Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. **OPTION CLAUSE:** The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.
2. **Bidder financial standing:** The bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings, should not be bankrupt. Bidder to upload undertaking to this effect with bid.
3. Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Supply Installation Testing and Commissioning of Goods
4. Warranty period of the supplied products shall be 1 years from the date of final acceptance of goods or after completion of installation, commissioning & testing of goods (if included in the scope of supply), at consignee location. OEM Warranty certificates must be submitted by Successful Bidder at the time of delivery of Goods. The seller should guarantee the rectification of goods in case of any break down during the guarantee period. Seller should have well established Installation, Commissioning, Training, Troubleshooting and Maintenance Service group in INDIA for attending the after sales service. Details of Service Centres near consignee destinations are to be uploaded along with the bid.

1.0 Queries Submission Timeline clause-

All prospective bidders are hereby instructed to submit any queries or requests for clarification related to this tender within a period of five (5) calendar days from the date of publishing of this tender document. Any queries received after the stipulated deadline will not be entertained or responded to by OIL. Queries must be submitted in writing via email to **dipankar.pathak@oilindia.in**. Please ensure that the subject line of your email clearly states 'Tender Query - [Tender No. & Name]'.

2. Avoidance of Extension for Bid Submission clause -Bidders are earnestly advised to ensure that their bid submissions are prepared and submitted in accordance with the deadlines specified in this tender document. OIL has taken all necessary steps to establish reasonable timelines for the submission of bids to allow ample time for thorough preparation. As a matter of policy, OIL will only

you consider granting an extension of the bid submission due date as a onetime exception in situations deemed unavoidable. Such extensions will be granted solely at the discretion of OIL and only in response to a written request from the bidder (mail to dipankar.pathak@oilindia.in), submitted in accordance with the procedures outlined in this tender document. It is hereby emphasized that OIL will not entertain or consider any requests for an extension of the bid submission due date, except in cases where OIL deems such extension unavoidable necessitating the extension. Bidders are therefore strongly advised to refrain from seeking an extension of the bid submission due date unless absolutely necessary due to unforeseen and unavoidable circumstances. By participating in this tender process, all bidders acknowledge and accept the terms and conditions outlined in this Avoidance of Bid Submission Due Date Extensions clause.

3.0 The hard copy of the Bid Security / EMD (for mode of submission other than online payment) is to be submitted in original in sealed envelope superscribed with GeM Bid No. and Bid End Date to CGM-Materials (HoD), Materials Department, Oil India Limited, Duliajan- 786602, Assam within the Bid Closing Date & Time, failing which the bid shall be treated as incomplete & lead to rejection of the bid by buyer without making any reference to the seller. Also, scanned copy of the same shall be mandatorily uploaded by the bidder in their online bid. This is in supersession of GeM GTC allowing for submission of hard copy of bid security / EMD (for mode of submission other than online payment) within 5 days of Bid Closing Date .

4.0 Bid Security / EMD must be valid for minimum 165 days from the original bid closing date (17/07/2024), i.e. valid up to minimum 29/12/2024. Offers received with lesser Bid Security validity shall be straightway rejected.

5.0 If Bank Guarantee is submitted towards 'Bid Security', then seller has to ensure that the Bank Guarantee issuing bank indicates the name and detailed address (including e-mail) of their higher office from where confirmation towards genuineness of the Bank Guarantee can be obtained.

6.0 Bidders are requested to submit Undertaking for Local Content(Annexure-F) uploaded in Buyer uploaded ATC document.

7.0 The items in the tender shall be used in flammable environment of Oil & Gas process industry {as per Notification No. FP-20013/2/2017-FP-PNG-Part (4) (E-41432) dated 26th April 2022 of MOPNG}. Bidders are requested to take note of the same and submit duly filled up undertaking (Annexure-F) attached in Buyer uploaded ATC Document.

8.0 Indigenous Supplies Certificate (ISC) formerly Known as Essentiality Certificate (EC) :The items covered by this enquiry shall be used by Oil India Limited in the PEL/ML areas which are issued/renewed after 01/04/99 and hence concessional rate of GST @12% against Indigenous Supplies Certificate (ISC)for invoice

having material value Rs. 1 Lakh and above will be applicable as per Notification No. 08/2022-Integrated Tax (Rate) dated 13th July, 2022. In the event of order, OIL will issue Indigenous Supplies Certificate (ISC), where concessional rate of GST @12% will be applicable. Supplier shall affect dispatch only on receipt of this certificate from OIL, failing which all related liabilities shall be to Supplier's account. As such, bidders are requested to quote GST@12% (against Essentiality Certificate) only if the total material value is greater than or equal to Rs. 1 Lakh. In case, the total material value is less than Rs. 1 Lakh, bidders will be required to quote the applicable GST rate. The seller must submit their proforma invoice (required for ISC application process) at least 01 (one) month prior to the delivery deadline so that ISC could be obtained from DGH in time and forwarded to the seller.

9.0 The tender has been floated in GeM portal under Single Stage Two Bid System. Therefore, bidder must not disclose their prices in their technical offer. The technical bid shall contain all techno-commercial details except the prices/costs. Bidder must note that disclosure of price in technical bids shall lead to rejection of the offer.

5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM.
