration / Resolution of Dispute
- xii. Force Majeure
- xiii. Applicable Laws
- xiv. Integrity Pact, if applicable
- xv. Any other condition specifically mentioned in the tender documents elsewhere that non-compliance of the clause lead to rejection of the bid.

2.0 BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC):

- 2.1 Bids conforming to the terms and conditions stipulated in the bid document and considered responsive and subject to qualifying the Bid Rejection Criteria will be considered for further evaluation.
- 2.2 To ascertain the inter-se-ranking, the comparison of the responsive bids will be made on the basis of total amount quoted for the items of SOQ (i.e. **fixed monthly charge X 36 months, Running Charge per KM X the Estimated KM indicated i.e. 3000 Km/month**) of the tender.
- 2.3 Any discount/rebates offered shall not be considered for evaluation of bids. However, if the lowest bidder happens to be the final acceptable bidder for award of contract and if they have offered any discount/rebate the contract shall be awarded after taking into consideration such discount/rebate after negotiation or otherwise.
- 2.4 Quoted rates must be in conformity with the applicable minimum wage as applicable other wise bid will be rejected.
- 2.5 ***In case more than one bidder emerges as lowest bidder due to equal rate quoted by the bidder, then the lowest bidder will be decided by draw of lots. Company's decision in this regard is final and binding to all bidders***
- 2.6 In case of tenders for Annual rate contracts / Maintenance and Service contracts, if the prospective bidder is executing rate / maintenance /service contract which is still running and the contract value / quantity executed prior to due date of bid submission is equal to or more than the minimum prescribed value in the BEC such experience will also be taken in to consideration provided that the bidder has submitted satisfactory work / supply / service execution certificate issued by end user.

3.0 OTHER INFORMATION /DOCUMENTS:

Bidders are required to furnish the following information with relevant documents wherever necessary:

i) Price quotation of the offered vehicle from the Authorised Motor Vehicle Dealer along with the offer.

Non Furnishing of the above information may be liable for rejection of the offer.

4.0 GENERAL:

- a) In case bidder takes exception to any clause of Tender Document not covered under BEC/BRC, then the Company has the discretion to load or reject the offer on account of such exception if the bidder does not withdraw/modify the deviation when/as advised by the Company. The loading so done by the Company will be final and binding on the Bidders. No deviation will however, be accepted in the clauses covered under BRC.
- b) To ascertain the substantial responsiveness of the bid the Company reserves the right to ask the Bidder for clarification in respect of clauses covered under BRC also such clarification fulfilling the BRC clauses must be received on or before ten days from the date of clarification sought by the Company, failing which the bid will be summarily rejected.
- c) In case of any of the clauses in the BRC contradict with other clauses of Bid Document elsewhere, then the clauses in the BRC shall prevail.
- d) Any exceptions/deviations to the tender and applicable statutory duties and levies must be spelt out by bidder in their Techno-Commercial bid only.
- e) The original copy of documents [furnished by bidders(s)] shall have to be produced by bidder(s) to OIL as and when asked for.

5.0 Bidders must have PF Account in their name issued by Regional Provident Fund Commissioner and ESI registration .
