2. Successful Bidder can submit the Performance Security in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft also (besides PBG which is allowed as per GeM GTC). DD should be made in favour of

3. Successful Bidder can submit the Performance Security in the form of Fixed Deposit Receipt also (besides PBG which is allowed as per GeM GTC). FDR should be made out or pledged in the name of

. Successful Bidder to indicate Contract number and name of Seller entity in the transaction details field at the time of on-line transfer. Bidder has to upload scanned copy / proof of the Online Payment Transfer in place of PBG within 15 days of award of contract.
5. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in the Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Commerce and Industry.

Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Sm Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be for percentage of 100% of total value.

6. Preference to Make In India products (For bids less than 200 Crore): Preference shall be given to Class 1 local : as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document 50%. If the bidder wants to avail Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 will be eligible to bid. Non - Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 are not eligible to participate. If Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get over this clause.

If any clause(s) incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category being bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Rare Bid Algorithm executed by GeM system.
