

Bid Corrigendum

GEM/2024/B/5680669-C1

Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. **OPTION CLAUSE:** The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.
2. Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Only supply of Goods
3. **Bidder financial standing:** The bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings, should not be bankrupt. Bidder to upload undertaking to this effect with bid.
4. Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.
5. Bidder shall submit the following documents along with their bid for Vendor Code Creation:
 - a. Copy of PAN Card.
 - b. Copy of GSTIN.
 - c. Copy of Cancelled Cheque.
 - d. Copy of EFT Mandate duly certified by Bank.
6. **Manufacturer Authorization:** Wherever Authorised Distributors/service providers are submitting the bid, Authorisation Form /Certificate with OEM/Original Service Provider details such as name, designation, address, e-mail Id and Phone No. required to be furnished along with the bid

 1. The Seller shall not assign the Contract in whole or part without obtaining the prior written consent of buyer.
 2. The Seller shall not sub-contract the Contract in whole or part to any entity without obtaining the prior written consent of buyer.
 3. The Seller shall, notwithstanding the consent and assignment/sub-contract, remain jointly and severally liable and responsible to buyer together with the assignee/ sub-contractor, for and in respect of the due performance of the Contract and the Sellers obligations there under.
8. While generating invoice in GeM portal, the seller must upload scanned copy of GST invoice and the screenshot of GST portal confirming payment of GST.
9. Without prejudice to Buyer's right to price adjustment by way of discount or any other right or remedy available to Buyer, Buyer may terminate the Contract or any part thereof by a written notice to the Seller, if:
 - i) The Seller fails to comply with any material term of the Contract.
 - ii) The Seller informs Buyer of its inability to deliver the Material(s) or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period or such inability otherwise becomes apparent.
 - iii) The Seller fails to deliver the Material(s) or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period and/or to replace/rectify any rejected or defective Material(s) promptly.
 - iv) The Seller becomes bankrupt or goes into liquidation.
 - v) The Seller makes a general assignment for the benefit of creditors.
 - vi) A receiver is appointed for any substantial property owned by the Seller.

vii) The Seller has misrepresented to Buyer, acting on which misrepresentation Buyer has placed the Purchase Order on the Seller.

10. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for percentage of 100% of total value.
11. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

1. The current amendment against the tender has been issued to include an indicative drawing and photograph of the tendered item, referenced as Annexure X in the Buyer uploaded ATC Document under Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC (Refer to Sl. No. 11 below) for a better clarity of the technical requirement of the tender.

However, bidders are required to note that the measurements shall be as per details mentioned in GEM Bid additional specification parameters only (& NOT those in the current indicative drawing).

2. Bidders are required to thoroughly review the Additional Specification Parameters of the indented item. In case of any conflict between the Additional Specification Parameters and the preceding Specification for Carbon brushes for motor and generator, the Additional Specification Parameters are to be considered final.

3. Detailed Technical Specifications of the indented item as outlined in Annexure IA of the Buyer uploaded ATC Document under Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC (Refer to Sl. No. 11 below). Offers submitted by bidders must fully comply with the technical specifications detailed in Annexure IA. Bidders shall provide their compliance to the technical specifications sought in Annexure IA in the Bidder's compliance column provided therewith.

4. Bidders must take note of the Additional Terms & Conditions available in the abovementioned Buyer uploaded ATC Document referenced as Annexure I and fill the designated column therein to indicate their compliance with the specified terms and conditions. In case, no remarks are submitted / left blank against the Additional Terms & Conditions given in Buyer uploaded ATC Document, then it would be construed that the bidder has not taken any exception/deviation to the tender requirements.

5. Bidders to submit Undertakings as per Exhibits-I, II & III and Proforma 1, 2, 3 & 4 given in Buyer uploaded ATC Document.

6. Queries Submission Timeline clause

All prospective bidders are hereby instructed to **submit any queries or requests for clarification related to this tender within a period of five (5) calendar days from the date of publishing of this tender document.** Any queries received after the stipulated deadline will not be entertained or responded to by OIL.

7. Avoidance of Extension for Bid Submission clause

Bidders are earnestly advised to ensure that their bid submissions are prepared and submitted in accordance with the deadlines specified in this tender document. OIL has taken all necessary steps to establish reasonable timelines for the submission of bids to allow ample time for thorough preparation.

As a matter of policy, OIL will only consider granting an extension of the bid submission due date as a onetime exception in situations deemed unavoidable. Such extensions will be granted solely at the discretion of OIL and only in response to a written request from the bidder (mail to joyshree.dutta@oilindia.in), submitted in accordance with the procedures outlined in this tender document.

It is hereby emphasized that OIL will not entertain or consider any requests for an extension of the bid submission due date, except in cases where OIL deems such extension unavoidable and the bidder submits a formal written request, detailing the compelling circumstances necessitating the extension. Bidders are therefore strongly advised to refrain from seeking an extension of the bid submission due date unless absolutely necessary due to unforeseen and unavoidable circumstances.

By participating in this tender process, all bidders acknowledge and accept the terms and conditions outlined in this Avoidance of Bid Submission Due Date Extensions clause.

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.

14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
