DALMIA CEMENT (BHARAT) LTD., TAMIL NADU	N/A	N/A	OIL has been procuring API Class G Cement for Oil Well Cementation Jobs through rate contracts following open tender procedures. Against several previous tenders, M/s. Dalmia Cement (Bharat) Ltd. has been getting rate contracts and accordingly, their product was in use for several years in and around FHQ, Duliajan without any adverse report. However, last PO (Ref. PO # 7119357/SSG/P1 dated 11.07.2017) was placed on L-1 bidder M/s. Shri Digvijay Cement Co. Ltd., Jamnagar for supply of 2,40,000 bags of cement covering two years projected requirements. However, after receipt of 1st Lot from them, after completion of necessary laboratory test conforming to relevant API 10A parameters, the supplied lot of M/s. Shree Digvijay Cement was taken into stock. However, in actual field operations, the cement supplied by M/s. Shree Digvijay Cement Co. exhibited high gelation properties. Therefore, comparative studies were carried out in OIL's Chemical Lab to ascertain the probable cause of high gelation and related pumping problems observed in field use. Further, when efforts were made to formulate appropriate cement slurry for oil string cementation jobs, it was disclosed that the thickening time of slurry and consistency trend of Shree Digvijay Cement do not compare favourably with that of M/s. Dalmia Cement. While the matter has been taken up with supplier M/s. Shree Digvijay Cement Co. Ltd. to improve the cement characteristics and conduct a joint inspection test in presence of OIL's representatives, it was apprehended that a stock out situation might arise for 2 to 3 months. Hence, approval was obtained from the competent authority by the User Department vide Proposal No. DRLG/CMTG/063/2018 dated 23.03.2018 for procurement of one rake load of API Class G Cement from M/s. Dalmia Cement (Bharat) Ltd., Tamil Nadu on nomination basis (considering long experience of trouble-free cement formulations for various well conditions & execution of diverse cement jobs in field operations with Ex-Dalmia Cement)

Previously the efficacy of the same has been demonstrated under laboratory condtions. Lemon Grass is a green chemistry and would eventually replace toxic Bactericide chemicals presently being used in the field. In order to implement the project within the timeframe proposed, timely procurement of the Lemongrass oil is a critical step. In this connection efforts were initiated to contact the vendor recommended by NEDFi, under DoNER Ministry, Gol for procurement of bulk quantities of authentic Lemongrass oil from M/s Brahmaputra Valley Aromatic Oil Industries, located in Kaliabor Tiniali, Nagaon, Assam.  The Field trial, as part of the proposed MoU project, is proposed to be conducted in Kathaloni OCS for a period of Tree Months and the total requirement of Lemon Grass Oil is calculated to 9000 Kgs at the rate of 100 ppm.  View above, approval of competent authority was obtained vide proposal ref. no. R&D/25E/338/2018 dated 23.03.2018 for procurement of Lemon Grass Oil (Water Soluble grade) on nomination basis from M/s Brahmaputra Valley Aromatic Oil Industries, Nagaon.

These Items are required to carry out the milling of GPA of 8 Nos. of wells of Greater Hapjan area.</p> <p>In the Warroom Meeting held on 18.04.2018 CMD in presence of other directors advised to go aheadwith the retrieval of the GPAs immidiately. In order to speed up the retrieval of these GPAs potential sources such as M/s. Baker Hughes and M/s. Schlumberger were contacted for supplying of High Performance Junk mill to submit their Budgetary Quotation with best delivery time. In response M/s. Baker Hughes metined that they need 5 months to manufacture this type of mills. However, M/s. Schlumberger agreed to supply within 5-6 weeks after receipt of order.</p> <p>Therefore, in view of urgency of materilas, Nomination order has been awarded on M/S. SMI OILFIELD TECHNOLOGY AND PRODUCTS FZE a Schlumberger company.</p>
