CORRIGENDUM DATED 31.01.2025.

This corrigendum has been issued to amend following clauses of **Tender No. SSI8124P25/P1** dated **02.01.2025**, as under instead of existing:

A) Clause No. 3.C of Annexure-I (Technical Specifications)

Existing	Amended
<p>Each bag of cement shall be legibly and indelibly marked with the following:</p> <p>a) Manufacturer's name and his registered trademark, if any b) BIS certification marking c) The words 'Portland pozzolana cement: Fly ash based' d) Net quantity, in kg e) The words 'Use no Hooks' on the bags f) Batch/control unit number in terms of week, month and year of packing g) Best before date (that is, 3 months from date of packing) h) The need for testing of cement more than 3 months old to check conformity before its use i) Address of the manufacturer j) Percentage of fly ash addition k) Similar information shall be provided in the delivery advices accompanying the shipment.</p> <p>Note : Manufacturer's Test Certificate should be furnished along with the dispatch document for every batch of cement dispatched. The certificate should include the test results for all the parameters as specified above and comply with the requirements of IS 1489:2015 Part 1. Cement must be supplied along with the MTC containing test results for all the parameters applicable as per IS 1489:2015 part 1.</p>	<p>Each bag of cement shall be legibly and indelibly marked with the following:</p> <p>a) Manufacturer's name and his registered trademark, if any b) BIS certification marking c) The words 'Portland pozzolana cement: Fly ash based' d) Net quantity, in kg e) The words 'Use no Hooks' on the bags f) Batch/control unit number in terms of week, month and year of packing g) Best before date (that is, 3 months from date of packing) h) Address of the manufacturer i) Percentage of fly ash addition</p> <p>Note: Manufacturer's Test Certificate (MTC) should be furnished based on test results of 3, 7 & 28 Days as per standard prescribed in IS code. The MTCs (indicating 3, 7 & 28 Days of obtained Compressive Strength) should be furnished indicating the corresponding Manufacturing Week. The certificate should also include the test results for all the parameters as specified above and comply with the requirements of IS 1489:2015 Part 1. The manufacturer shall furnish MTC within ten 10 days of dispatch of cement (except for 28 days compressive strength test results and drying shrinkage percent, which shall be furnished by manufacturer after completion of the test).</p>

B) Note description for Item No./Nos. : 10,20

<p>Pre-Dispatch Inspection</p> <p>OIL reserves the right to assign its representative to the Supplier's premises either before commencing the dispatch of materials against 1st Lot or against any other Lot during the contract period. The Supplier shall provide all necessary facilities to ensure a smooth inspection process in accordance with the terms and conditions of the purchase order, at no additional cost to OIL.</p> <p>Prior to commencing the supply of 1st Lot, the Supplier shall provide at least 15 days' advance notice once the material is ready for final inspection. OIL reserves the right to assign representatives for inspection before dispatch or to conduct random inspections during the contract period, at its discretion.</p>	<p>1. Pre-Dispatch Inspection</p> <p>OIL reserves the right to assign its representative to the Supplier's premises either before commencing the dispatch of materials against 1st Lot or against any other Lot during the contract period. The Supplier shall provide all necessary facilities to ensure a smooth inspection process in accordance with the terms and conditions of the purchase order, at no additional cost to OIL.</p> <p>Prior to commencing the supply of 1st Lot, the Supplier shall provide at least 15 days' advance notice once the material is ready for final inspection. OIL reserves the right to assign representatives for inspection before dispatch or to conduct random inspections during the contract period, at its discretion.</p> <p>2. OIL reserves the right to conduct random testing upon receipt of cement through any Government approved NABL accredited Third Party Laboratory. The test results shall be acceptable to both the parties.</p> <p>3. In case supplied cement fails to comply the parameters prescribed in relevant IS Code in NABL accredited third party lab, the supplied Cement Lot shall be rejected straight away. Further, Payment for the same shall not be released.</p> <p>4. In case Cement fails to comply the prescribed parameters of IS code carried out through Government approved NABL accredited Third Party Laboratory on three successive occasions against a single Purchase Order, the supplier shall be liable for action as per OIL's Banning Policy.</p> <p>5. Cement remaining in bulk storage at the factory, prior to shipment, for more than six months, or cement in bags, in local storage such as, in the hands of a vendor for more than 3 months after completion of tests, shall be retested before use and shall be rejected, if it fails to conform to any of the requirements of this specification.</p>

C) Clause No. III (Delivery Requirement) under Special Notes

<p>A. ITEM NO. 10 - TO BE DELIVERED AT DULIAJAN: Delivery of cement is to be made on "as and when required basis". Supply notice shall be issued by OIL from time to time. Delivery at OIL, Duliajan is to be made within 20 days from the date of receipt of supply notice from OIL. OIL's tentative monthly requirement is around 30,000 bags. However, supply notice shall be issued for supply of 10,000 - 30,000 Bags (tentatively) at a time against each supply notice. The supplier shall start delivery of material as per supply notice issued by OIL from time to time & complete supply of entire order quantity within 12-18 months (tentatively) depending on consumption from the date of supply of the 1st batch.</p> <p>B. ITEM NO. 20 - TO BE DELIVERED AT MORAN DIRECTLY: Delivery of construction cement is to be made on "as and when required basis". Supply notice shall be issued by OIL from time to time. Delivery at OIL (MORAN) is to be made within 20 days from the date of receipt of supply notice from OIL. OIL's tentative monthly requirement is 6,000 Bags. Accordingly, OIL shall issue notices for supply of 5,000 to 6,000 Bags (tentatively) at a time against each supply advise depending on the requirement. The supplier shall start delivery of material as per supply notice issued by OIL from time to time & complete supply of entire order quantity within 12-18 months (tentatively) depending on consumption pattern from the date of supply of the 1st batch.</p>	<p>A. ITEM NO. 10 - TO BE DELIVERED AT DULIAJAN: Delivery of 25,000 bags per month to be made in a staggered way on weekly basis.</p> <p>B. ITEM NO. 20 - TO BE DELIVERED AT MORAN DIRECTLY: Delivery of 5,000 bags per month to be made in a staggered way on weekly basis.</p>

D) The Bid Closing Date has been extended upto 19.02.2025 (11:00 Hrs) and bids shall be opened on 19.02.2025 (at 14:00 Hrs).

Note: All other terms and conditions of the Tender No. SSI8124P25/P1 dated 02.01.2025 shall remain unchanged.
