- 2.Any query / clarification sought by OIL from the Bidder must be furnished within the stipulated time frame. Failing which the offer shall be considered as non responsive and shall be rejected.
- 3. All documents in the bide shall have to be furnished as detailed under Sl. No. B: Note to Bidders of the NIT (Bidders response sheet).

### 4. Documents & Certificates

- I. Documents should be forwarded along with the quotations:

### 5. Warrantee:

The warranty period for the flow meters shall be a minimum of 18 months from the date of dispatch / shipment or 12 months from the date of commissioning.

# 6. Installation & Commissioning:

- I. Installation / commissioning charges should be quoted separately which shall be considered for evaluation of the offers. These charges should include amongst others to and fro fares, boarding/ lodging and other expenses of the commissioning crew during their stay at Duliajan, Assam (India). All Personal, Income and Service Tax etc. towards the services provided by the supplier shall be borne by the supplier and will be deducted at source. Bidders should also confirm about installation/ commissioning in the Technical Bid.
- II. All necessary mechanical (piping and end connections) jobs as recommended by the supplier vide Clause No 4.II (of Documents & Certificates) shall be carried out by OIL.
- III. Installation and Commissioning of the flow meter(s) shall be carried out by the bidder in the presence of OIL representatives at its fields at Duliajan, Assam (India). Only competent service personnel shall be engaged for installation, testing and commissioning of flow meter(s).
- IV. OIL Shall provide only transportation for the Commissioning Crew to and fro to Work site from OIL's office at Duliajan. No lodging shall be provided by OIL to the Commissioning Crew.
- V. Arc welding / Gas Cutting services if required shall be provided by OIL.
- VI. OIL will provide necessary statutory permits in classified areas as and when required.

VII. The flow meter(s) shall be treated as commissioned only after successful completion of a trial run for minimum 72 hours and on satisfactory performance, shall be subsequently handed over to OIL.

### BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC) / BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC)

### 1. BID REJECTION CRITERA (TECHNICAL):

I. The bids must conform to the specifications, terms, and conditions given in the NIT. Bids shall be rejected in case the items offered do not conform to the required minimum / maximum parameters stipulated in the technical specifications and to the respective international /national standards wherever stipulated. - a. Installation & Commissioning charges shall be considered for evaluation of the offers.
- b. To evaluate the inter-se-ranking of the offers, Assam Entry Tax on purchase value will be loaded as per prevailing Govt. of Assam guidelines as applicable on bid closing date. Bidders may check this with the appropriate authority while submitting their offer.
