OIL Super 30 achieves remarkable success in the 2017 IIT Entrance Examination

Under OIL Super 30, 99 students have cracked the IIT entrance examination this year. This is the best ever result achieved under the project, with 99 out of 147 students in the batch qualifying the prestigious IIT-Advance entrance examination. Oil India Limited had instituted the CSR project, OIL Super 30, in 2010, with its first centre at Guwahati.
