1.0 Application showing full address/email address with Tender Fee (Non-refundable) of ₹ **5,000/- by Demand Draft/Banker's Cheque only in favour of M/s Oil India Limited and payable at Guwahati is to be sent to Chief Manager (Contracts) , Oil India Limited, P.O. Udayan Vihar, Assam-781171 only between 04-16-2013 and one week prior to Bid Closing date.** The envelope containing the application for participation should clearly indicate **“Request for participation”** for easy identification and timely issue of authorization. No physical tender documents will be provided. On receipt of requisite tender fee **USER_ID** and initial **PASSWORD** will be communicated to the bidder (through e-mail) and will be allowed to participate in the tender through OIL's e-Procurement portal. **Details of NIT can be viewed using “Guest Login” provided in the e-Procurement portal.** The link to e-Procurement portal has been also provided through OIL's web site www.oil-india.com.

2.1 TENDER FEE:

2.1.1 Bidders interested to provide the services and interested to participate in the above tender are requested to submit the tender fee of **₹ 5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand)** only by Demand Draft/Banker's Cheque favouring OIL INDIA LIMITED, Payable at Guwahati issued by any Scheduled Bank. **NO OTHER MODE OF PAYMENT WILL BE ACCEPTED BY THE COMPANY.**

2.1.2 Sealed envelopes containing the Tender Fee shall be marked with the above Tender Number and description of work and addressed to following:

Tender fee shall reach the above address one week prior to Bid Closing date during working days (excluding Sundays/Holidays). Bidder whose Tender fee reach after the last date of received of tender fee as mentioned in online data shall not be allowed to participate in the bidding process.

2.2 EXEMPTION OF TENDER FEE:

- i) Small Scale Industries (SSI) registered with NSIC under Single Point Registration Scheme are exempted from payment of tender fees for the items they are registered with NSIC. Valid registration certificate with NSIC must be enclosed along with the application for issuing tender documents.
- ii) Public Sector Units (PSU) are also exempted from payment of tender fee.
- iii) Firms registered with NSIC, PSU's & Government Departments claiming exemption from payment of tender fee should submit their request with all credentials to the tender administrator at least 7 days in advance from the date of closer of sale of bid documents, to get access for participation in the tender.
- (iv) Tender documents provided to SSI Units registered with NSIC on free of charge basis shall submit their offer for the service for which they are registered. Their offer for other than the registered service shall not be acceptable. Their offer as service provider also will not be acceptable and shall be rejected straightway.

BID REJECTION CRITERIA /BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BRC)

1.0. BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC):

The bid shall conform to the specifications and terms and conditions given in the Bidding Documents. Bids will be rejected in case material and services offered do not conform to the required parameters stipulated in the technical specifications. Notwithstanding the general conformity of the bid to the stipulated specifications, the following requirements will have to be particularly met by the Bidders without which the same will be considered as non-responsive and rejected. All the documents related to BRC shall be submitted along with the Techno-Commercial Bid.

1.1 TECHNICAL: Bidder's Eligibility Criteria:

- 1.1.1 Bidder shall qualify to take up pipe laying work depending on experience of having completed construction of pipeline with size and length of minimum 675 mm -km in last seven years ending Bid closing date.

(mm - Km means diameter of constructed pipeline in mm X length in Km, only 200 mm NB (8") or above against a single contract will be considered. i.e minimum 200mm dia 9.37 km or 300mm dia 6.25 km or 400 mm dia 4.68 km)

Note: Documentary evidence in support of the above jobs in the form of completion certificates from the owner are to be submitted. Completion certificate should include completion of all mechanical jobs as laying of pipelines

- 1.1.2 Experience of having successfully completed similar jobs (Similar nature of jobs means construction of oil and gas pipelines of size 200 mm NB (8") or above as per ASME B 31.4 / ASME B 31.8.) by the Bidders in the last seven years ending bid closing date with value shall be as below.

- i) Single contract of minimum value ₹ 1,32,02,900.00

- or
- ii) Two contracts each of minimum value ₹ 82,51,800.00
- or
- iii) Three contracts each of minimum value ₹ 49,51,100.00

Documentary evidence in support of the above jobs in the form of completion certificates from the clients are to be submitted failing which the offers will be rejected.

1.1.3 Bids by Consortium/ joint venture will not be acceptable.

1.2 FINANCIAL:

Bidder's average annual financial turn over during the last three years ending 31st March, up to the previous financial period of the bid closing date i.e. 2012-13 shall be **Rs 49,51,065.00.** For Proof of Annual Turnover any of the following documents /photocopy must be furnished

- i) A Certificate issued by a practicing Chartered / Cost Accountant Firm, with membership number certifying the Annual Turnover and nature of business.
- ii) Audited Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss account.

1.3 Bids shall summarily be rejected for non furnishing of documentary evidences as applicable along with the bid as noted in **Para 1.1** above

2.0 INTEGRITY PACT:

Bidder shall submit Integrity Pact Proforma / Annexure along with the Technical Bid, duly signed on all pages by same signatory who signed the bid, failing which the offer will summarily be rejected.

3.0 BID EVALUATION CRITERIA:

The bid conforming to the terms and conditions stipulated in the bid documents and considered to be responsive after subjecting to Bid Rejection Criteria as well as verification of original of any or all documents / documentary evidences pertaining to BRC will be considered for further evaluation as per the Bid Evaluation Criteria given below:

To ascertain the inter-se-ranking, the comparison of the responsive bids will be made on the basis of total amount quoted for each segment as per Schedule of Rates and Payment including all applicable statutory levies, taxes and duties including Service tax.
