BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC)

The bid shall conform generally to the specifications and terms and conditions given in the Bidding Documents. Bids will be rejected in case material and services offered do not conform to the required parameters stipulated in the technical specifications. Notwithstanding the general conformity of the bid to the stipulated specifications, the following requirements will have to be particularly met by the Bidders without which the same will be considered as non-responsive and rejected. All the documents related to BRC shall be submitted along with the Techno-Commercial Bid.

[A] Financial capability: Bidders must have:

Average Annual financial turnover as per Audited Annual Reports for the last three accounting years ending financial year (ending 31st March, 2015) should be at least `1,86,000.00

For Proof of Annual Turnover any of the following documents /photocopy must be furnished

- A Certificate issued by a practicing Chartered / Cost Accountant Firm, with membership number certifying the Annual Turnover and nature of business.
- Audited Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss account.

The bidder shall submit Bank Account number, Provident Fund Code No., PAN, Service Tax Regd. No. and VAT Regd. No. along with bid.

[B] Experience: Bidders must have;

1. The bidder must have sufficient experience and competency in rewinding of various motors and alternators of capacity up to 40 HP and 25 KVA respectively.

- 2. The bidders shall have experiences of having successfully completed in rewinding of various motors and alternators of capacity up to 40 HP and 25 KVA respectively in State Govt. Deptt./ Central Govt. Organizations/ PSEs during last seven years ending last day of the month previous to the month of NIT publication.
 - (i) Three similar completed works each costing not less than $^{\circ}$ 2.48,000.00
 - (ii) Two similar completed works each costing not less than `3,09,900.00

Or

(iii) One similar completed works each costing not less than '4.95,900.00

<u>"Similar works shall work means"</u>: Rewinding of various motors and alternators of capacity up to 40 HP and 25 KVA respectively in State Govt. Deptt./ Central Govt. Organizations/ PSEs.

Note:

- 1. Documentary evidence in support of work experience and fulfilling the requirement as spelt out in clause [B] above must be submitted along with techno-commercial bid.
- 2. These documents should be in the form of copies of Job Completion Certificates/ Payment Certificates issued by the State Govt. Deptt./Central Govt. Organizations/ PSEs showing the Gross value of Job done, Nature of Job and Period of Contract. However, the originals of these documents shall have to be produce by the bidder, as and when asked for.
- 3. In case of OIL Contracts copy of Service Entry Sheet or Job Completion certificate showing Gross value of Job Done, Nature of Job and Period of contract should be submitted. Please note that merely mentioning the work order will not be accepted.

For proof of requisite Experience, any one of the following document/ photocopy must be submitted along with the bid:

- i) In case of contracts executed under Oil India Ltd., copy of 'Certificate of Completion (COC)'/
 'Certificate of Payment (COP)'/ 'Service Entry Sheet (SES)' of jobs successfully completed
 during the last 7 (seven) years ending bid closing date showing gross value of job done. It
 may be clearly noted that simply mentioning of OIL CCO/ Contract Number will not be
 accepted.
- ii) Certificate issued by any other Public Sector Undertaking/ Govt. Department/ Other Company in last 7 (seven) years ending bid closing date showing:
 - (a) Gross value of job done,
 - (b) Description of job done,
 - (c) Contract period

C) Evaluation of Bids:

The Bids will be evaluated as per the Bid Evaluation Criteria (BEC) as stated herein under:

BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC)

- The bids conforming to the technical specifications, terms and conditions stipulated in the tender documents and considered to be responsive after subjecting to Bid Rejection Criteria will be considered for further evaluation as per the Bid Evaluation Criteria given below.
- To ascertain the inter-se-ranking, the comparison of the responsive bids will be made subject to loading for any deviation. Comparison of offers will be done on total evaluated cost on the basis of rates quoted in the Price Bid Format.
- In case of identical lowest offered rate by more than 1 (one) bidder, the selection will be made by draw of lot between the parties offering the same lowest price.

D) EXEMPTION OF TENDER FEE AND EMD:

- (i) Small Scale Industries (SSI) registered with NSIC under Single Point Registration Scheme are exempted from payment of tender fees for the items they are registered with NSIC. Valid registration certificate with NSIC must be enclosed along with the application for issuing tender documents.
- (ii) Public Sector Units (PSU) are also exempted from payment of tender fee.
- (iii) Firms registered with NSIC, PSU's & Government Departments claiming exemption from payment of tender fee should submit their request with all credentials to the tender administrator at least 7 days in advance from the date of closer of sale of bid documents, to get access for participation in the tender.
- (iv) Tender documents provided to SSI Units registered with NSIC on free of charge basis shall submit their offer for the service for which they are registered. Their offer for other than the registered service shall not be acceptable. Their offer as service provider also will not be acceptable and shall be rejected straightway.
- (v) Small Scale Industries (SSI) registered with NSIC under Single Point Registration Scheme are exempted from payment of Earnest money deposit for the items they are registered with NSIC. Valid registration certificate with NSIC must be enclosed along with the application for issuing tender documents
