**CORRIGENDUM NO. 8 DATED 01.08.2024 TO E-TENDER NO. GEM/2024/B/4856672 for  
“Hiring of Drilling Waste Management Services for collection, transportation & disposal of  
drilling waste from OIL’s drilling locations through Co-processing/TSDF.**

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This Corrigendum is issued to notify the following change:

1.0 Kindly read the Point No. 5 of Clause No. 2.0 of SOW i.e., ‘Broad Scope of Work’ as following in place of existing:

"Testing of Drilling Waste shall be under contractor’s scope. Contractor shall pick up and analyse the drill cuttings/mud/sludge generated during drilling and stored at Contractor’s waste pits through an NABL accredited laboratory/ MoEF&CC registered laboratory and as per the analysis the Drilling waste will be categorized as hazardous or non-hazardous characteristic in nature as per Schedule-I, II, III of Hazardous Waste Rules, 2016. For disposal of drill cuttings identified as hazardous or non-hazardous, Contractor shall comply with all conditions of “Guidelines for Disposal of Solid waste, Drill cuttings, Drill fluids for offshore and onshore drilling operations” notified by MoEF&CC dated 30/08/2005 (GSR 546 (e)). Considering “Precautionary Principle” or else shall follow Construction & Demolition Waste Management Rules 2016, Solid Waste Management Rule 2016, as applicable. However, OIL also may analyse the drill cuttings generated during drilling through an NABL accredited laboratory/ MoEF&CC registered laboratory."

2.0 Bid Closing / Opening dates extended as per following:

- i. Bid Closing Date & Time: Extended up to 13.08.2024 [1400 Hrs (IST)]
- ii. Bid Opening Date & Time: Extended up to 13.08.2024 [1430 Hrs (IST)]
