

Amendment No.2 dated 09.09.2024 to Tender No GEM/2024/B/5244710

1.0 This Amendment is issued for certain changes in the tender documents as given under:

AA. Clause on local content under Bid details of the GeM bidding document has been amended as under:

Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for percentage of 50% of total value.</p>	<p>5.
