All corrigenda, addenda, amendments, time extension, clarification etc. to the tender will be hosted on the Oil Website and no separate notification shall be issued in the press. Prospective bidders are requested to regularly visit the website.

BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC) / BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC)

The bid shall conform generally to the specifications and terms and conditions given in the Bidding Documents. Bids will be rejected in case material and services offered do not conform to the required parameters stipulated in the technical specifications. Notwithstanding the general conformity of the bid to the stipulated specifications, the following requirements will have to be particularly met by the Bidders without which the same will be considered as non-responsive and rejected. All the documents related to BEC/BRC shall be submitted along with the Techno-Commercial Bid.

1.0 Financial capability: Bidders must have:

(A) Annual financial turnover as per Audited Annual Reports in any of the preceding three (3) three financial years should be at least Rs. 1,32,000.00.

FOR CONSORTIUM:

At least one member of the consortium to meet the above criteria of 50% turnover. The other members of consortium should meet minimum 25% turnover requirement.

- **(B)** Net Worth should be positive for the preceding financial year.
- (C) For proof of Annual Turnover & Net worth any one of the following document must be submitted along with the bid:
 - i) A certificate issued by a practicing Chartered/Cost Accountant (with Membership Number and Firm Registration Number), certifying the Annual turnover & Net worth

ii) Audited Balance Sheet along with Profit & Loss account..

2.0 Experience: Bidders must have:

- 2.1 Experience of having successfully completed similar works during last 7 years ending last day of month previous to the one in which applications are invited should be of the following:
 - (i) Experience of at least 1(one) similar work of Rs. 2,20,000.00

similar works (Similar works mean 'Providing services Mechanical workshop services for refurbishment of machinery components using various workshop operation like turning, thread making, drilling, reaming, shaping, honing, welding, brazing, gas-cutting, hydraulic press etc. in Central Govt. Organization/PSU/State Govt. Organization/Semi-State Govt. Organization or any other Central/State Govt. Undertaking in India

The Bidder must have ownership of a functional Mechanical Workshop located within Jorhat Town area, District – Jorhat, Assam.

The bidder shall submit the complete address of the mechanical workshop with details such as name of owner(s), Govt. registration number etc. along with bid for record and verification.

The above Mechanical Workshop must possess following mandatory machineries & facilities in healthy condition as a minimum:

Lathe Machine (with job holding capacity of minimum 325 mm diameter), Shaper machine, Pedestal Drill machine, Pedestal Grinding machine, Arc Welding machine, Gas Welding/cutting set, Brazing facilities, hydraulic bench press.

Bidder shall submit a list of machineries & facilities available in his/her workshop, which, as a minimum, must comply the aforementioned requirements.

- 2.2 In case the bidder is a Central Govt. Organization/PSU/State Govt. Organization/Semi-State Govt. Organization or any other Central/State Govt. Undertaking, where the auditor is appointed only after the approval of Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the Central Government, their certificates may be accepted even though **FRN** (**Firm Registration Number**) is not available. However, bidder to provide documentary evidence for the same.
- 2.3 Considering the time required for preparation of financial statements, if the last date of preceding financial/accounting year falls within the preceding six months reckoned from the original bid closing date and the financial statements of the preceding financial/accounting year are not available with the bidder then the financial turnover of the previous three financial/accounting years excluding the preceding financial/accounting year will be considered. In such cases, the Net Worth of the previous financial/accounting year excluding the preceding financial/accounting year will be considered. However, the bidder has to submit an affidavit/undertaking certifying that the balance sheet/financial statements for the financial year________(as the case may be)has actually not been audited so far

NOTE-:

- (i) A job executed by a bidder for its own organization / subsidiary cannot be considered as experience for the purpose of meeting BEC.
- (ii) In case of tenders for Annual rate contracts / Maintenance and Service contracts, if the prospective bidder is executing rate / maintenance /service contract which is still running and the contract value / quantity executed prior to due date of bid submission is equal to or more than the minimum prescribed value in the BEC such experience will also be taken in to consideration provided that the bidder has submitted satisfactory work / supply / service execution certificate issued by end user.
- iii) For proof of requisite experience and relevant technical requirements, any one of the following documents/photocopies must be submitted along with the bid:
- 2.4 In case of OIL contractors, copy of 'Certificate of Completion(COC)'/ 'Certificate of Payments(COP)'/ 'Service Entry Sheet' of jobs successfully completed, during last 7(seven) years ending bid closing date, showing gross value of job done. It may be clearly noted that simply mentioning of OIL CCO Number will not be accepted.
- 2.5 Relevant certificate issued by any other Public Sector Undertaking/Govt. Department in last seven (07) years ending bid closing date showing:
 - a) Gross value of job done; and
 - b) Nature of job done; and
 - c) Time period covering the financial year(s) as per NIT; and
 - d) Clearly mentioning job completion date.
- 2.6 The Bidder must have a business office establishment for a least one year within 50 Km radius of the area of operation where the services need to be provided. Documentary evidence must be provided in the form of Municipality trade license or other such documents as per the following which satisfies as a proof of having the office establishment.
 - (i) Trade License issued by the local authority in the name of the Firm or
 - (ii) Landline phone number in the name of the Firm or
 - (ii) Electricity bill for last one year in the name of the Firm

All the supporting documents in compliance to BRC requirements under clause 1.0, 2.0, 2.6 above shall be scanned and uploaded along with the technical bid.

- 2.7 Any bid not complying BRC requirements shall be summarily rejected.
- 2.9 To ascertain the substantial responsiveness of the bid the Company reserves the right to ask the Bidder for clarification in respect of clauses covered under BRC and such clarification fulfilling the BRC clauses must be received on or before the deadline given by the Company, failing which the offer will summarily rejected.
- 3.0 In case, any of the clauses in the BRC contradict with other clauses of Bid Document elsewhere, then the clauses in the BRC shall prevail.
- 3.1 Bidders must have PF Account in their name issued by Regional Provident Fund Commissioner and ESI registration. Documentary evidence of the same is to be submitted.

3.0 Deviation to the following provision of the tender document shall make the bid liable for rejection:

- i. Firm price
- ii. EMD / Bid Bond
- iii. Scope of work
- iv. Specifications
- v. Price Schedule
- vi. Delivery / Completion Schedule
- vii. Period of Validity of Bid
- viii. Liquidated Damages

- xi. Arbitration / Resolution of Dispute
- xii. Force Majeure
- xiii. Applicable Laws
- xiv. Integrity Pact, if applicable
- xv. Any other condition specifically mentioned in the tender documents elsewhere that non-compliance of the clause lead to rejection of the bid.

Non Furnishing of the above information may be liable for rejection of the offer.

4.0 COMMERCIAL:

- 1 Bidder shall submit the offer under "Single Stage Single Bid System".
- 2. Bidder shall furnish Bid Security along with Bid. Any bid not accompanied by a proper bid security will be rejected. Bidder shall submit original document to the address as specified with BCD before Bid opening date and time, otherwise Bid will be rejected. A scanned copy of this document should also be uploaded along with the bid.
- 3. Omitted.
- 4. Bidder shall furnish Bid Security as referred in Relevant Section of the Bid document so as to reach the Company (i.e. OIL) before due date of closing. Any bid for which bid security is not received before due Date of Bid Closing will be rejected.
- 5. Validity of the bid shall be minimum 90 days. Bids with lesser validity will be rejected.
- 6. Any bid received in the form of Telex/Cable/Fax/E-mail/ Telephone call will not be accepted.
- 7. Bidders must quote clearly and strictly in accordance with the price schedule outlined in relevant section of Bidding Documents; otherwise the bid will be rejected.
- 8. Any bid containing false statement will be rejected.
- 9. The Bid Documents are not transferable. Bids made by parties who have not purchased the Bid Documents from the Company will be rejected.
- 10. Any Bid received by the Company after the deadline for submission of bids prescribed by the Company will be rejected.
- 11. Price quoted by the successful Bidder must be firm during the performance of the Contract and not subject to variation on any account. A bid submitted with an adjustable price will be treated as non-responsive and rejected.
- 12. The following Clauses with all its sub-clauses should be agreed in toto, failing which the bid will be rejected. To this effect Bidder shall submit an undertaking along with the Technical Bid.
 - a) Performance Security Clause
 - b) Force Majeure Clause
 - c) Termination Clause
 - d) Settlement of disputes Clause
 - e) Liquidated Damages Clause.
 - f) Acceptance of Jurisdiction and applicable law.

- g) Tax liabilities clause.
- h) Insurance clause.
- i) With holding clause.
- j) Liability clause.
- k) Set off clause

5.0 GENERAL:

- 1. In case Bidder takes exception to any clause of Tender Document not covered under BEC/BRC, then the Company has the discretion to load or reject the offer on account of such exception if the Bidder does not withdraw/ modify the deviation when/as advised by the Company. The loading so done by the Company will be final and binding on the Bidders. No deviation will however, be accepted in the clauses covered under BEC/BRC.
- 2. To ascertain the substantial responsiveness of the bid the Company reserves the right to ask the Bidder for clarification in respect of clauses covered under BEC/BRC also and such clarification fulfilling the BEC/BRC clauses must be received on or before the deadline given by the Company, failing which the offer will summarily be rejected.
- 3. In case, any of the clauses in the BRC contradict with other clauses of Bid Document elsewhere, then the clauses in the BRC shall prevail.
- 4. Bidder shall fulfill all the relevant clauses applicable for this e-Tender.
- 5. The original copy of documents [submitted by bidders(s)] shall have to be produced by bidder(s) to OIL as and when asked for.

6.0 **Evaluation of Bids**:

The Bids will be evaluated as per the Bid Evaluation Criteria (BEC) as stated herein under:

BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC)

- Bids conforming to the terms and conditions stipulated in the bid document and considered responsive and subject to qualifying the Bid Rejection Criteria will be considered for further evaluation.
- 2 To ascertain the inter-se-ranking, the comparison of the responsive bids will be made on the basis of total amount quoted for the items of SOQ.
- In case more than one bidder emerges as lowest bidder due to equal rate quoted by the bidder, then the lowest bidder will be decided by draw of lots. Company's decision in this regard is final and binding to all bidders
- Any discount/rebates offered shall not be considered for evaluation of bids. However, if the lowest bidder happens to be the final acceptable bidder for award of contract and if they have offered any discount/rebate the contract shall be awarded after taking into consideration such discount/rebate after negotiation or otherwise.
- Company will open the Bids in the presence of Bidder's representatives who choose to attend at the date, time and place mentioned in the Forwarding Letter. However, an authorization letter from the bidder must be produced by the Bidder's representative at the time of bid opening. Unless this Letter is presented, the representative will not be allowed to attend the bid opening. Only one representative against each bid will be allowed to attend.
- Bid for which an acceptable notice of withdrawal has been received shall not be opened. Company will examine bids to determine whether they are complete, whether requisite

Bid Securities have been furnished, whether documents have been properly signed and whether the bids are generally in order.

- At bid opening, Company will announce the Bidder's names, written notifications of bid modifications or withdrawal, if any, the presence of requisite Bid Security and such other details as the Company may consider appropriate.
- 8 Company shall prepare, for its own records, document containing the information disclosed to those present in accordance.
- To assist in the examination, evaluation and comparison of bids the Company may at its discretion, ask the Bidder for clarifications of its bid. The request for clarification and the response shall be in writing and no change in the price or substance of the bid shall be sought, offered or permitted.
- Prior to the detailed evaluation, Company will determine the substantial responsiveness of each bid to the requirement of the Bidding Documents. For purpose of these paragraphs, a substantially responsive bid is one, which conforms to all the terms and conditions of the Bidding Document without deviations or reservation. A deviation or reservation is one which affects in any way substantial way the scope, quality, or performance of work, or which limits in any substantial way, in-consistent way with the bidding documents, the Company's right or the bidder's obligations under the contract, and the rectification of which deviation or reservation would affect unfairly the competitive position of other bidders presenting substantial responsive bids. The Company's determination of bid's responsiveness is to be based on the contents of the Bid itself without recourse to extrinsic evidence.
- A Bid determined as not substantially responsive will be rejected by the Company and may not subsequently be made responsive by the Bidder by correction of the non-conformity.
- The Company may waive minor informality or nonconformity or irregularity in a bid, which does not constitute a material deviation, provided such waiver, does not prejudice or affect the relative ranking of any Bidder.
- Quoted rates must be in conformity with the applicable minimum wage as applicable otherwise bid will be rejected.

7.0 **OPENING OF COMMERCIAL/PRICE BIDS:**

- 24.1 Company will open the Commercial/Price Bids of all the Bidders on a specific date in presence of interested bidders.
- 24.2 The Company will examine the Price quoted by Bidders to determine whether they are complete, any computational errors have been made, the documents have been properly signed, and the bids are generally in order.
- Arithmetical errors will be rectified on the following basis. If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price (that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity) the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected accordingly. If any Bidder does not accept the correction of the errors, their bid will
- 21.4 All entries in the offer must be made in English. Rates quoted must be firm and shall be both in figures and words. In case of any discrepancy the rates quoted in words will prevail. No overwriting shall be allowed and all corrections must be initiated. The quoted

price shall be the net price inclusive of all taxes/charges/expenses. (However taxes, duties, charges etc. considered should also be shown separately). In absence of these details the quoted price shall be considered as net price inclusive of all taxes, duties, charges/expenses for providing the services at the required place/location.

21.5 Bidders are requested quote their rates in the Price Format enclosed as per SOQ. Rates quoted shall be both in figures and words. In case of any discrepancy the rates quoted in words will prevail.

8.0 EXEMPTION OF TENDER FEE AND EMD:

- (i) Small Scale Industries (SSI) registered with NSIC under Single Point Registration Scheme are exempted from payment of tender fees for the items they are registered with NSIC. Valid registration certificate with NSIC must be enclosed along with the application for issuing tender documents.
- (ii) Public Sector Undertakings (PSU), Central Govt. Departments are also exempted from payment of tender fee.
- (iii) Firms registered with NSIC, PSU's & Government Departments claiming exemption from payment of tender fee should submit their request with all credentials to the tender administrator at least 7 days in advance from the date of closer of sale of bid documents, to get access for participation in the tender.
- (iv) Tender documents provided to SSI Units registered with NSIC on free of charge basis shall submit their offer for the service for which they are registered. Their offer for other than the registered service shall not be acceptable. Their offer as service provider also will not be acceptable and shall be rejected straightway.
- (v) Public Sector Undertakings (PSU), Central Govt. Departments, Small Scale Industries (SSI) registered with NSIC under Single Point Registration Scheme are exempted from payment of Earnest money deposit for the items they are registered with NSIC. Valid registration certificate with NSIC must be enclosed along with the application for issuing tender documents
