BID REJECTION CRITERIA /BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BRC)

[A] Financial capability: Bidders must have;

- a) Average Annual financial turnover as per Audited Annual Reports for the last three accounting years preceding scheduled bid opening date should be at least Rs 1,92,200/-.
- b) For Proof of Annual Turnover any of the following documents /photocopy must be furnished
 - A Certificate issued by a practicing Chartered / Cost Accountant Firm, with membership number certifying the Annual Turnover and nature of business.
 - Audited Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss account.

[B] Experience: Bidders must have:

Experience of having successfully completed similar works (<u>similar work means</u> <u>supply of Manpower</u>) during last 7 years ending last day of month previous to the one in which applications are invited should be either of the following:

- (i) Three similar completed works each costing not less than Rs. 2,56,300/-.
- (ii) Two similar completed works each costing not less than **Rs. 3,20,300/-.**

Or

(iii)One similar completed works each costing not less than Rs. 5,12,500/-.

Documentary proof must be furnished in support of the experience by way of purchase order / work order / contract document along with completion certificate from the organization to whom such services have been rendered.

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[C] <u>BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC)</u>:
