BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC)

The bid shall conform to the specifications and terms and conditions given in the Bidding Documents. Bids will be rejected in case material and services offered do not conform to the required parameters stipulated in the technical specifications. Notwithstanding the general conformity of the bid to the stipulated specifications, the following requirements will have to be particularly met by the Bidders without which the same will be considered as non-responsive and rejected. All the documents related to BRC shall be submitted along with the Techno-Commercial Bid.

1.0 FINANCIAL CAPABILITY: BIDDERS MUST HAVE ;

- 1.1 The average annual financial turnover of the Bidder during the last three years (**ending 31st March 2013**) should be not less than **Rs. 5,45,800.00**

For proof of annual turn over any of the following document / photocopy must be submitted along with the bid.

- a) A certificate issued by a practicing chartered / Cost accountant firm, with membership number certifying the annual turn over and nature of business.
- b) Audited Balance Sheet and Profit and Loss account.

2.0 TECHNICAL: BIDDERS ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 2.1 The Bidder shall have experience of maintenance / laying of OFC or maintenance / laying Pipeline along OIL's ROW in last 07(seven) years ending last day of month previous to the one in which applications are invited should be either of the following :

- a) Three contract of minimum value than ` **7,27,700.00** or
- b) Two contracts of minimum value than ` **9,09,600.00** or
- c) Single contracts of minimum value than ` **14,55,400.00**

Similar work refers to:-

Having experience of (i) Maintenance / Laying of OFC or (ii) Maintenance / Laying Pipeline along OIL's ROW.

For proof of experience, the following document/photocopy must be submitted along with the bid:-

Copy of certificate of completion (COC)/ Payment Certificates issued by the State Govt. Organization / Central Govt. Organizations / PSEs / other reputed organizations for the period as mentioned in para-2.1. above, showing:-

- a) Gross Value of Job done,
- b) Nature of job done, and
- c) Time period covering the financial year(s) as per NIT.

Note:

Documentary evidence in support of work experience and fulfilling the requirement as spelt out in clause 2.1 must be submitted along with the bid. These documents shall be in the form of document / photocopies of Work Order/Contract/Completion Certificates issued by the State Govt. Organization / Central Govt. Organizations / PSEs / other reputed organizations, showing

- a) Gross Value of Job Done;
- b) Nature of Job Done and
- c) Time Period covering the financial years as per NIT.

However, the originals of these documents shall have to be produced by the bidder, as and when asked for.

3.0 EVALUATION OF BIDS:

The Bids will be evaluated as per the Bid Evaluation Criteria (BEC) as stated herein under:

BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC)

- 1 Bids conforming to the technical specification, terms and conditions stipulated in the bid document and considered and subject to qualifying the Bid Rejection Criteria will be considered for further evaluation.
- 2 To ascertain the inter-se-ranking, the comparison of the responsive bids will be made on the basis of total amount quoted for the items of SOQ of the tender.
- 3 Any discount/rebates offered shall not be considered for evaluation of bids. However, if the lowest bidder happens to be the final acceptable bidder for award of contract and if they have offered any discount/rebate the contract shall be awarded after taking into consideration such discount/rebate after negotiation or otherwise.
- 4 In case more than one bidder emerges as lowest bidder due to equal rate quoted by the bidder, then the lowest bidder will be decided by draw of lots. Company's decision in this regard is final and binding to all bidders.
