BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC) / BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC)

A) Financial capability: Bidders must have

1. Average Annual financial turnover as per Audited Annual Reports for the last three accounting years (**ending 31st March, 2015**) should be at least **₹ 2,91,600.00**

For Proof of Annual Turnover any of the following documents /photocopy must be furnished

- A Certificate issued by a practicing Chartered / Cost Accountant Firm, with membership number certifying the Annual Turnover and nature of business.
- Audited Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss account.

2. Experience: Bidders must have;

The Bidder must have experience of having successfully completed similar works during last 7 years ending last day of the month previous to the one in which applications invited either of the following:

- (i) Three completed works each costing not less than **₹ 3,88,800.00**
Or
- (ii) Two completed works each costing not less than **₹ 4,86,000.00**
Or
- (iii) One completed works each costing not less than **₹ 7,77,600.00**

SIMILAR WORK :

Similar work means all works pertaining to ISO and/or OHSAS certification related to oil and gas industry.

NOTE :

The Bidder must have accreditation for certification from the National Accreditation Board for Certification Bodies (NABCB).

B) EVALUATION OF BIDS:

The Bids will be evaluated as per the Bid Evaluation Criteria (BEC) as stated herein under:

BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC)

1. Bids conforming to the terms and conditions stipulated in the bid document and considered responsive and subject to qualifying the Bid Rejection Criteria will be considered for further evaluation.
2. Inter-se ranking of the bids will be on the basis of total value of the rates quoted by the participating consultants/ consulting firms .
3. Any discount/rebates offered shall not be considered for evaluation of bids. However, if the lowest bidder happens to be the final acceptable bidder for award of contract and if they have offered any discount/rebate the contract shall be awarded after taking into consideration such discount/rebate after negotiation or otherwise.
4. In case more than one bidder emerges as lowest bidder due to equal rate quoted by the bidder, then the lowest bidder will be decided by draw of lots. Company's decision in this regard is final and binding to all bidders
