SCOPE OF WORK:

The scope of work covers manufacture and supply of skid mounted portable crew hut for use of employees of Logistics Department, OIL, Duliajan at well site **as per Drawing No.: OIL 7767/A enclosed herewith**. Specifications, dimensions, fittings, accessories, terms and conditions etc. as in the above drawing including the 14 points under note of it as well as **Annexure-I** given below. (Salient points as in the drawing are provided in **Annexure-II**).

Annexure-I

ADDITIONAL FEATURES AND TERMS & CONDITIONS:

A. ADDITIONAL FEATURES:

- 1. Skid fabricated from ISMB 250 channels only.
- 2. Skid minimum 04 (four) longitudinal channels.
- 3. All steel works including table & benches with smooth edges & corners to avoid injury.
- 4. Inner wall of water waterproof polished or plain ply-board or plain ply-board covered with mica sheet on 50mmx50 mm timber framing.
- 5. Suitable locking arrangement for stay rod of window chajja/shed.
- 6. <u>Electrical wiring in suitable conduits for single-phase 240 V power supply complete with</u> following:
- a. 02 (two) Nos. 40 watts tube light.
- b. 03 (three) Nos. mim. 400 mm size wall mounted swivel fan with suitable guard.
- c. 01 (one) No. 5 amp plug point in switch board in addition to 02 (two) 15 amp points.
- 7. Provision to hook-up external power supply to the main switchboard of hut through suitable connectors located outside side panels at minimum 1.50 metre height.
- 8. Two Nos. of exhaust fans on the on the wall at suitable locations to be provided.

B. TERMS & CONDITIONS:

- OIL **reserves the right** to inspect, test and if necessary reject the hut/huts after delivery at site in case of any fault on the part of the supplier. It shall no way be waived by the reason that the hut/s was previously inspected and passed by OIL as per Inspection Clause detailed above.

Salient dimensions, features etc. as in the Drawing No.: 7767/A mentioned hereunder for not fully legible in the drawing.

A. Major Dimensions:

1. Length of Cabin : 5600 mm 2. Width of cabin : 2500 mm

3. Overall length with the skid: 6500 mm 4. Overall width with the skid: 2850 mm

5. Overall Height : 3000 mm

6. Inside height of cabin : 2400 mm

(from floor to false ceiling)

B. The 14 points under note in the drawing:

- 1. All the tubular posts should be welded to ISMB 250 and not to the chequered plates (i.e. not to the floor sheets)
- 2. All MS sheets shall have stitch welds 75 mm long 150 mm gap with all steel adjoining steel members.
- 3. All steel works to be fabricated by welding except otherwise specified
- 4. Roof, table, bench ends & corners should be rounded suitably.
- 5. One coat of primer to be provided to all exposed as well as unexposed surface of the steel works for protection from rust. The hut to be finally painted (2 coats) with synthetic paint {inside cabin-Light Sky Blue (Not White), Outside Hut-Steel Grey}.
- 6. Coat hook arrangement to be provided at lintel level all around inside (15 Nos.) at a gap of around two feet in between two hooks.
- 7. MS "L" drops and hooks of approved quality to be provided on doors, toolbox lid, windows (from inside for windows), etc. for locking arrangement. 3 (three) Navtal 7 levers padlocks-not 2 (two) Nos. to be provided for door and tool box lid locking.
- 8. Toolbox, bench, table are to be fixed to the floor by welding.
- 9. Windows to be guarded with 75 mm square mesh X 5 mm dia. IRC fabric.
- 10. False ceiling is to be made of either hard board or ply board of 6 mm thick on 75 mm X 50

mm timber framing.

- 11. Door, window hinges to be welded to the frame but not to wall panel.
- 12. Each skidded hut be offered for inspection to our Engineer(s):
- i) On completion of fabrication job of the frame but before fixing of walls and roof and ceiling,


