## **SECTION – II**

### **INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS**

1.0 Bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of bid. Oil India Limited, hereinafter referred to as Company, will in no case be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

1.1 Prospective Bidders may interact with Company's Materials & Contracts Department at Jodhpur during working hours to understand the existing facilities, actual requirements and the desired level of services etc., before submitting their bids.

#### **A. BIDDING DOCUMENT / TENDER DOCUMENT**

2.0 The services required, bidding procedures and contract terms are prescribed in the Bidding Documents. This bidding document includes the following:

2.1 The bidder is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms and specifications in the Bid Document. Failure to furnish all information required as per the Bid Document or submission of a bid not substantially responsive to the Bid Document in all respect will be at the Bidder's risk & responsibility and may result in rejection of their bids.

#### **3.0 AMENDMENTS TO BIDDING DOCUMENT:**

3.1 At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids, the Company may, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective Bidder, modify the Bid Document through an Addendum.

- 3.2 The Addendum will be uploaded in OIL's e-Portal in the C-folder under tab "Amendments to Tender Documents". Prospective Bidders, shall be intimated about the amendments through e-mail/fax/courier etc. The Company may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for bid submission, if the Bidders are expected to require additional time in which to take the Addendum into account in preparation of their bid or for any other reason.

**B. PREPARATION OF BIDS**

**4.0 LANGUAGE OF BIDS:**

The bid as well as all correspondence and documents relating to the bid exchanged between the Bidder and the Company shall be in English language, except that any printed literature may be in another language, provided it is accompanied by an English version which shall govern for the purpose of bid interpretation.

**5.0 DOCUMENTS COMPRISING THE BID:**

The bidder should submit their offer under single stage composite bid system i.e., only a single Techno-Commercial Bid comprising of the following documents.

- (i) Complete technical details of the services etc.
- (ii) Documentary evidence establishing Bidder's eligibility as per BEC/BRC defined in Section – VI.
- (iii) Bid Security (Scanned Copy) furnished in accordance with Para 10.0 below.
- (iv) Statement of compliance as per Proforma – I of Section – VI .
- (v) Bid Form & Price Schedule Details as per Section – V and Proforma – II of Section VI.
- (vi) All other Annexure, Proforma and Documents as required in the Tender

**6.0 BID FORM:**

The bidder shall complete the Bid Form and the appropriate Price Schedule furnished in the Bid Document vide as per Section – V and Proforma – II of Section VI respectively.

**7.0 BID PRICE:**

- 7.1 Rates/Unit Prices must be quoted in Indian Rupees only in words as well as in figures.
- 7.2 Price quoted by the Successful Bidder must remain firm throughout its performance of the Contract and is not subject to variation on any account, including extension period, if any.
- 7.3 All duties and taxes including Corporate income taxes, Service Tax and other levies payable by the Contractor under the Contract for which this Bid Document is issued, shall be included in the rates, prices and total Bid Price submitted by the bidder, and the evaluation and comparison of bids shall be made accordingly. For example, personal taxes and/or any corporate taxes arising out of the profits on the contract as per rules of the country shall be borne by the bidder. Only the R & D Cess, applicable if any against this contract will be borne and paid for by OIL.

**8.0 CURRENCIES OF BID AND PAYMENT:**

As the tender is issued only to the indigenous (domestic) Bidders, rates must be quoted in Indian Rupees only and payment will accordingly be made in Indian rupees.

## 9.0 DOCUMENTS ESTABLISHING BIDDER'S ELIGIBILITY AND QUALIFICATIONS

These are listed in Bid Rejection Criteria vide Section – VI of the Bidding document.

## 10.0 BID SECURITY:

- 10.1 The **Original Bid Security** for the amount as specified in the "Forwarding Letter" **must reach the office of Chief Manager (M & C), Oil India Limited, 2A, District Shopping Centre, Saraswati Nagar, Basni, Jodhpur -342005, Rajasthan, India before the scheduled Bid Closing Date and Time of the Tender, otherwise Bid will be rejected.** Tender Number and the Description of work must be clearly highlighted on the envelope containing the original Bid Security. A scanned copy of this document should also be uploaded along with the un-priced Technical Bid on e-portal.
- 10.2 Pursuant to Para 5.0 above, the Bidder during online submission of its bid shall furnish as part of its Technical unpriced Bid, Bid Security (scanned copy) in the amount as specified in the "Forwarding Letter".
- 10.3 The Bid Security is required to protect the Company against the risk of Bidder's conduct, which would warrant the security's forfeiture, pursuant to sub-para 10.8 below.
- 10.4 The Bid Security shall be denominated in the currency of the Bid or another freely convertible currency, and shall be in the form of a Bank Guarantee issued by a scheduled Bank located in India in the form provided in the Bid document (Ref. Section-VIII for the format) and valid for **90 days beyond the validity of the Bid**. The bank guarantee should be so endorsed that it can be invoked at the issuing bank's branch located at Jodhpur (Rajasthan) India or alternatively at New Delhi, India.
- 10.5 Any Bid not secured in accordance with above-mentioned subparagraphs 10.1 to 10.4 will be rejected by Company as non-responsive, except those are exempted.
- 10.6 Unsuccessful Bidder's Bid Security will be discharged and/or returned immediately after finalization of the Tender by Company or latest by within 30 days of expiry of the period of bid validity.
- 10.7 Successful Bidder's Bid Security will be discharged upon the Bidder's signing of the contract and furnishing the Performance Security.
- 10.8 The Bid Security will be forfeited:
- (a) If any Bidder withdraws their bid during the period of bid validity (including any subsequent extension) specified by the Bidder on the Bid Form, or
  - (b) If a Successful Bidder fails:
    - i) To sign the contract within reasonable time and within the period of bid validity, and /or,

- ii) To furnish Performance Security.

**NOTE: Public Sector Undertakings and Small Scale Units registered with NSIC/Directorate of Industries are exempted from submitting bid securities against this tender.**

**11.0 PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF BIDS:**

- 11.1 Bids shall remain valid for 120 days after the date of bid opening prescribed by the Company.
- 11.2 In exceptional circumstances, the Company may solicit the Bidder's consent to an extension of the period of validity. The request and the response thereto shall be made in writing (by Fax or E-mail). A Bidder may refuse the request without forfeiting their Bid Security. A Bidder granting the request will neither be required nor permitted to modify their bid but shall arrange suitable validity extension of their bid security provided under para 10.0 above.

**12.0 FORMAT AND SIGNING OF BID:**

As the Bids are to be submitted ONLINE with digital signature, manual signature is not required

**C. SUBMISSION OF BIDS:**

**13.0 ONLINE SUBMISSION:**

- 13.1 The Bid should be submitted online up to 11:00 Hrs. (IST) (Server Time) on the date as mentioned herein i.e., on the scheduled Bid Closing Date. The Bids will be opened on the same day at 15:00 Hrs. (IST) at the office of Chief Manager (M&C), Oil India Limited, 2A, District Shopping Centre, Saraswati Nagar, Basni, Jodhpur -342005, Rajasthan, India in presence of authorized representative of the bidder.
- 13.2 The Rates/Prices along with price related conditions should be filled online in the Price-Bid Format(Proforma-II,Section-VII) only. All other techno-commercial documents other than the cost details to be submitted with unpriced bid as per tender requirement placed in the “un-priced” bid folder.
- 13.3 The Bid and all uploaded documents must be digitally signed by duly authorized representative of the bidding company using “Class 3” digital certificate [e-commerce application (Certificate with personal verification and Organization name)] as per Indian IT Act obtained from the licensed Certifying Authorities operating under the Root Certifying Authority of India (RCAI), Controller of Certifying Authorities (CCA) of India.
- 13.4 The Bidder will be responsible for ensuring the validity of digital signature and its proper usage by their employee. The authenticity of above digital signature shall be verified through authorized CA after the bid opening. If the digital signature used for signing is not of “Class-3” with Organization name, the bid will be rejected.

13.5 The Tender is invited under SINGLE STAGE COMPOSITE -BID SYSTEM. Therefore, the Bidder has to submit both the “TECHNICAL” and “PRICE ” bids through electronic form in OIL’s e-Tender Portal within the Bid Closing Date and Time stipulated in the e-Tender. The Technical Bid is to be submitted as per Scope of Work & Technical Specifications defined in the Tender and the Commercial Bid as per the online Price Bid Format.

13.6 Bidder should ensure that Technical Bid is uploaded in the Technical attachments->Technical RFx Response-> User - > Technical Bid Tab Page only. Please go through the help document provided in OIL’s e-Portal in details before uploading the document.

**NB** : All the Bids must be digitally signed using “Class-3” digital signature certificate with Organizations Name (e-commerce application) as per Indian IT Act obtained from the licensed Certifying Authorities operating under the Root Certifying Authority of India (RCAI), Controller of Certifying Authorities (CCA) of India.

13.7 Rates/Prices must be quoted/maintained in the “online price Bid Format” only. OIL will consider the rates/prices quoted in the “online price Bid Format” only.

14.0 Timely submission of online bids is the responsibility of the Bidders. The Bid along with all annexure and copies of documents should be submitted in e-form only through OIL’s e-bidding engine. The Bid submitted in physical form against e-procurement tenders shall not be given any cognizance. However, the following documents should necessarily be submitted in physical form in sealed envelope. The Tender No. and the Date of Bid Closing/Opening must be prominently marked on the outer cover/envelope containing these documents and should be sent to Chief Manager (M & C), Oil India Limited, 2A-District Shopping Centre, Saraswati Nagar, Basni, Jodhpur -342005, Rajasthan, Rajasthan, India so as to reach before the scheduled Bid Closing Date and Time of the Tender.

- (ii) Power of attorney for signing the bid document.
- (iii) Other documents required to be submitted in original as per tender requirement, if any.

15.0 **DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF BIDS :**

15.1 Bidders will not be permitted by the System to make any change in their Bid after it is uploaded. The Bidder may however request CHIEF MANAGER (M & C) for returning their Bid before the due date of submission and resubmit their bid after necessary revision/correction, if so envisaged any. But no such request will be entertained once the due date for submission of Bid is reached and/or bids are opened.

15.2 No bid can be submitted/uploaded after the submission deadline is reached. The system time displayed on e-procurement web page shall decide the submission deadline.

16.0 **EXTENSION OF BID SUBMISSION DATE/TIME:**

16.1 Normally no request for extension of Bid Closing date & Time will be entertained by Company. However, in case of any change in the specifications, non-receipt of any offer, inadequate response or for any other reasons, Company may at its discretion or otherwise, extend the Bid Closing Date and/or Time.

16.2 In the event of receipt of Single Offer within Bid Closing date & Time, OIL reserves



the right to extend Bid Closing Date and/or Time as deemed fit. During extension period bidders who have already submitted the bids on or before original Bid Closing date & Time shall not be permitted to revise their bid.

17.0 FORMAT OF BID SUBMISSION:

17.1 Bids to be submitted online at OIL's E-PORTAL. Detailed instructions are available in "HELP DOCUMENTATION" in the E-PORTAL. Guidelines for bid submission are also provided in this tender document.

17.2 The Bid Security (Scanned Copy) mentioned in para 10.0 above should be uploaded with the Technical Bid.

17.3 The terms and conditions of the contract to be entered with the successful bidder are given in various Sections of this bid document.

18.0 LATE BIDS:

Bidders are advised in their own interest to ensure that the bids are uploaded in the system well before the closing date and time of the bid. Company will not be responsible for any failure to upload the Bids due to last minute rush.

19.0 MODIFICATION AND WITHDRAWAL OF BIDS :

19.1 After the Bid is uploaded by the Bidder in the system, they will not be permitted by the System to make any change in their Bid. For making any such subsequent modification/correction, the Bidder has to request CHIEF MANAGER (M & C) for returning their Bid before the due date of submission and re-submit their bid after necessary revision/correction within the deadline. But no such request will be entertained once the due date for submission of Bid is reached and/or bids are opened.

19.2 The Bidder, after submission of bid, may withdraw its bid entirely by written notice to Company prior to bid closing without forfeiting their Bid Security.

19.3 Bids should not be withdrawn during the interval between the deadline for submission of bids and the expiry of the period of bid validity specified by the Bidder on the Bid Form. Withdrawal of a bid during this interval shall result in the Bidder's forfeiture of its Bid Security.

20.0 BID OPENING AND EVALUATION

20.1 Company will open the Bids, including submission(s) made pursuant to para 18.0, in the presence of Bidder's representatives who choose to attend at the date, time and place mentioned in the Forwarding Letter. However, the Bidder's representative must produce an authorized letter from the bidder at the time of opening of tenders. Unless this Letter is presented, the representative will not be allowed to attend the opening of tenders. The Bidders' representatives who are allowed to attend the bid opening shall sign in a register evidencing their attendance. Only one representative against each bid will be allowed to attend.

20.2 Bid (if any) for which an acceptable notice of withdrawal has been received pursuant to para 18.2 shall not be opened. On opening the remaining bids Company will examine them to determine whether the same are complete, requisite Bid Securities have been furnished, documents have been properly signed and the bids are generally in order.

- 20.3 At bid opening, Company will announce the Bidders' names, written notifications of bid modifications or withdrawal, if any, furnishing of requisite Bid Security, rates/costs quoted and such other details as the Company may consider appropriate.
- 20.4 Company shall prepare, for its own records, minutes of bid opening including the information disclosed to those present in accordance with above sub-clauses.
- 20.5 To facilitate examination, evaluation and comparison of bids the Company may, at its discretion, ask the Bidder for clarifications of its bid. The request for clarification and the response shall be in writing and no change in the price or substance of the bid shall be sought, offered or permitted.
- 20.6 Prior to detailed evaluation, the Company will determine the substantial responsiveness of each bid to the Bidding Document. For this purpose, a substantially responsive bid is one, which conforms to all the terms and conditions of the Bidding Document without material deviations or reservation. A materials deviation or reservation is one which effects in any substantial way the scope, quality or performance of work, or which limits in any substantial way, in consistent way with the bidding document, the Company's right or the bidder's obligations under the contract, and the rectification of which deviation or reservation would affect unfairly the competitive position of other bidders presenting substantial responsive bids. The Company's determination of bid's responsiveness is to be based on the contents of the Bid itself without recourse to extrinsic evidences.
- 20.7 A Bid determined as not substantially responsive will be rejected by the Company and can not subsequently be made responsive by the Bidder through correction of the non-conformity.
- 20.8 The Company may waive minor informality or nonconformity or irregularity on a bid that does not constitute a material deviation, provided such waiver does not prejudice or affect the relative ranking of any Bidder.
- 20.9 The Company will examine the Bids to determine whether they are complete, any computational errors have been made, required sureties have been furnished, the documents have been properly signed, and the bids are generally in order.
- 20.10 Arithmetical errors will be rectified on the following basis. If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price (that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity) the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected accordingly. If any Bidder does not accept the correction of the errors, his bid will be rejected. If there is a discrepancy between words, and figures, the amount in words will prevail.
- 21.0 EVALUATION AND COMPARISON OF BIDS :
- The Company will evaluate and compare the commercial bids as per Bid Evaluation Criteria (Proforma-II, Section- VI) of the tender document to establish inter-se-ranking of bidders.
- 22.0 CONTACTING THE COMPANY :
- 22.1 Except as otherwise provided in para 18.0 & 19.0 above, no Bidder shall contact Company on any matter relating to its bid, from the time of the bid opening to the time the Contract is awarded.

- 22.2 An effort by a Bidder to influence the Company officials in bid evaluation, bid comparison or Contract award decisions, may result in rejection of their bid.

**D. AWARD OF CONTRACT**

**23.0 AWARD CRITERIA:**

The Company will award the Contract to the Contractor whose bid has been determined to be substantially responsive and has been determined as the lowest evaluated bid, provided further that the Bidder is determined to be qualified to perform the Contract satisfactorily.

**24.0 COMPANY'S RIGHT TO ACCEPT OR REJECT ANY BID:**

Company reserves the right to accept any bid and to reject any or all bids and/or to annul the bidding process in entirety, at any time prior to award of contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidders or any obligation to inform the participating bidders of the ground for Company's action.

**25.0 NOTIFICATION OF AWARD:**

- 25.1 Prior to the expiry of the period of bid validity or extended validity, the Company will notify the successful Bidder in writing by registered letter or by fax (to be confirmed in writing by registered / courier letter) that his bid has been accepted.
- 25.2 The notification of award will constitute formation of the Contract.

**26.0 PERFORMANCE SECURITY:**

- 26.1 Within 30 days of receipt of notification of award from the Company, the successful Bidder shall furnish the performance security for an amount (10% of annualized contract value) specified in the Forwarding Letter in the form of Bank Guarantee as per the performance Security Form as provided in the Bidding Document (Ref. Section – VII) from any of the following Banks:

- i) Any Nationalised / Scheduled Bank in India OR
- ii) Any Indian branch of a Foreign Bank OR
- iii) Any reputed foreign Bank which is not a Scheduled Bank in India, provided the Bank Guarantee issued by such Bank is counter-guaranteed by any Branch situated in India of any Scheduled Bank incorporated in India.

The performance security shall be payable to Company as compensation for any loss resulting from Contractor's failure to fulfill its obligations under the Contract.

- 26.2 The performance security specified above must be valid for nine (09) months beyond the expiry date of the contract covering the warranty/defect liability period of 6(six) months & time period required to allow Company to lodge claim, if any. The same will be discharged by Company not later than 30 days following its expiry. In the event of extension of contract, subsequent to expiry of validity of the original contract period, Contractor shall have to enhance the value of the performance security to cover 10 % of the contract value for the extended period and also to extend the validity of the performance security accordingly.

- 26.3 Failure of the successful bidder to comply with the requirements of para 26.1 or 26.2 above shall constitute sufficient grounds for annulment of the award and forfeiture of the Bid Security. In such an event, the Company may award the contract to the next lowest evaluated Bidder or call for new bid or negotiate with the next lowest bidder as the case may be.

#### INVOCATION OF PERFORMANCE BANK GUARANTEE

- 26.4 In the event of Contractor failing to honour any of the commitments entered into under the contract and/or in respect of any amount due from Contractor to Company, Company shall have an unconditional option under the guarantee to invoke the Performance Bank Guarantee and claim the amount from Bank.
- 26.5 Company will have the right to invoke the Performance Bank Guarantee in case the Contractor fails to mobilize the Equipment, tools and personnel etc. within the stipulated period irrespective of any reasons whatsoever.

#### 27.0 SIGNING OF CONTRACT:

- 27.1 At the same time as the Company notifies the successful Bidder that their Bid has been accepted, the Company will either invite the bidder for signing of the agreement or send the formal Contract document. The contract document will be accompanied by the General & Special Conditions of Contract, technical specifications, schedules of rates and all other relevant documents.
- 27.2 Within 15 days of receipt of the final contract document, the successful Bidder shall sign and date the contract and return the same to the Company.

#### **GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT made this ..... day of ..... 2017 between OIL INDIA LIMITED, a Company incorporated under the Companies Act 1956 and having its Registered Office at Duliajan in the district of Dibrugarh, Assam and Project Office at 2-A, Saraswati Nagar, Jodhpur-342005 (hereinafter called ‘The Company’) of the ONE PART and Sri ..... carrying of business as PROPRIETOR under the firm name M/s. .... with their Office at ..... in the district of ..... aforesaid (hereinafter called “The Contractor”) of the OTHER PART.

WHEREAS, in this Agreement the following terms shall be interpreted as indicated below :

- a) The “Agreement” means the Contract entered into between the Company and the Contractor, and terms & conditions as recorded in this document signed by the parties, including all attachments and appendices thereto and all documents incorporated by reference therein
- b) The “Agreement Price” means the prices/costs/rates payable by the Company to the Contractor under the contractual obligations.
- c) The ‘Work’ means each and every activity described in the Schedule of Work/Specifications, detailed in Proforma-II
- d) “Company” means OIL INDIA LIMITED and its executors, successors, administrators and assignees.
- e) “Contractor” means the individual or firm or Company performing the ‘work’ under this Agreement and its executors, successors and assignees.
- f) “Contractor’s personnel” means the personnel to be provided/deployed by the Contractor for due performance of the assigned work as per the Agreement.
- g) “Company Personnel” mean the personnel to be provided by the Company. The Representative/Engineer of the Company is also included in the Company’s personnel. The Company’s Representative/Engineer means the person or persons appointed and approved from time to time by the Company to act on its behalf for overall co-ordination and project management at site.
- h) “Site” means the land, installation and other places, provided and designated by the Company on which the works are to be executed by the Contractor.
- i) “Company’s item” means the equipment, materials, installations and services, which are to be provided by the Company at the expense of the Company.
- j) “Contractor’s item” means the equipment, materials and services, which are to be provided by the Contractor at the expense of the Contractor.
- k) “Commencement date” means the date on which the Contractor’s personnel starts the job as mentioned in the Agreement.
- l) “Gross negligence” as used in this Agreement shall mean ‘willful and wanton disregard for harmful, avoidable and foreseeable consequence’.

## **WITNESSETH :**

- 1.0 (a) The Contractor hereby agrees to carry out the work as per Schedule of Work in accordance with General Specifications read in conjunction with any drawings and Special terms & conditions of the Agreement.
- (b) In this Agreement all words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them hereinabove which the Contractor has perused and is fully conversant with before entering into this Agreement.

**2.0 Make of Vehicle:** Make of vehicle should be as per Schedule of Service / Rates and the vehicle(Goods Carrier Registered only) must be owned and registered preferably in the name of the Firm or in the name of owner of the firm during the entire tenure of contractual period including extension period, if any.

**3.0 Model of Vehicle:** As specified in the point of Schedule of Service.

**4.0 Mobilization of Vehicle:** The Transport Service Provider shall have to place their vehicle within 30 days from the date of LOA. Failure to place the vehicle will attract liquidated damage as set out in Para 13.0 below.

**5.0 Liquidated Damages:** The Transport Service Provider shall provide the services of vehicle by placing the same within 30 days from the date of Letter of Award of Contract failing which liquidated damages will be levied at the rate of 1.5 times of daily rate(calculated as the Pro-rata basis of monthly rate per day or part thereof for the delay in placement of vehicle subject to maximum of 7.1/2% of the total evaluated value of the contract.

**6.0 Penalty:** The Transport Service Provider shall supply and maintain the service of the vehicles in normal service EVERYDAY (24 HOURS) with driver throughout the day and night as required by the Company. In case of failure to keep up the vehicles in normal service on any day and night, the Transport Service Provider shall be liable to pay to the Company penalty at the rate of 1.5 times of fixed charge per vehicle per day. The total shut down hours would be converted into number of days and for fraction of day, the penalty would be charged proportionately. The above penalty is in addition to proportionate deduction of fixed charge for shut down Hours. Such penalty may be recovered from the service provider's outstanding bills or may be reduced or waived at the Company's discretion.

**7.0 Termination:** In the event of failure of the Transport Service Provider to place the vehicles or replacement thereof with similar vehicle in due time or to render proper services as per terms of this contract the Company reserves the right to terminate the contract with 15 (fifteen) days notice in writing and on the expiry of this notice period the service contract shall stand terminated and the Transport Service Provider shall not be entitled to any damage or compensation on account of such termination or otherwise from any cause arising whatsoever.

**7.1** The Company may send written notice to the Transport Supplier, terminate the agreement, in whole or in part at any time for its convenience. The notice of termination shall specify that the termination is for Company's convenience, the extent to which performance of service under this agreement is terminated and the date on which such termination becomes effective, which will be at least 45(forty Five) days after the date of the notice of termination. If the Company exercises this right, it shall pay the Transport Supplier in accordance with the provisions of this

agreement for the services satisfactorily rendered up to the date of termination. The Transport Supplier will not be entitled to any damages or compensation on account of such termination

**8.0 Payment:** The Company shall make payment, subject to adjustment /deduction as necessary, for the service rendered in each calendar month before the expiry of the subsequent calendar month on the basis of accepted rates calculations as mentioned Part #II of the Service contract provided bills without any discrepancy (which are to be submitted by the contractor once a month) are received not later than the 4th day of subsequent calendar month.

8.1 The Bill must be accompanied with the followings:

(i) Daily Log Book in original for the month

**9.0 Duration of Contract:** The duration of the service contract shall be for a period of (04) Four years.

10.0 The Transport Service Provider shall undertake to fully indemnify the Company against any and all claims which may arise under the Motor Vehicles Act, Mines Act, Payment of Bonus Act, workmen's compensation Act, Payment of Wages Act and / or Statutes having bearing over the service and / or engagement of workmen directly or indirectly for performance of service hereunder agreed upon.

**11.0 INSURANCE:** The transport supplier shall arrange comprehensive insurance to cover all risks in respect of their personnel, materials, equipment and vehicles belonging to the Transport supplier or his/her contractors during the currency of the agreement and provide certificates of such insurance.

12.0 The transport supplier should ensure that the drivers are available every day i.e. on Holiday, Sundays, Off days or during leave of the drivers as per the requirements of the Company's Engineer/Officer. In the event of failure to do so would tantamount to a default and the vehicles/equipment shall be treated as shut down, in which case the liquidated damages shall be deducted from the transport supplier.

13.0 Oil India Limited reserves the right to cancel this tender without assigning any reason whatsoever.

**14.0 Make & Model:**

(ii) Model : Bolero Camper 2WD BS4 with AC

15.0 Vintage of Equipment/Vehicle(s) : Brand new vehicle(s) purchased & Registered after the date of issue of LOA.

16.0 Tenure of Agreement : 04(Four) years from the date of Placement of Vehicle

17.0 Area of operations : In OIL's operational areas of Rajasthan and nearby states/areas.

18.0 Tendered Cost of Fuel per Liter : Rs.63.69 (as on 29.03.2017)

19.0 Mobilization Period :1(one) month from the date of issuance of LOA

20.0 Periodic inspection/test : a) On initial placement; and  
: b) Every three months thereafter or as and when considered necessary by the Company Engineer/Officer during the tenure of agreement.

20.1 Normal hours/timings of duty/day: As may be stipulated by the Company's Engineer/Officer (Subject to change depending upon the requirement).

## 21.0 **FORCE MAJEURE:**

21.1 In the event of either party being rendered unable by "Force Majeure" to perform any obligation required to be performed by them under this Agreement, the relative obligation of the party affected by such "Force Majeure" will stand suspended as provided herein. The word "Force Majeure" as employed herein shall mean acts of God, war, revolt, agitation, strikes, riot, fire, flood, sabotage, civil commotion, road barricade (but not due to interference of employment problem of the Contractor) and any other cause, whether of kind herein enumerated or otherwise which are not within the control of the party to the contract and which renders performance of the contract by the said party impossible.

21.2 Upon occurrence of such cause and upon its termination, the party alleging that it has been rendered unable as aforesaid thereby, shall notify the other party in writing within Seventy Two (72) hours of the alleged beginning and ending thereof, giving full particulars and satisfactory evidence in support of its claim.

21.3 Should "Force Majeure" condition as stated above occurs and should the same be notified within seventy two (72) hours after its occurrence, either party will have the right to terminate the Agreement if such "Force Majeure" condition continues beyond ten (10) days with prior written notice. Should either party decide not to terminate the Agreement even under such condition, no payment would apply after expiry of ten (10) days period unless otherwise agreed to.

## 22.0 **TERMINATION:**

### 22.1 **TERMINATION ON EXPIRY OF THE TERMS (DURATION):**

The Agreement shall be deemed to be automatically terminated on the expiry of duration of the Agreement (or extension, if any, thereof).

### 22.2 **TERMINATION ON ACCOUNT OF FORCE MAJEURE**

Either party shall have the right to terminate the Agreement on account of Force Majeure as set forth herein above.

### 22.3 **TERMINATION ON ACCOUNT OF INSOLVENCY**

In the event that the Transport Service Provider at any time during the term of the Agreement, becomes insolvent or makes a voluntary assignment of his/her assets for the benefit of the creditors or is adjudged bankrupt, then the Company shall, by a notice in writing have the right to terminate the Agreement and all the Transport Service Provider's right and privileges hereunder, shall stand terminated forthwith.

### 22.4 **TERMINATION FOR UNSATISFACTORY PERFORMANCE**



If the Company considers that, the performance of the Transport Service Provider is unsatisfactory, or not up to the expected standard, the Company shall notify the Transport Service Provider in writing and specify in details the cause of the dissatisfaction. The Company shall have the option to terminate the Agreement by giving 10 (ten) days notice in writing to the Transport Service Provider, if the Transport Service Provider fails to comply with the requisitions contained in the said written notice issued by the Company.

**22.5 TERMINATION DUE TO CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP & ASSIGNMENT:**

In case the Transport Service Provider's rights and/or obligations under the Agreement and/or the Transport Service Provider's rights, title and interest to the equipment/material, are transferred or assigned without the Company's consent, the Company may at its absolute discretion terminate the Agreement.

**23.0 CONSEQUENCES OF TERMINATION:**

23.1 In all cases of termination herein set forth, the relative obligations of the parties to the Agreement shall be limited to the period up to the date of termination. Notwithstanding the termination of the Agreement, the parties shall continue to be bound by the provisions of the Agreement that reasonably require some action or forbearance after such termination.

23.2 Upon termination of the Agreement, the Transport Service Provider shall return to the Company all of the Company's items, which are in Transport Service Provider's possession at the time.

23.3 Notwithstanding any provisions herein to the contrary, the Agreement may be terminated at any time by the Company on giving 10(ten) days written notice to the Transport Service Provider due to any other reason not covered under the above clauses from 8.1 to 8.2 and in the event of such termination the Company shall not be liable to pay any cost or damage to the Transport Service Provider except for payment for service charges and other charges as per the Agreement up to the date of termination.

23.4 In the event of termination of the Agreement, the Company will issue Notice of Termination to the Transport Service Provider with date or event after which the Agreement will be terminated. The Agreement shall then stand terminated and the Transport Service Provider shall have to demobilize his/her personnel and materials from the site, after handing over the company items, information, records etc. to the Company Representative.

24.0 In case of any doubt or dispute as to the interpretation of any clause herein contained the decision of the Company's representative shall be final and binding on the Transport Service Provider.

**25.0 ADDRESS FOR CORRESPONDENCE:**

Any notice required to be given under this Agreement including all correspondence shall be addressed to the respective parties at their given address. Any change in address shall be communicated by the respective parties in writing under registered cover at least fifteen days prior to the change of address.

**26.0 APPLICABLE LAWS :**

26.1 The contract shall be deemed to be a Contract made under, governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India for the time being in force and shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of Courts situated in Jodhpur, Rajasthan.

26.2 The Contractor shall ensure full compliance of various Indian Laws and Statutory Regulations, to the extent applicable, as stated below, but not limited to, in force from time to time and obtain necessary permits/licenses etc. from appropriate authorities for conducting operations under the contract :

- a) The Mines Act 1952-as applicable to safety and employment conditions .
- b) The Minimum Wages Act, 1948.
- c) The Oil Mines Regulations, 1983.
- d) The Workmen's Compensation Act, 1923.
- e) The Payment of Wages Act, 1963.
- f) The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965.
- g) The Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, 1970 and the rules framed thereunder.
- h) The Employees Pension Scheme, 1995.
- i) The Interstate Migrant Workmen Act., 1979 (Regulation of employment and conditions of service).
- j) The Employees Provident Fund and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952.
- k) The Rajasthan Tax Act
- l) Service Tax Act.
- m) Customs & Excise Act & Rules
- n) Rajasthan Entry Tax Act
- o) Value Added Tax
- p) Environment Protection Act
- q) Public Liability Act.
- r) Income tax act & sales tax act,
- s) Insurance act.

27.0 **SUBSEQUENTLY ENACTED LAWS:** Subsequent to the date of submission of Contractor's bid, if there is a change in or enactment of any law or interpretation of existing law, which results in additional cost/reduction in cost to Contractor on account of the operation under the Contract, the company/ Contractor shall reimburse/pay Contractor/company for such additional/ reduced costs actually incurred.

**28.0 ARBITRATION:**

28.1 Arbitration (Applicable for Suppliers/Contractors other than PSU) :

Except as otherwise provided elsewhere in the contract, if any dispute, difference, question or disagreement arises between the parties hereto or their respective representatives or assignees, in connection with construction, meaning, operation, effect, interpretation of the contract or breach

thereof which parties are unable to settle mutually, the same shall be referred to Arbitration as provided hereunder :

1. A party wishing to commence arbitration proceeding shall invoke Arbitration Clause by giving 30 days notice to the other party. The notice invoking arbitration shall specify all the points of dispute with details of the amount claimed to be referred to arbitration at the time of invocation of arbitration and not thereafter. If the claim is in foreign currency, the claimant shall indicate its value in Indian Rupee for the purpose of constitution of the arbitral tribunal.
2. The number of arbitrators and the appointing authority will be as under:

Claim amount (excluding claim for interest and counter claim, if any)	Number of Arbitrator	Appointing Authority
Upto Rs. 5 Crore	Sole Arbitrator	OIL
Above Rs. 5 Crore	3 Arbitrators	One Arbitrator by each party and the 3 <sup>rd</sup> Arbitrator, who shall be the presiding Arbitrator, by the two Arbitrators.

3. The parties agree that they shall appoint only those persons as arbitrators who accept the conditions of the arbitration clause. No person shall be appointed as Arbitrator or Presiding Arbitrator who does not accept the conditions of the arbitration clause.
4. Parties agree that there will be no objection if the Arbitrator appointed holds equity shares of OIL and/or is a retired officer of OIL/any PSU. However, neither party shall appoint its serving employees as arbitrator.
5. If any of the Arbitrators so appointed dies, resigns, becomes incapacitated or withdraws for any reason from the proceedings, it shall be lawful for the concerned party/arbitrators to appoint another person in his place in the same manner as aforesaid. Such person shall proceed with the reference from the stage where his predecessor had left if both parties consent for the same ; otherwise, he shall proceed de novo.
6. Parties agree that neither shall be entitled for any pre-reference or pendente-lite interest on its claims. Parties agree that any claim for such interest made by any party shall be void.
7. The arbitral tribunal shall make and publish the award within time stipulated as under :

Amount of Claims and counter claims(excluding interest)	Period for making and publishing of the award(counted from the date of first meeting of the Arbitrators)
Upto Rs. 5 Crore	Within 8 months
Above Rs. 5 Crore	Within 12 months

The above time limit can be extended by Arbitrator, for reasons to be recorded in writing, with the consent of the other parties.

8. If after commencement of the arbitration proceedings, the parties agree to settle the dispute mutually or refer the dispute to conciliation, the arbitrators shall put the proceedings in abeyance until such period as requested by the parties.

9. Each party shall be responsible to make arrangements for the travel and stay etc. of the arbitrator pointed by it. Claimant shall also be responsible for making arrangements for travel/stay arrangements of the Presiding Arbitrator and the expenses incurred shall be shared equally by the parties.

In case of sole arbitrator, OIL shall make all necessary arrangements for his travel, stay and the expenses incurred shall be shared equally by the parties.

10. The Arbitration shall be held at the place from where the contract has been awarded. However, parties to the contract can agree for a different place for the convenience of all concerned.

11. The Arbitrator(s) shall give reasoned and speaking award and it shall be final and binding on the parties.

12. Subject to aforesaid, provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and any statutory modifications or re-enactment thereof shall apply to the arbitration proceedings under this clause.

#### 28.2 Arbitration (applicable in case of Contract awarded on Public Sector Enterprise) :

In the event of any dispute or difference relating to, arising from or connected with the Contract, such dispute or difference shall be referred by either party to the arbitration of one of the Arbitrators in the Department of Public Enterprises, to be nominated by the Secretary to the Government of India, In-Charge of the Bureau of Public Enterprises. The Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 shall not be applicable to the Arbitration under this clause. The award of the Arbitrator shall be binding upon the parties to the dispute, provided however, any party aggrieved by such award may make a further reference for setting aside or revision of the award to the Law Secretary, Deptt. of Legal Affairs, Ministry of Law and Justice, Government of India. Upon such reference, the dispute shall be decided by the Law Secretary or the Special Secretary/Additional Secretary, whose decision shall bind the parties finally and conclusively. The parties in the dispute will share equally the cost of the arbitration as intimated by the Arbitrator.

The venue of all arbitrations under both 28.1 & 28.2 will be Jodhpur, Rajasthan. The award made in pursuance thereof shall be binding on the parties.

29.0 The Crane Service Provider shall undertake to fully indemnify the Company against any and all claims which may arise under the Motor Vehicles Act, Mines Act, Payment of Bonus Act, Workmen's Compensation Act, Payment of Wages Act and /or Statutes having bearing over the service and /or engagement of workmen directly or indirectly for performance of service hereunder agreed upon.

30.0 **ASSIGNMENT:** The Transport Supplier shall not assign his/her rights, duties and obligations arising under this agreement and sublet to any third person or party except in respect of payments to be received by Transport Suppliers, if acceptable to the Company.

31.0 The transport supplier should ensure that the drivers are available every day i.e. on Holiday, Sundays, Off days or during leave of the drivers as per the requirements of the Company's Engineer/Officer. In the event of failure to do so would tantamount to a default and the crane

shall be treated as shut down, in which case the liquidated damages shall be deducted from transport supplier.

## **32.0 TAX LIABILITIES**

- 32.1 Tax levied as per the provisions of Indian Income Tax Act and any other enactment/rules on income derived/payments received under the contract will be on Contractor's account.
- 32.2 Contractor shall be responsible for payment of personal taxes, if any, for all the personnel deployed by them.
- 32..3 All local taxes, levies and duties, sales tax, Service tax, octroi, toll tax etc. on purchases and sales made by contractor shall be borne by the contractor.

## **33.0 CONFIDENTIALITY, USE OF CONTRACT DOCUMENTS AND INFORMATION:**

33.1 Contractor shall not, without Company's prior written consent, disclose the contract, or any provision thereof, or any specification, workflow, sample or information furnished by or on behalf of Company in connection therewith, to any person other than a person employed by Contractor in the performance of the contract. Disclosure to any such employed person shall be made in confidence and shall extend only so far as may be necessary for purposes of such performance.

33.2 Contractor shall not, without Company's prior written consent, make use of any document or information except for purposes of performing the contract.

33.3 Any document supplied to the Contractor in relation to the contract other than the Contract itself remain the property of Company and shall be returned ( in all copies) to Company on completion of Contractor's performance under the Contract if so required by Company. All information obtained by Contractor in the conduct of work and the information/maps/Seismic Data/Log suites etc. provided to the Contractor shall be considered confidential and shall not be divulged by Contractor or its employees to anyone other than the Company's personnel. The various outputs/deliverables generated and the inferences and interpretations drawn as part and parcel of the work carried out under the terms of the Contract shall not be divulged by the Contractor or its employees to any other than the Company's personnel. This obligation of Contractor shall be in force even after the termination of the contract.

## **34.0 WARRANTY AND REMEDY OF DEFECTS**

34.1 The Contractor warrants that he shall perform the work in a first class, workmanlike, and professional manner and that all work shall be performed in accordance with highest quality, and efficiency with instructions and guidance which the Company may, from time to time furnish to the Contractor.

34.2 The rights and remedies of the Company provided by this clause are in addition to any other right and remedies provided by law or in equity or otherwise.

## **35.0 CHANGES:**

35.1 During the performance of the work, Company may make a change in the work mutually agreed within the general scope of this Contract including, but not limited to, changes in methodology, and minor additions to or deletions from the work to be performed. Contractor

shall perform the work as changed. Changes of this nature will be affected by written order (Change Order) by the Company.

35.2 If any change result in an increase in compensation due to Contractor or in a credit due to Company, Contractor shall submit to Company an estimate of the amount of such compensation or credit in a form prescribed by Company. Such estimates shall be based on the rates shown in the Schedule of Rates and Payment (PROFORMA-II). Upon review of Contractor's estimate, Contractor shall establish and set forth in the Change Order the amount of the compensation or credit for the change or a basis for determining a reasonable compensation or credit for the change. If Contractor disagrees with compensation or credit set forth in the Change Order, Contractor shall nevertheless perform the work as changed, and the parties will resolve the dispute hereunder. Contractor's performance of the work as changed will not prejudice Contractor's request for additional compensation for work performed under the Change Order.

36.0 **SUBCONTRACTING:** Contractor shall not subcontract or assign, in whole or in part, its obligations to perform under this contract, except with Company's prior written consent. The company is in no way duty bound in allowing such a request nor does it hold any responsibility for any time loss on such account.

37.0 **MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS:**

37.1 Contractor shall give notices and pay all fees at their own cost required to be given or paid by any National or State Statute, Ordinance, or other Law or any regulation, or bye-law of any local or other duly constituted authority as may be in force from time to time in India, in relation to the performance of the services and by the rules & regulations of all public bodies and companies whose property or rights are affected or may be affected in any way by the services.

37.2 Contractor shall conform in all respects with the provisions of any Statute, Ordinance of Law as aforesaid and the regulations or bye-law of any local or other duly constituted authority which may be applicable to the services and with such rules and regulation public bodies and Companies as aforesaid and shall keep Company indemnified against all penalties and liability of every kind for breach of any such Statute, Ordinance or Law, regulation or bye-law.

37.3 During the tenure of the Contract, Contractor shall keep the facility and resources allocated for the services free from other work obligations of the Contractor not under the preview of this Contract.

37.4 Key personnel cannot be changed during the tenure of the Contract except due to sickness/death/resignation of the personnel in which case the replaced person should have equal experience and qualification, which will be again subject to approval, by the Company.

38.0 **WAIVER & AMENDMENTS:** It is fully understood and agreed that none of the terms and conditions of the contract shall be deemed waived or amended by either party unless such waiver or amendment is executed in writing by the duly authorized agents or representatives of such party. The failure of either party to execute any right of termination shall not act as a waiver or amendment of any right of such party provided hereunder.

**39.0 RECORDS, REPORTS AND INSPECTION:** The Contractor shall, at all times, permit the Company and its authorised employees and representatives to inspect all the Work performed and to witness and check all the deliverables and tests made in connection with the said work. The Contractor shall keep an authentic, accurate history and logs reasonable times for inspection by the Company's designated representatives and its authorised employees and representatives. The Contractor shall provide the Company designated representatives with a weekly written report, on form prescribed by the Company showing details of work during the preceding week. The Contractor shall not, without Company's written consent allow any third person(s) access to the said records, or give out to any third person information in connection therewith.

**40.0 Provident Fund:** The Contractor if covered under the P.F Act and if the contract cost is inclusive of P.F., must ensure strict compliance of provisions of Provident Fund and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 in addition to the various Acts mentioned elsewhere in this contract. Any Contractor found violating these provisions will render themselves disqualified from any future tendering. As per terms of the contract, if applicable, the Contractor must deposit Provident Fund Contribution (covering Employee's & Employer's share) with the competent authority monthly under their direct code. The Contractor shall be required to submit documentary evidence of deposit of P.F. Contribution to the Company. In case of failure to provide such documentary evidence, the Company reserves the right to withhold the amount equivalent to 13.36% P.F. Contribution on wage component.

**41.0** General health, Safety and Environment aspects will be as per the terms set forth in **Appendix-A**.

**42.0** Procedure for obtaining Labour Licence under Contract Labour (R&A) Act, 1970 & Central Rules-1971 will as per terms set forth in **Appendix-B**.

**43.0 SET OFF CLAUSE :**

**43.1** Any sum of money due and payable to the Contractor (including Security Deposit refundable to them) under this or any other Agreement may be appropriated by Oil India Limited and set off against any claim of Oil India Limited (or such other person or persons contracting through Oil India Limited) for payment of a sum of money arising out of this Agreement or under any other Agreement made by the Contractor with Oil India Limited (or such other person or persons contracting through Oil India Limited).

## SECTION – IV

### SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITION

Hiring of 01(ONE) No Brand New Bolero Camper 2WD BS4 with AC (Goods Carrier Registration only) along with Driver for a period of 04(Four) Years for operation in different areas within the state of Rajasthan like Jodhpur, Ajmer, Jaipur, Barmer, Jaisalmer, Bikaner and Shriganganagar districts and any other surrounding State/areas of Companies activity as determined by the Company.

**1.0 SECURITY DEPOSIT / PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE:** The contractor shall deposit Security Deposit @ 10% of annualized contract value through Bank Guarantee issued in favour of OIL INDIA LIMITED, Jodhpur from any scheduled Bank with validity up to 6(six) months beyond the date of expiry of the contract. The security deposit will be returned to the contractor after 1(one) month of the date of expiry of the contract after adjustment of compensation/loss, if any, due to the Company for any reason. This security deposit shall not accrue any interest. In case of default on the part of the contractor, the security deposit shall automatically stand forfeited in full or in part and the contractor shall have no claim on this account whatsoever.

**2.0 Make of Vehicle:** Make of vehicle should be as per Clause 2.0 of PART # II (Schedule of Service / Rates) and the vehicle(Goods Carrier Registered only) must be owned and registered preferably in the name of the Firm or in the name of owner of the firm during the entire tenure of contractual period including extension period, if any.

**3.0 Model of Vehicle:** As specified in the point (ii) of Clause 1.0 of PART # II (Schedule of Service).

**4.0 Mobilization of Vehicle:** The Transport Service Provider shall have to place their vehicle within 30 days from the date of LOA. Failure to place the vehicle will attract liquidated damage as set out in Para 6.0 below.

**5.0 Liquidated Damages:** The Transport Service Provider shall provide the services of vehicle by placing the same within 30 days from the date of Letter of Award of Contract failing which liquidated damages will be levied at the rate of 1.5 times of daily rate(calculated as the Pro-rata basis of monthly rate per day or part thereof for the delay in placement of vehicle subject to maximum of 7.1/2% of the total evaluated value of the contract.

**6.0 Penalty:** The Transport Service Provider shall supply and maintain the service of the vehicles in normal service EVERYDAY (24 HOURS) with driver throughout the day and night as required by the Company. In case of failure to keep up the vehicles in normal service on any day and night, the Transport Service Provider shall be liable to pay to the Company penalty at the rate of 1.5 times of fixed charge per vehicle per day. The total shut down hours would be converted into number of days and for fraction of day, the penalty would be charged proportionately. The above penalty is in addition to proportionate deduction of fixed charge for shut down Hours. Such penalty may be recovered from the service provider's outstanding bills or may be reduced or waived at the Company's discretion.

**7.0 Termination:** In the event of failure of the Transport Service Provider to place the vehicles or replacement thereof with similar vehicle in due time or to render proper services as per terms of this contract the Company reserves the right to terminate the contract with 15 (fifteen) days notice in writing and on the expiry of this notice period the service contract shall stand



terminated and the Transport Service Provider shall not be entitled to any damage or compensation on account of such termination or otherwise from any cause arising whatsoever.

7.1 The Company may send written notice to the Transport Supplier, terminate the agreement, in whole or in part at any time for its convenience. The notice of termination shall specify that the termination is for Company's convenience, the extent to which performance of service under this agreement is terminated and the date on which such termination becomes effective, which will be at least 45(forty Five) days after the date of the notice of termination. If the Company exercises this right, it shall pay the Transport Supplier in accordance with the provisions of this agreement for the services satisfactorily rendered up to the date of termination. The Transport Supplier will not be entitled to any damages or compensation on account of such termination

**8.0 Payment:** The Company shall make payment, subject to adjustment /deduction as necessary, for the service rendered in each calendar month before the expiry of the subsequent calendar month on the basis of accepted rates calculations as mentioned Part #II of the Service contract provided bills without any discrepancy (which are to be submitted by the contractor once a month) are received not later than the 4th day of subsequent calendar month.

8.1 The Bill must be accompanied with the followings:

(i) Daily Log Book in original for the month

**9.0 Duration of Contract:** The duration of the service contract shall be for a period of (04) Four years.

**10.0 Address for Correspondence:** Any notice required to be given under this service agreement including all correspondence shall be addressed to the respective parties at their given address. Any change in address shall be communicated by the respective parties in writing under registered cover at least fifteen days prior to the change of address.

11.0 In case of any doubt or dispute arising under this Agreement the decision of the Company's representative shall be final and binding on the Transport Service Provider.

12.0 The Transport Service Provider shall undertake to fully indemnify the Company against any and all claims which may arise under the Motor Vehicles Act, Mines Act, Payment of Bonus Act, workmen's compensation Act, Payment of Wages Act and / or Statutes having bearing over the service and / or engagement of workmen directly or indirectly for performance of service hereunder agreed upon.

**13.0 INSURANCE:** The transport supplier shall arrange comprehensive insurance to cover all risks in respect of their personnel, materials, equipment and vehicles belonging to the Transport supplier or his/her contractors during the currency of the agreement and provide certificates of such insurance.

13.1 **ASSIGNMENT:** The Transport Supplier shall not assign his/her rights, duties and obligations arising under this agreement and sublet to any third person or party except in respect of payments to be received by Transport Suppliers, if acceptable to the Company.

14.0 **SUB-CONTRACT:** The Transport Supplier shall not sub-contract all or any part of the work envisaged under this Agreement.

15.0 **Force Majeure:** Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, shall not be liable for forfeiture of its performance security, Payment of penalties or termination for default, if and to the extent that, its delay in performance or other failure to perform its obligation under the Service Agreement is the result of any event of Force Majeure.

15.1 For the purpose of this clause, #Force Majeure# means as event beyond the control of or and not involving contractor#s fault or negligence. Such events include, but are not restricted to act of Company either in its sovereign or on agreement capacity, words or revolutions, fires, floods epidemics, quarantine restrictions and freight embargoes.

15.2 If a Force Majeure situation arises the Transport Service provider shall promptly notify the Company in writing of such condition and the cause thereof. Unless otherwise directed by the Company in writing shall continue to perform its obligations under the agreement as far as in reasonably practicable and shall seek all reasonable alternative means for performance not prevented by Fore Majeure event.

15.3 In the event of Force Majeure conditions involving war hostilities, riots, civil commotions, earthquake, strikes/lockouts, whether legal / illegal etc. prevailing and continuing for more than 15 days, the Company shall be entitles to terminate the agreement by giving 15 days Notice thereof in writing after the first days of Force Majeure.

16.0 The transport supplier should ensure that the drivers are available every day i.e. on Holiday, Sundays, Off days or during leave of the drivers as per the requirements of the Company#s Engineer/Officer. In the event of failure to do so would tantamount to a default and the vehicles/equipment shall be treated as shut down, in which case the liquidated damages shall be deducted from the transport supplier.

17.0 Oil India Limited reserves the right to cancel this tender without assigning any reason whatsoever.

- 1) The service to be rendered shall be on hire basis as per the rates specified in Part-II. The period of hire of the vehicle under these service agreement will be for a period of 4(Four) years.
- 2) The vehicles shall be equipped with all standard fittings; instruments etc. and conform to the provisions of Motor Vehicle Act including Insurance cover, Fitness Certificate, Registration Certificate etc.
- 3) The vehicles shall at all times be licensed (at the Service Provider's cost) by appropriate government Authority to ply on contract basis in Jodhpur, Barmer, Jaisalmer, Bikaner & Sriganganagar District of Rajasthan State and any other surrounding state/areas of the Company's activities as determined by the company.

#### **CLAUSE # II:**

1. The speedometer and kilometer record must be maintained at a high standard of accuracy. Any defects noticed by Company's officer at the initial and subsequent per indicial inspection shall have to be rectified forthwith by the Contractor at his cost. Until such rectification, the reading of the instrument will be subject to such correction factors as determined by the Company Officers. For purpose of monthly payments corrected reading of the various records, if such corrections is deemed necessary will be binding on the Contractor.
2. In the event any vehicle becoming out of order, or otherwise not available, a relief equivalent vehicle shall be placed in service immediately as substitute. In the event of failure on the part of the Contractor, liquidated damages will be payable by the Contractor as specified in this tender document. Also, the Company has the right to make alternative arrangement and additional expenditure incurred by the Company in arranging alternative arrangement, if any, will be recovered from the Contractor.
3. Drivers of the vehicles provided against the contract must be in possession of valid professional driving license authorizing him to drive the particular type of vehicle in the manner

required under this contract. Name of the driver with full particulars of driving licenses shall be furnished to the Company at the commencement of the agreement and also on every occasion when a driver is required to be replaced for any reason.

4. Regarding the color & other details of the car, the contractor should contact Chief Manager (A&ER) before purchasing the vehicle.

4.1 The driver or drivers engaged by the contractor should be of good character, discipline and in good health. If the driver or drivers indulges in any theft, or other unlawful activities, action will be taken as per the law of the land. If the vehicle is seized by the Police or any other law enforcing agency for such activities, while on company's duty, it will be the responsibility of the contractor to deal with the matter.

5 In company's opinion, if a driver is not attending duty properly or having bad credentials or found involved in theft or any other unlawful activities drunken driving, he may not be issued any entry pass. In that event, the contractor has to remove the driver on getting advice from the company.

6 Drivers, when operating the vehicles, must be in a fit physical and mental condition and shall not be under the influences of intoxication of any type.

7 All persons employed by the Contractor under the Service Agreement must observe -

8 All the rules promulgated by Rajasthan State Administration from time to Time for working Rajasthan.

9 While working inside the declared prohibited areas, if any person is found to be objectionable from security considerations, the person must be replaced by the Contractor.

9.1 The vehicle shall carry Name Plates or Markings (for purpose of identification) inscribing #ON OIL INDIA LIMITED DUTY# and towing Hock at the rear, as directed by the Company Representative at the cost of the Contractor.

10 During the currency of this Contract while on duty on call basis, the Contractor shall NOT # withdraw the vehicle on company duty from service for any other purposes (except in connection with repairs).

11 Notwithstanding with any clause of the contract, it will be terminated on account any one of the following situation -

11.1 Deteriorated mechanical condition of the vehicle.

11.2 Frequent shutdown due to non-availability of fuel etc.

11.3 During the currency of the contract, if it is found that the contractor submitted any false statement / document in the application / tender document

12 The vehicle (Goods Carrier Registered only) must be owned and registered preferably in the name of the Firm or in the name of owner of the firm during the entire tenure of contractual period including extension period, if any. Change of ownership of vehicle at any time during the tenure of the contract period will lead to termination of the contract.

13 Payment shall be made for the days / kilometerage actually logged on Company's duties as per instructions of the Company's Engineer/officer and as reflected in the Daily Log Book.

14 Under no circumstances, the vehicle should carry out/involve in any unlawful activities /duties. In the event of any such case, the contractor will be held responsible for the consequences.

15 On receipt of the Monthly statement-cum-kilometreage Bill the Company's Engineer shall verify the same with the Daily Log Book and forward the same after making adjustment as may be necessary to the Finance Department of the Company for Payment. The Bill must be accompanied with the following:

15.1 Daily Log Book in original for the month.

16. All standard safety devices & AC fitted to the vehicles should be in working condition.

17 The Contractor will make all arrangement at for fuelling/servicing/repairing of the vehicle, boarding and lodging of his staff at his cost.

18 The Transport Service Provider shall render trouble free services during the agreement period without any failure. The Transport Service Provider will be allowed a shut down for maximum of 48 hours at a stretch per month exclusively for maintenance and repair of each vehicle preferably on Sundays. The day will be selected with the permission of the company as per convenience of company's work and LD and Penalty will not be applicable for this 48 hours at a stretch per month. However, Penalty and LD will be applicable for beyond more than 48 hours at a stretch shut down in a calendar month. However, if it is found that the vehicle was not utilized for maintenance and repair purpose, the company will impose LD & Penalty at its sole discretion.

19 The driver can be replaced even for short period, only with permission of the company Engineer/Officer.

20 The rates shown in Part-II shall be fixed and firm for the entire tenure of the contract and shall be binding on both the parties. No changes in these rates shall be allowed under any circumstances during the tenure of this service agreement.

21 The rates Per Kilometre run shall be corresponding to the HSD RATE (Rs. 63.69) prevailing as on 29.03.2017. All minor increase/Decrease of rate of fuel price within 5% shall be absorbed by the contractor. In case of any change in rates of HSD beyond 5% compensation for increase/Decrease in running cost will be paid to the contractor or recovered as the case may be. For calculation of such compensation, Mileage (HSD compensation rate) for the vehicle may be considered as 14 KM/Liter without AC and 12 KM/Liter with AC .

22 Parking Charges/ Toll charges/ Inter-State tax shall be reimbursed by OIL at actual against documentary evidence of such payments.

23. ## **SECTION-V**

### **SCOPE OF WORK**

1.0 Hiring of transport services of following brand new vehicle along with drivers and with all standard fittings as per the manufacturers latest leaflets and purchased after issuance of LOA for operational areas in Rajasthan and any other surrounding states/areas of the Company's activities as determined by the Company for a period of 04(Four) years. The vehicle shall have Goods Carrier Registration and comply with Motor Vehicle Act which includes provision of Safety Belts, First Aid Box and Fire Extinguisher etc. The Transport Service Provider shall be responsible for all Central / State Govt. and local taxes inclusive of fees, insurance, capital investment, operating expenses etc. and the rates shall be inclusive of all such and similar charges. The rates shall also be inclusive of all incidental and contingent operations which, although not specifically mentioned in the service contract, are necessary for the performance of the service in a satisfactory manner and up to the desired standard. The Transport Service Provider shall supply and maintain the service of the vehicles in normal service EVERYDAY with drivers thorough out the day and night as required by Company. In case of failure to keep up the vehicle in normal service on any day and night, the Service Provider shall be liable to pay to the Company liquidated damage.

WHEREAS the Company desires to hire the above mentioned services.

1.0 The Contractor should have adequate capacity to undertake the aforesaid service and is equipped with fully trained personnel capable of adequately operating and providing the required services.

2.0 #BREACH OF CONTRACTUAL OBLIGATION# means amongst others also the following:

- (i) Carriage of unauthorized passengers by the Transport Supplier while under this agreement with the Company.
- (ii) Unauthorized use of the vehicle(s)/equipment when released to the Transport Supplier for undertaking its deployment for any other business purpose.
- (iii) Withdrawal of vehicles/equipment from the service before expiry of the term of this agreement for any reason whatsoever without the consent/instruction of the Company Engineer/Officer.
- (iv) Failure to park the vehicles/equipment after release on close of working hours at place designated by the company's engineer/officer.
- (v) Failure of the Transport Supplier to place the vehicles/equipment for periodic inspection as per schedule as directed by Company's Engineer/Officer.
- (vi) The vehicle(Goods Carrier Registered only) must be owned and registered preferably in the name of the Firm or in the name of owner of the firm during the entire tenure of contractual period including extension period, if any.

2.0 "LICENCE AND PERMITS" means any and all of the following which must be valid and updated periodically by the Transport Supplier to the satisfaction of the Company:-

- a. Professional driving license(s) and P.S.V. badge(s) for the driver(s)
- b. Registration Book(s) with endorsement of Road Tax
- c. Permits for plying the vehicle(s)/equipment for commercial purpose as may be required
- d. Road permits

- e. Fitness certificate
- f. Comprehensive insurance certificate(s) both for vehicle(s)/equipment as well as driver/Crew
- g. Any other as required under law in force
- h. Pollution under control certificate

4.0 "STATUTORY ACTS" means all the State and Central Government statutes and regulations effecting the operation of the services under this Agreement as may be in force from time to time and shall particularly include but not be limited to the following;

- i. The Motor Vehicle Act, 1988,
- ii. The Motor Transport Worker's Act, 1961,
- iii. The Contract Labour (Regulations & Abolition) Act, 1970,
- iv. The Minimum Wages Act, 1948,
- v. The Employees Provident Fund & Miscellaneous Act, 1952,
- vi. The Oil Mines Act, 1972 and Oil Mines Regulation, 1984,
- vii. The Workmen Compensation Act, 1923 &
- viii. Industrial Disputes Act, 1947.

**5.0 Fixed Charge Per Month:** Fixed charge mentioned under of PART-II(Special Terms & Conditions) hereof which will be inclusive of depreciation, all applicable taxes & duties, insurances, wages and other emoluments of drivers inclusive of relief drivers which the transport supplier will have to engage and provide at all times essentially for the continuous operation of the service envisaged under this agreement. The supplier shall have to ensure full compliance with Motor Vehicles Act 1988 and Motor Transport Workers Act 1961 and the Rules framed there under all other statutory acts as may be in force from time to time governing the engagement of staff, their conditions of service which must include minimum wages as per the aforesaid Acts, Statutory/Weekly offs, holiday, overtime, annual leave, uniforms etc.. No other separate charges on such accounts will be payable by the company at any point of time during the tenure of the contract and same, if any, shall have to be borne entirely by the transport supplier. The fixed charges payable under this agreement shall be deemed to be inclusive of all payments to be borne by the transport supplier on all such accounts. Fixed charge also includes the cost of consumables and fuel as may be required for stipulated normal hours of duty at a stationary place when there is no km run.

#### **6.0 OBLIGATIONS OF THE TRANSPORT SUPPLIER:**

6.1 The Transport Supplier shall observe and abide by all the Statutory Acts and shall be primarily and solely responsible for observance of the rules and regulations stipulated hereunder.

6.2 The Transport Supplier shall be responsible and liable for all claims, monetary or otherwise, arising out of the use of vehicle(s)/equipment or operations of the services envisaged under this agreement including liability under the Statutory Act or any other liability as may arise due to operation of this agreement and the Company shall not be held liable or responsible for any such claim in any manner whatsoever. The Statutory requirements and obligations to be performed under the Statutory Acts affecting the operations of the services under this Agreement shall have to be performed by the Transport Supplier only and shall be his/her sole responsibility. Be it stated particularly that the Transport Supplier hereby undertakes to fully implement entirely at his/her own cost all the provisions of the Motor Transport Workers Act, 1961 and other Statutory Acts as may be in force from time to time and the rules framed there under as may be applicable to the operation of the service envisaged under this agreement in the area of operations of the Company.



6.3 The Company shall not be liable for any dues, statutory or otherwise claimed by the employees/workmen employed by the Transport Supplier for the services rendered under this agreement and all such claims, statutory or otherwise or operation of any settlement or award in favour of the employees/workmen employed by the Transport Supplier will be solely against the Transport Supplier and not against the Company. Be it expressly stated that any demands whether present or future by the employees deployed by the Transport Supplier against the services envisaged under this agreement shall have to be settled and satisfied by the Transport Supplier solely and in the event of any loss or inconvenience or disruption that may result because of any non-settlement of such demands which may lead to a disruption of service envisaged under this Agreement shall also be deemed as a default.

6.4 The Company shall neither entertain any demands from the employees of the Transport Supplier nor deal directly or indirectly with any recognized or un-recognized unions of such employees. Be it expressly stated that it shall be primarily and solely the responsibility of the Transport Supplier to deal, interact and settle any demands or disputes of his/her employees individually or through any unions or otherwise and the Company shall not mediate in this matter at all.

6.5 Any unsettled disputes between the Transport Supplier and his/her employees leading to a legal or illegal strike by them would have to be settled by the Transport Supplier expeditiously. In the event of such a strike, whether legal or illegal, the vehicle(s)/equipment shall be treated as shut down. Any failure on the part of the Transport Supplier to settle the disputes expeditiously or with reasonable dispatch which results in interruption of the services envisaged under this Agreement would be considered as a default under this agreement and the agreement would be terminated at the discretion of the Company. The Transport Supplier shall, however, be given reasonable opportunity by the Company to explain that the cause of the dispute was not due to delay on his/her part or due to failure to implement the statutory obligations under the Statutory Acts as stipulated hereof. In the event if it is proved that the Transport Supplier was in default as mentioned here above, the Company shall have the option to terminate the Agreement forthwith and the Transport Supplier shall not be entitled to any damages or compensation whatsoever on account of such termination.

6.6 The Transport Supplier shall ensure that the vehicle(s)/equipment deployed under this service agreement do not cause any damage to the Company's properties. In the event of any such damages, the cost of repair in respect thereof as determined by the Company's Engineer shall be deducted from the Transport Suppliers outstanding bills. The Company's decision in this regard shall be final and binding.

6.7 The Transport Supplier shall be responsible and liable for all claims, monetary or otherwise, arising out of the use of the equipment / vehicles or operation of the services envisaged under this Agreement including liability under the Motor Vehicles Act, Payment of Bonus Act, Workmen's Compensation Act, Payment of Wages Act or any other statutory liabilities as may be in force from time to time and whatsoever. 9.0 The service shall be to the satisfaction of Company's Officer/Engineer who shall have powers, amongst other, to

a) Order the Transport Service Provider to remove immediately any cause of unsatisfactory performance of the service.

b) Order the Transport Service Provider to replace, any person/driver/helper/mechanic/supervisor engaged for the running of vehicle or for general management of the service, if and when such person is found unsuitable for the purpose of rendering efficient service to the Company

c) Order the Transport Service Provider from time to time such further instructions as shall be necessary for the purpose rendering the services properly and adequately and for keeping records which are deemed to be necessary for the Company. Non compliance of the instructions will make the contractor liable for penalty as per the provisions of the contract.

**GENERAL HSE POINTS**

- 1.0 It will be solely the Contractor's responsibility to fulfill all the legal formalities with respect in the Health, Safety & Environmental aspects of the entire job (namely, the persons employed by him, the equipment, the environment etc.) under the jurisdiction of the district of that state where it is operating. Ensure that all sub Contractors hired by him comply with the same requirement as the Contractor himself and shall be liable for ensuring compliance all HSE laws by the sub or sub Contractors.
- 2.0 Every person deployed by the Contractor in a mine must wear safety gadgets to be provided by the Contractor. The Contractor shall provide proper Personnel Protective Equipment as per the hazard identified and risk assessed for the job and conforming to statutory requirement and the Company PPE schedule. Safety appliances like protect footwear, safety helmet and full body harness has to be DGMS approved. Necessary supportive document shall have to be submitted as proof. If the Contractor fails to provide the safety items as mentioned above to the working personnel, the Contractor may apply to the Company (OIL) for providing the same. OIL will provide the safety items, if available, but in turn. OIL will recover the actual cost of the items by deducting from Contractor's bill. However, it will be the Contractor's sole responsibility to ensure that the persons engaged by him in the mines use the proper PPE while at work. All the safety gears mentioned above are to be provided to the working personnel before commencement of the work.
- 3.0 The Contractor shall prepare written Safe Operating Procedure (SOP) for the work to be carried out, including as assessment of risk, wherever possible and safe methods to deal with it/them. The SOP should clearly state the risk arising to men, machineries and materials from the mining operation/operations to be done by the Contractor and how it is to be managed.
- 4.0 The Contractor shall provide a copy of SOP to the person designated the Mine Owner who shall be supervising the Contractor's work.
- 5.0 Keep an up to date SOP and provide a copy to changes to a person designed by the Mine Owner/Agent/Manager
- 6.0 The Contractor has to ensure that all work is carried out in accordance with the Statute and SOP and for the purpose he may deploy adequate qualified and competent personnel for the purpose of carrying out the job in a safe manner. For work of a specified scope/nature, he should develop and provide to the Mine Owner a site
- 7.0 All persons deployed by the Contractor for working in mine must undergo Mines Vocational Training, initial medical examination, PME. They should be issued cards stating the name of the Contractor and the work and its validity period, indicating status of MVT, IME & PME.
- 8.0 The Contractor shall submit to DGMS indicating – name of his firm Registration Number, name 7 Address of person heading the firm, nature of work, type of deployment of work persons, No. of work persons deployed, how many work persons hold VT Certificate, how many work persons undergone IME and type of medical coverage given to the work persons.

- 9.0 The return shall be submitted quarterly (by 10<sup>th</sup> of April, July, October & January) for contracts of more than one year. However, for contracts of less than one year, returns shall be submitted monthly.
- 10.0 It will be entirely the responsibility of the Contractor/ his Supervisor/Representative to ensure strict adherence to all HSE measures and statutory rules during operation in Oil's installations and safety of workers engaged by him. The crew members will not refuse to follow any instruction given by the Company's Installation Manager/Safety Officer/Engineer/Official/Supervisor/Junior Engineer for safe operation.
- 11.0 Any compensation arising out of the job carried out by the Contractor whether related to pollution, Safety or Health will be paid by the Contractor only.

- 23.0 When there is a significant risk to health, environment or safety of a persons or pace arising because of a non-compliance of HSE measure the Company will have the right to direct the Contractor to cease work until the non-compliance is corrected.
- 24.0 The Contractor should prevent the frequent change of his contractual employees as far as practicable.
- 25.0 The Contractor should frame a mutually agreed bridging document between OIL and the Contractor with roles and responsibilities clearly defined.
- 26.0 For any HSE matters not specified in the Contract document, the Contractor will abide the relevant and prevailing Acts/Rules/Regulations pertaining to Health, Safety and Environment.

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**Procedure for obtaining Labour Licence under Contract Labour (R&A) Act, 1970 & Central Rules-1971**

Every Contractor to whom this Act applies shall execute any work through Contract Labour only after obtaining valid licence from Licensing Officer. To obtain licence contractor is required to submit:

- i) Application in Form IV in triplicate duly filled (Name of the Proprietor/Partner or the Directors/Responsible person in case of firm/company, complete postal address including Pin Code number, Telephone Number, Fax Number & E-mail address, if any), correct details of PE and work to be executed etc. correctly against all columns;
- ii) In case contractor is registered under the Companies Act and applicant is other than Director then he should be holding valid Power of Attorney.
- iii) Original Form-V issued by PE
- iv) Demand Draft for licence fees and security deposit payable in favour of Regional Labour Commissioner (Central), Ajmer along with duly filled central challan (in TR-6) duly signed by applicant in quadruplicate for each demand draft;
- v) Copy of Work Order;
- vi) Copy of Partnership Deed and in case of Company, the application should be accompanied with Memorandum of Association/Article of Association;

- Note:
- 1. Application form complete in all respect shall be either personally delivered to the Licensing Officer or can be sent by Registered A.D. Post.
  - 2. Contractors, may intimate Dy. Chief Labour Commissioner (Central), Ajmer for expediting/suitable action if they do not receive licence nor any communication within a week.
  - 3. Contractors are not required to visit office of Licensing Officer unnecessarily for obtaining licence until and unless they have been specifically advised to appear in person. Appearance of contractors in the office of licensing officer for obtaining licence by persuasion will be viewed seriously.

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
