Hance, as a stop gap arrangement, it was proposed to award the contract on a nomination basis. Admin Department mentioned that they have proposed to award a short-term contract to the existing vendor i.e. M/s. Himalaya Enterprise, as it wouldn't be feasible to identify and negotiate Terms & conditions with a new vendor on such short notice. Also, M/s. Himalaya Enterprise has agreed to execute the above short-term contract at the same rate, terms & conditions as prevailing in the last contract.
