Oil India Limited, a Government of India Enterprise intends to avail the “To provide Miscellaneous support services such as Jungle cutting, Hiring of JCB / Excavator and Repair of Exposures by Boulder Sausage and Boulder Pitching Works with CC Topping, Earth Filling etc. from PLKM 704 to PLKM 736 for works at different locations for a period of 36 months on as and when required basis. In-case of emergency, service may be extended from PLKM 704 to PLKM 1157.”

Interested bidder may collect the Bid Documents from the office of the General Manager (Contracts) Guwahati-781171 from 13.04.2024 to 13.05.2024 during office hours from 8.00 AM to 10.00 AM. The Bid Closing Date (BCD) is 13.05.2024 at 13.30 hrs. and Bid Opening Date (BOD) is 13.05.2024 at 14.00 Hrs.

All corrigenda, addenda, amendments, time extension, clarification etc. to the tender will be hosted on the Oil Website and no separate notification shall be issued in the press. Prospective bidders are requested to regularly visit the website. Tender Reference is CGI5983P24.

BID REJECTION CRITERIA(BRC) / BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC)

The bid shall conform generally to the specifications and terms and conditions given in the Bidding Documents. Bids will be rejected in case material and services offered do not conform to the required parameters stipulated in the technical specifications. Notwithstanding the general conformity of the bid to the stipulated specifications, the following requirements will have to be particularly met by the Bidders without which the same will be considered as non-responsive and rejected. All the documents related to BEC/BRC shall be submitted along with the Techno-Commercial Bid.

1.0 Financial capability: Bidders must have:

(A) Annual financial turnover as per Audited Annual Reports in any of the preceding three(3) financial years should be at least **INR 2,45,000.00**

(B) Net Worth should be positive for the preceding financial year.

(C) For proof of Annual Turnover & Net worth any one of the following document must be submitted along with the bid:-

i) A certificate issued by a practicing Chartered/Cost Accountant (with Membership Number and Firm Registration Number,**UDIN**), certifying the Annual turnover & Net worth

OR

ii) Audited Balance Sheet along with Profit & Loss account.

Note:Annexure-AA (furnished below) is to required to be mandatorily submitted

(D) In case the bidder is a Central Govt. Organization/PSU/State Govt. Organization/Semi-State Govt. Organization or any other Central/State Govt. Undertaking, where the auditor is appointed only after the approval of Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the Central Government, their certificates may be accepted even though FRN (Firm Registration Number) is not available. However, bidder to provide documentary evidence for the same.

(E) Considering the time required for preparation of Financial Statements, if the last date of preceding financial/ accounting year falls within the preceding six months reckoned from the original bid closing date and the Financial Statements of the preceding financial / accounting year are not available with the bidder, then the financial turnover of the previous three financial / accounting years excluding the preceding financial / accounting year will be considered. In such cases, the Net worth of the previous financial/ accounting

year excluding the preceding financial/ accounting year will be considered. However, the bidder has to submit an affidavit/ undertaking certifying that the balance sheet/ Financial Statements for the financial year 2022-2023 (or as the case may be) has actually not been audited so far.

2.0 Experience: Bidders must have:

2.1 The bidder must have successfully executed/completed similar Works over the last 7(seven) years reckoned from the Original Bid Closing Date in Central/State Government/ PSUs/ Nationalised Banks/ Public Limited Company as under

Experience of having successfully completed similar works in previous 7(seven) years to be reckoned from the original bid closing date should be the following :

(i) Experience of at least 1(one) similar work of INR4,09,100.00

Similar work shall mean" **CARRYING OUT EXPOSURE REPAIR OF HYDROCARBON PIPELINE and ASSISTANCE IN HYDROCARBON PIPELINE PILFERAGE REPAIR.**

2.2 A job executed by a bidder for its own organization / subsidiary cannot be considered as experience for the purpose of meeting BEC.

2.3 In case of tenders for Annual rate contracts / Maintenance and Service contracts, if the prospective bidder is executing rate / maintenance /service contract which is still running and the contract value / quantity executed prior to due date of bid submission is equal to or more than the minimum prescribed value in the BEC such experience will also be taken in to consideration provided that the bidder has submitted satisfactory work / supply / service execution certificate issued by end user.

2.4 Documentary proof must be furnished in support of the experience by way of purchase order / work order / contract document along with completion certificate from the organization to whom such services have been rendered.

3.0 Deviation to the following provision of the tender document shall make the bid liable for rejection:

- i. Firm price
- ii. EMD / Bid Bond
- iii. Scope of work
- iv. Specifications
- v. Price Schedule
- vi. Delivery / Completion Schedule
- vii. Period of Validity of Bid

- xi. Arbitration / Resolution of Dispute

 - xiii. Applicable Laws
- xiv. Integrity Pact, if applicable
- xv. Any other condition specifically mentioned in the tender documents elsewhere that non-compliance of the clause lead to rejection of the bid.

4. COMMERCIAL:

4.1. Bidder shall submit the offer under **Single Stage Single bid (Composite)system.**

The tender is invited under **SINGLE STAGE SINGLE BID SYSTEM**. The bidders shall submit both the "TECHNICAL" and "PRICED" bids through electronic form in the OIL's E-Procurement portal within the Bid Closing Date and Time stipulated in the E-Tender. The Technical Bid should be submitted as per Scope of Work & Technical Specifications along with all technical documents related to the tender and uploaded under "Technical Attachment" Tab only. Bidders must note that no price details should be uploaded in "Technical Attachment" Tab Page. **The Technical Bid should not have any price indication.** Details of prices as per Price Bid format/ Priced bid to be uploaded under **"Notes and Attachment" Tab. Bidders must quote clearly and strictly in accordance with the price schedule outlined in relevant section of Bidding Documents; otherwise the bid will be rejected.**

Offer not complying with above submission procedure will be rejected as per Bid Rejection Criteria. In Bid opening, both Technical & Priced Bids will be opened. In Bid opening, Technical Bid will be opened. Priced Bid opening will be notified in OIL E-TENDER portal.

4.2. Bidder shall furnish **Bid Security(if applicable)/ DECLARATION FOR BID SECURITY(if applicable)** along with Bid. **Bid Security/DECLARATION FOR BID SECURITY** shall be furnished as a part of 'Technical Bid'. **Any bid not accompanied by a proper Bid Security(if applicable)/ DECLARATION FOR BID SECURITY(if applicable) will be rejected. Bidder shall submit original document to the address as specified with BCD before Bid opening date and time, otherwise Bid will be rejected.** A scanned copy of this document should also be uploaded along with the Un-priced bid.

EMD/Bid security is **not applicable** against this tender and may be paid in the form of Demand Draft/Banker Cheque /Bank Guarantee **(as per Proforma-D)** . **DECLARATION FOR BID SECURITY is to be furnished by the bidders along with**

the technical RFX in case of seeking exemption from submission of Bid security/ EMD(if applicable) (as per Proforma-R). Any offer not accompanied with the Bid Security(**if applicable**) shall be treated as invalid and summarily rejected unless the bidder is exempted from submission of Bid Security as per Bid Security Exemption Criteria of this tender and proper proof towards this exemption is submitted by the bidder. Any subsequent deposit of Bid Security(**if applicable**) after the bid closing date shall not be permitted. Also, adjustment of Bid Security(**if applicable**) due against the instant tender, against dues from the Company or on any account shall not be permitted.

4.3. The Validity of the bid shall be **minimum 90 days**. Bids with lesser validity will be rejected.

4.4. Any bid received in the form of Telex/Cable/Fax/E-mail/ Telephone call will not be accepted.

4.5. Price quoted by the successful Bidder must be firm during the performance of the Contract and not subject to variation on any account. A bid submitted with an adjustable price will be treated as non-responsive and rejected.

4.6. Any bid containing false statement will be rejected.

4.7. The Bid Documents are not transferable. Bids made by parties who have not purchased the Bid Documents from the Company will be rejected.

4.8. Any Bid received by the Company after the deadline for submission of bids prescribed by the Company will be rejected.

4.9. The following Clauses with all its sub-clauses should be agreed in toto, failing which the bid will be rejected. To this effect Bidder shall submit an undertaking along with the Technical Bid.

- a) Performance Security Clause
- b) Force Majeure Clause
- c) Termination Clause
- d) Settlement of disputes Clause
- e) Liquidated Damages Clause.
- f) Acceptance of Jurisdiction and applicable law.
- g) Tax liabilities clause.
- h) Insurance clause.
- i) With holding clause.
- j) Liability clause.
- k) Set off clause

4.10 PURCHASE PREFERENCE TO MSE BIDDERS: Purchase Preference to Micro and Small Enterprises is applicable for this tender.

4.10.1 In case participating MSEs Quote price within price band of L1+15%, such MSE shall be considered for award of contract by bringing down their price to L1 price in a situation where L1 price is from someone other than an MSE.

4.10.2 In case of more than one such MSE qualifying for 15% purchase preference, the contract shall be awarded to lowest eligible MSE amongst the MSEs qualifying for 15% purchase preference.

4.10.3 Documentation required to be submitted by MSEs: Categorization and various criteria applicable to MSE bidders shall be guided by the Gazette Notification No. CG-DL- E-26062020-220191 dated 26.06.2020.

The bidder claiming the MSE status (MSE-General, MSE-SC/ST, MSE-Woman) against this tender must submit the following documents along with the technical bid for availing the benefits applicable to MSEs.

(i) Udyam Registration Number with Udyam Registration Certificate.

Note: In case bidding MSE is owned by Schedule Caste or Schedule Tribe or Woman entrepreneur, valid documentary evidence issued by the agency who has registered the bidder as MSE owned by SC/ST/Woman entrepreneur should also be enclosed.

4.11 COMPLIANCE OF THE COMPETITION ACT, 2002: The bidder shall strictly comply with the provisions of the Competition Act, 2002, more particularly, Section-3 of the Act. Any violation of the provisions of the Act shall attract penal action under the Act.

5. BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC):

5.1. The bids conforming to the technical specifications, terms and conditions stipulated in the bid documents and considered to be responsive after subjecting to the Bid Rejection Criteria will be considered for further evaluation as per the Bid Evaluation Criteria.

5.2. To ascertain the inter-se-ranking, the comparison of the responsive bids will be made on the basis of total cost of various works envisaged under the contract.

5.3. In case more than one bidder emerges as lowest bidder due to equal rate quoted by the bidder, then the lowest bidder will be decided by draw of lots. Company's decision in this regard is final and binding to all bidders

5.4. Any discount/rebates offered shall not be considered for evaluation of bids. However, if the lowest bidder happens to be the final acceptable bidder for award of contract and if they have offered any discount/rebate the contract shall be awarded after taking into consideration such discount/rebate after negotiation or otherwise.

5.5 Original Bid closing date will be considered for evaluation of BRC criteria even in case of any extension of the original Bid Closing Date.
