BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC) / BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC)

1.0 BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC):

The bid shall conform to the specifications and terms and conditions given in the Bidding Documents. Bids will be rejected in case material and services offered do not conform to the required parameters stipulated in the technical specifications. Notwithstanding the general conformity of the bid to the stipulated specifications, the following requirements will have to be particularly met by the Bidders without which the same will be considered as non-responsive and rejected. All the documents related to BRC shall be submitted along with the Techno-Commercial Bid.

1.1 TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS FOR BIDDERS:

Bidder must have relevant experience in carrying out similar nature of jobs in previous 7 (seven) years to be reckoned form the from the original bid closing date should be the following: .

i) One similar completed work costing not less than Rs 5,24,200.00

Note: Similar Work as described above shall mean Works of Electrical Maintenance OR Electrical Service OR Earthing Grid Works OR Electrification OR Reelectrification Works OR Electrical Cable Trenching Works OR Electrical Cable Laying Works OR Electrical Overhead Line/poles Works OR Maintenance services of Electrical Machines / Installations/ Equipment/Panels/Switchgears/Overhead poles or lines etc.

NOTE:-

- 1. A job executed by a bidder for its own organization / subsidiary cannot be considered as experience for the purpose of meeting BEC.
- 2. Documentary evidence in support of work experience and fulfilling the requirement as spelt out in clauses above must be submitted along with techno-commercial bid.
 - A. These documents shall be in the form of copies Work Order and/or Contract document along with Completion Certificates. The Work Order and/or Contract Document shall contain detail scope of work in support of Work Experience. OR

B.In case the work is done for OIL, the bidder shall submit documentary evidence in the form of copies of Final Service Entry Sheet (SES) and copies of Work Order and/or Contract document

1.2 FINANCIAL:

1.2.1 Annual financial turnover of the bidder, as per Audited Annual Reports in any of the preceding three financial years should be at least **Rs 3,14,500.00**

For consortium:

At least one member of the consortium to meet the above criteria of 50% turnover.

The other members of consortium should meet minimum 25% turnover requirement.

1.2.2 **Net Worth** shall be positive for the preceding financial year reckoned from the original bid closing date

Note: For proof of Annual turnover and Annual financial turnover in any the preceding 3(Three) accounting years reckoned from the bid closing date, any of the following documents/photocopies must be submitted along with the bid:

 i) A certificate issued by a practicing Chartered Cost Accountants(with membership no. and Firm Registration Number) certifying the **Annual turnover** and & **Net Worth**

OR

ii) Audited Balance Sheet along with Profit & Loss account.

In case the bidder is a Central Govt. Organization/PSU/State Govt. Organization/Semi-State Govt. Organization or any other Central/State Govt. Undertaking, where the auditor is appointed only after the approval of Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the Central Government, their certificates may be

accepted even though FRN (Firm Registration Number) is not available. However, bidder will have to provide documentary evidence for the same.

1.3 GENERAL:

- (i) In case bidder takes exception to any clause of Tender Document not covered under BEC, then the Company has the discretion to load or reject the offer on account of such exception if the bidder does not withdraw / modify the deviation when / as advised by the Company. The loading so done by the Company will be final and binding on the Bidders.
- (ii) To ascertain the substantial responsiveness of the bid the Company reserves the right to ask the Bidder for clarification in respect of clauses covered under BEC also and such clarification fulfilling the BEC clauses must be received on or before stipulated day from the date of clarification sought by the Company, failing which the bid will be rejected.
- (iii) In case any of the clauses in the BEC contradict with other clauses of Bid Document elsewhere, then the clauses in the BEC shall prevail.
- (iv) The originals of such documents [furnished by bidders(s)] shall have to be produced by bidder(s) to OIL as and when asked for.

1.4 BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC):

Deviation to the following provision of the tender document shall make the bid

rejection:

- vi. Delivery / Completion Schedule
- vii. Period of Validity of Bid

- xiii. Applicable Laws
- xiv. Integrity Pact, if applicable
- xv. Any other condition specifically mentioned in the tender documents elsewhere that non-compliance of the clause lead to rejection of the bid.

1.6 COMMERCIAL:

- 1.6.1 Bidder shall submit the offer under "<u>Single Stage" Single Bid System</u>". Technical bid" and the "Price Bid".
- 1.6.2 Bidder shall furnish Bid Security along with Bid. Bid security shall be furnished as a part of 'Technical Bid'. **Any bid not accompanied by a**

proper bid security will be rejected. Bidder shall submit original document to the address as specified with BCD before Bid opening date and time, otherwise Bid will be rejected. A scanned copy of this document should also be uploaded along with the Un-priced bid.

- 1.6.3 The Technical Bid should not have any price indication.
- 1.6.4 Bidder shall furnish Bid Security as referred in Relevant Section of the Bid document so as to reach the Company (i.e. OIL) before due date of closing. Any bid for which bid security is not received before due Date of Bid Closing will be rejected.
- 1.6.5 Validity of the bid shall be minimum **90 days**. Bids with lesser validity will be rejected.
- 1.6.6 Any bid received in the form of Telex/Cable/Fax/E-mail/ Telephone call will not be accepted.
- 1.6.7 Bidders must quote clearly and strictly in accordance with the price schedule outlined in relevant section of Bidding Documents; otherwise the bid will be rejected.
- 1.6.8 Any bid containing false statement will be rejected.
- 1.6.9 The Bid Documents are not transferable. Bids made by parties who have not purchased the Bid Documents from the Company will be rejected.
- 1.6.10 Any Bid received by the Company after the deadline for submission of bids prescribed by the Company will be rejected.
- 1.6.11 Price quoted by the successful Bidder must be firm during the performance of the Contract and not subject to variation on any account. A bid submitted with an adjustable price will be treated as non-responsive and rejected.
- 1.6.12 The following Clauses with all its sub-clauses should be agreed in toto, failing which the bid will be rejected. To this effect Bidder shall submit an undertaking along with the Technical Bid.
 - a) Performance Security Clause
 - b) Force Majeure Clause
 - c) Termination Clause
 - d) Settlement of disputes Clause
 - e) Liquidated Damages Clause.
 - f) Acceptance of Jurisdiction and applicable law.
 - g) Tax liabilities clause.
 - h) Insurance clause.
 - i) With holding clause.
 - j) Liability clause.
 - k) Set off clause

2.0 BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC):

- 2.1 The bids conforming to the technical specifications, terms and conditions stipulated in the bid documents and considered to be responsive after subjecting to the Bid Rejection Criteria will be considered for further evaluation as per the Bid Evaluation Criteria.
- 2.2 To ascertain the inter-se-ranking, the comparison of the responsive bids will be made on the basis of total cost of various works envisaged under the contract.
- 2.3 In case more than one bidder emerges as lowest bidder due to equal rate quoted by the bidder, then the lowest bidder will be decided by draw of lots. Company's decision in this regard is final and binding to all bidders
- 2.4 Any discount/rebates offered shall not be considered for evaluation of bids. However, if the lowest bidder happens to be the final acceptable bidder for award of contract and if they have offered any discount/rebate the contract shall be awarded after taking into consideration such discount/rebate after negotiation or otherwise.
